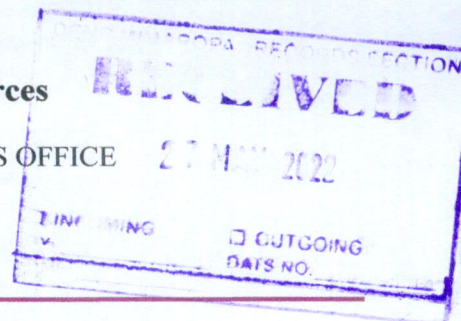


Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum of CENRO Coron, Palawan dated May 11, 2022 relative the above subject.





By virtue of this deputation, they are authorized to assist in the enforcement of laws, rules, deforming ordinances, decrees, orders, and protected areas and national parks, marine resources and sanctuaries, and other lands of the public domain under the jurisdiction of the DENR within their locality.

They are further authorized to perform the following:


1. Assist in the issuance of administrative permits, secure orders and conduct of administrative hearings involving the enforcement necessary for the protection and administrative jurisdiction of forest, protected, sanctuaries, parks, and other lands of the public domain, and other lands of the public domain.

2. Arrest, even without warrant, any person who has committed or is committing in his/her presence any of the offenses provided in environmental and natural resources laws, rules and regulations.
3. Deliver, within the period prescribed by law, from time of arrest and seizure, the offender, including the apprehended natural resources products, tools, equipment and contrabands, and coordinate with the appropriate official designated by law to conduct preliminary investigation prior to the filing of information in Court through the CENRO or PENRO or Regional Director, where it is most expediently available.
4. Act as witness in Court for the speedy prosecution of criminal contraventions violators of environmental and natural resources laws, rules and regulations.
5. Assist in the conduct of environment and natural resources information campaign, such as meetings, public assembly, and other extension activities within their areas of jurisdiction in coordination with CENRO officers and personnel of other government or private agencies involved in such projects, and
6. Submit monthly accomplishment reports to the CENRO concerned and to the Field Operations Office having jurisdiction over their area of responsibility, using the standard reporting form attached as Annex 1.

They are authorized to exercise the power and authority conferred herein within the territorial jurisdiction of CENRO-Coron, Palawan.

This Deputation Order takes effect upon issue and will expire after one (1) year from the date of approval unless sooner revoked or terminated by this Office.
