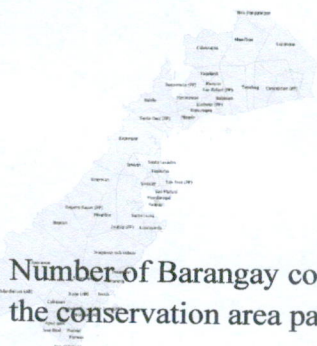

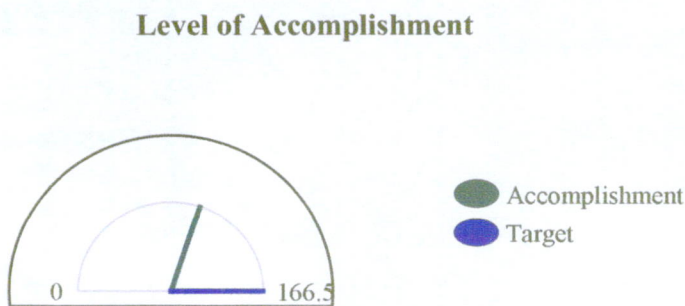
Summary Patrol Report
