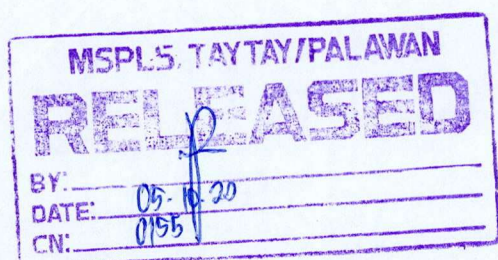

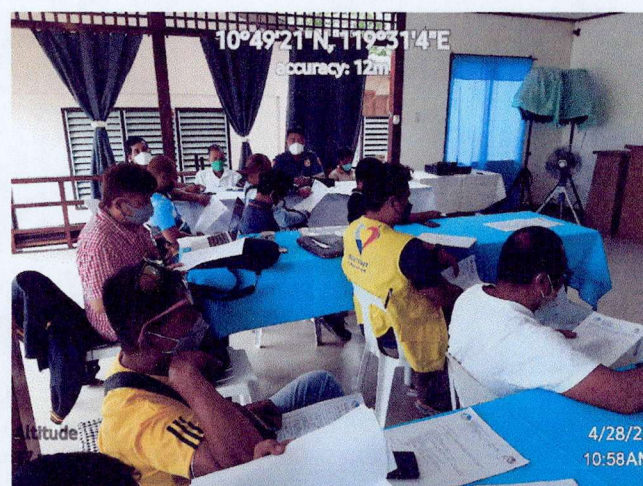


Figure III. Reading and approval of the previous meeting.






Figure VII. FR Francis Abe G. Bose, presented the accomplishment of the enforcement team of FPMS VI.

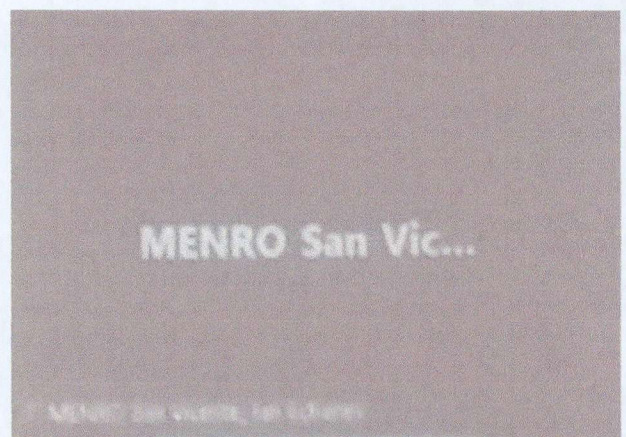
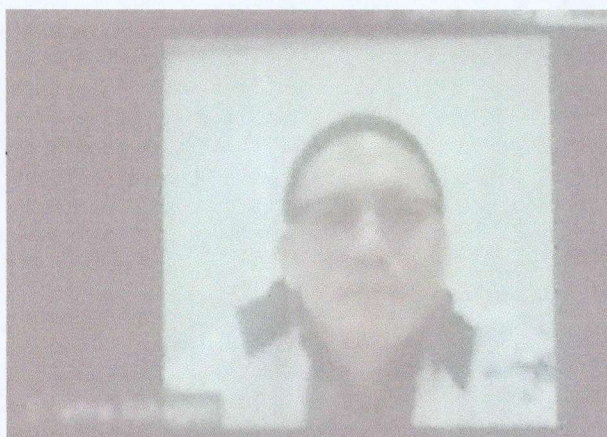
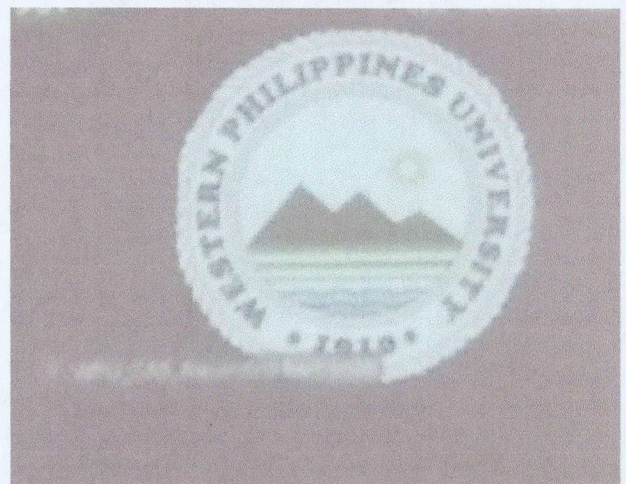
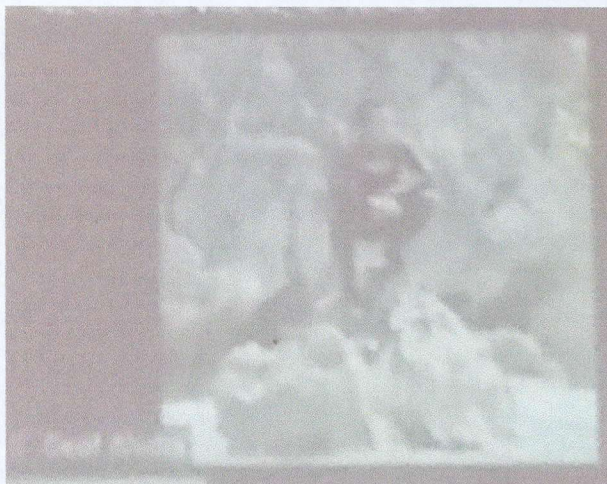
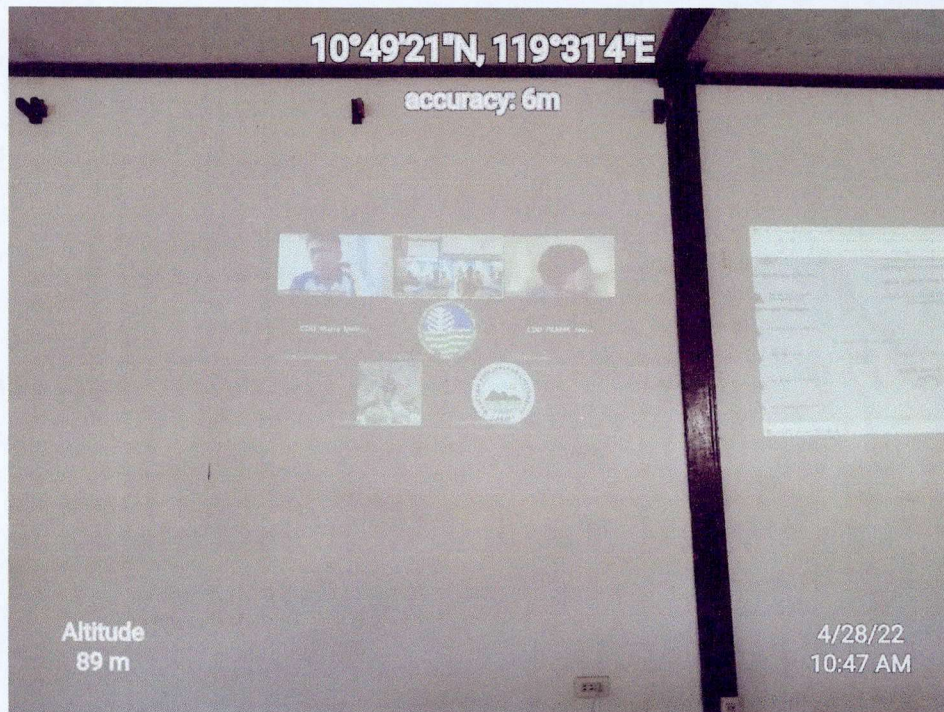



Figure XI. PAMB members thru virtual appearance.
