ORDER

When this case was called for arraignment, Atty. Rey Daniel S. Acedillo of the Public Attorney's Office, counsel for the accused, manifested that the accused intends to plead guilty to the lesser offense under Section 7 no. 3 of R.A. 9175.

The public prosecutor and the arresting officer in the person of PSsg Bien Lawrence I. Sanchez orally gave their conformity to the plea bargaining proposal by the accused.

Thereafter, accused, when arraigned in Filipino, a language known to and understood by him, pleaded guilty to the lesser offense defined and penalized under Section 7 no. 3 of R.A. 9175. Let a plea of guilty be entered into the records of the case.

In view of the plea of guilty of the accused to Section 7 no. 3 of R.A. 9175, he is hereby sentenced to suffer the imprisonment of one (1) month and to pay a fine of One Thousand Pesos (₱1000.00).

On motion of the defense counsel, the accused shall stay on provisional liberty on the strength of the same bond pending the filing of the necessary pleading.

The chain saw confiscated as a result of the arrest of the accused and subject matter of this case shall be sold at public auction and the proceeds thereof shall go to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.
