B. Justification

- 1. The jurisdiction of CENRO Puerto Princesa, CENRO Roxas and CENRO Taytay were badly hit by typhoon Odette last December 17, 2021. The devastation brought about tremendous task for DENR Palawan to respond as the lead agency in the Task Force Build Back Better (TFBBB) per Executive Order No. 120, dated November 18, 2020. It is the responsibility of DENR to serve as the overall and central body to ensure whole-of-government implementation and monitoring of post-disaster recovery and rehabilitation effort of the National government in typhoon-affected areas. Among the urgent task to be accomplished are the following:
 - a. To attain improved systems and essential services
 - b. To attain better resilient infrastructure and stronger shelter and resilient settlement
 - c. To intensify watershed management and environmental protection thru continuous conduct of forest patrolling
- 2. In order to appropriately respond to the above identified urgent actions there is a need to hire additional One Hundred Forty (140) Forest Protection Officers and additional funds for other activities specified in the attached work and financial plan.




