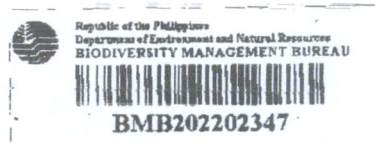
SUBJECT : REQUEST FOR NOMINEES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE  
SEABIRD IDENTIFICATION TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON  
JULY 19-22, 2022

Seabirds are distinguished by the fact that they breed on land and they obtain nourishment from the sea. Majority of the species nest on islands, most of the time in isolated parts of the country that are difficult to access, making these pelagic birds the least studied birds in the Philippines.

In this regard, the Bureau is organizing a Seabird Identification Training-Workshop to fill-in the knowledge gaps in seabird familiarity and identification to be held face-to-face on **July 19-22, 2022** in Metro Manila (exact venue to be determined). This learning event also aims to capacitate the DENR field offices on the survey methods and monitoring of seabirds.

In line with this, may we request for one (1) representative from each Region to participate face-to-face in the training-workshop and one (1) representative from each of the **Marine Protected Areas** to participate online via virtual platform.
