

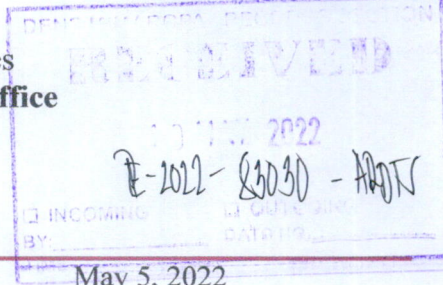





This pertains to the memorandum dated March 28, 2022 of ASec Marcial C. Amaro, Jr. CESO II on the above subject.

Please be informed that this Office had reported a total universe of 2,039 CSCs in 2018 based on the list under CBFM Unit. However, it was found out that some of the reported CSCs were unsigned while others had incomplete data (i.e. unsigned contract, signed contract but no indicated area and no CSC number). Upon checking of the CSC data, the following were disclosed, to wit:

- a. There are one thousand six hundred ninety three (1,693) found valid CSCs in which few of these were only obtained from the holders during the ground evaluation. Meanwhile, the exact number of CSC universe outside the CBFM area cannot be computed, unless actual ground verification be done during evaluation.
- b. A total of 261 CSC forms covering six (6) barangays were found invalid because those were not signed by the CENRO and concerned staff;
- c. There were 85 CSCs with incomplete data (signed contract but no specific area or CSC number);
- d. Out of 1,693 CSCs, there were 708 evaluated CSCs in which 252 were recommended for renewal; 136 for re-evaluation; 135 for transfer; and 91 for cancellation. Further, 54 were identified within the CBFM area and 40 were recommended for cancellation and PACBRMA application for being within the Protected Area.



In view of the above concerns, this Office recommends the following, to wit:

- a. That the 85 CSCs with incomplete data should still be considered in the universe because this office is still reconciling the data with the available documents (CSC logbook) in the Office;
- b. That the claimant of the 261 unsigned CSCs should be organized to CBFM/PACBRMA program;
- c. The 40 CSCs that were previously evaluated and recommended for PACBRMA be considered for renewal, cancellation, re-evaluation and transfer.
