

- 2. The DENR CENRO to assist in the delineation and survey with engineers from LGU and Gorong Bay Corp. and determine the location of the proposed sewer pipeline that will be installed in the area.
- 3. The Provincial Government of Palawan to secure PAMB endorsement for the cluster tank and sewer pipeline as components of the STP.
- 4. Schedule technical conference with Provincial Government of Palawan and LGU El Nido regarding issues and concerns being encountered in relation to the STP project.

This pertains to the memorandum from the CENRO dated January 3, 2022 with instruction to conduct inspection in the laying of the sewer pipeline within the mangrove area of Bgy. Corong-corong, El Nido, Palawan attached is letter request of Hon. Edna Gacot-Lim dated December 16, 2021 and other

documents submitted by the Municipal Government of El Nido.

Please be informed that the undersigned conducted inspection on January 17, 2022 for the proposed location of laying of sewer pipeline in mangrove area located at Bgy. Corong-corong, El Nido, Palawan. During the inspection the project is not yet started and the sewer pipeline will be installed along the riverbank within the mangrove area and allegedly within the private property of Gorong Bay Corporation. Based on the submitted documents there will be a pipe support made of fabricated flat bar, steel plate, cement it will be connected to the cluster tank to the main tank.

Be informed further, that the said project is a joint project of the Provincial Government of Palawan and the Municipal Government of El Nido. Also, the said project is not yet endorse by the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) of El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA).

The team recommends the following;

Coordinate to Gorong Bay Corporation;

2. In-depth study for the adverse effect to the environement;

3. Secure PAMB Endorsement for the cluster tank and sewer pipeline; and,

4. Tracking of sewer pipeline.







Greetings!

This has reference to the operation of the El Nido Sewage and Solid Waste Treatment Plant ("El Nido STP" for brevity) which is a joint project of the Provincial Government of Palawan and the Municipal Government of El Nido which is governed by a Memorandum of Agreement, the photocopy of which is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof.

The El Nido STP which has a true cost of P695,972,504.00 is part of the rehabilitation program of the Municipality of El Nido to improve its water quality.

To be fully operational in the area of Barangay Corong Corong, there is a need to lay the sewer pipeline to connect the sewer cluster collector tank to the commercial establishments and households. The sewer pipeline will traverse along the five (5) meters easement of the riverbank within the mangrove area. For your ready reference, the copy of the google map indicating the sewer pipeline is hereto attached as Annex "8" and made an integral part hereof.

The laying of the sewer pipeline is **non-inv**asive as it will not involve the cutting of any mangrove. Necessary precautions in the laying of the sewer pipelines will be done so as not to cause damage to the **environment**.

Incidentally, the mangrove area is within an area which is embraced and covered by a Transfer Certificate of Title in the name of the Gorong Bay Corporation.

Densidering that the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENIX) has the preserv jurisdiction over the management and disposition of the management, we are requesting your clearance for the laying of the sewer pipeline.




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












METHOD STATEMENT

CLUSTER COLLECTOR TANK 9B 8" HDPE TRUNK LINE

1.0 PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project aims to accomplish the laying of Cluster Collector tank 9B's trunk line located at Brgy. Corong-Corong, El Nido Port (Takasan area). The said trunk line will be laid at the easement area of the shoreline, the mangrove area along the river which will be pipe supported, up to the Main tank which is located at the El Nido Central Elementary School.

2.0 OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this method statement is to describe the activities and methods, which will be used to carry out the laying of trunk line pipes.

3.0 TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

The tools and equipment to be prepared on site shall be as follows:

- 1. PC70 backhoe
- 2. Butt fusion

4.0 MATERIALS

All materials needed on the site shall be as follows:

- 1. 8" HDPE pipes
- 2. Deformed reinforced bars
- 3. Cement
- 4. Aggregates
- 5. Generator set

5.0 CONSTRUCTION METHOD

The sequence of the work to be carried out shall be as follows:

- 5.1 Laying of 8" HDPF pipes along the shoreline
- 3.2 Construction of pipe support
- 5.3 Placing of 8" HDPE pipes to the pipe support
- 5 | Laying of 8" HDPE pipes along the shoreline
- 5.1.1 Prior to laying of HDPE pipes along the shoreline, a 1.5 meters depth shall be excavated with sinkers connected at every 6 meters or every connection of pipe in accordance to the detailed plan and design.

- 5.1.2 The HDPE pipes shall be connected to each pipes by butt fusion (HDPE welding) process. It involves the simultaneous heating of the ends of two pipe/fitting components which are to be joined, until a molten state is attained on each contact surface. The two surfaces are then brought together under controlled pressure for a specific cooling time and a homogenous fusion joint is formed.
- 5.2 Construction of Pipe support
- 5.2.1 Each pipe support has a clear distance of 3meters and a height of 1-1.5meters in accordance to the detailed plan and design.
- 5.2.2 Foundation of each pipe support and structure shall be checked and supervised by engineer in-charge in accordance to the design and specifications.
- 5.2.3 All materials needed to the construction shall be manually delivered on site by means of manpower only.
- 5.3 Placing of 8" HDPE pipes to the pipe support
- 5.3.1 Prior to placing of pipes, a proper butt fusion with trained manpower and a proper anchors shall be inspected by the engineer in charge properly.

Dear Engr. Cardenas,

I am writing in behalf of my client, GORONG BAY RESORT CORPORATION represented by its President, Mr. Cho Hang Jin. This has reference to the project of the Provincial Government of Palawan (Cluster Collector Tank 9B 8" HDPE Trunk Line) located at Brgy. Corong-Corong, El Nido, Palawan.

It is stated in the project description provided to my client that the trunk line will be laid at the easement area of the shore line and the mangrove area along the "river" which, as per my client's initial assessment, is inside the titled property of Gorong Bay Resort Corporation. (On whether it is classified really by the DENR as a river is another matter.) Representatives from the LGU have met with my client through his representatives on various occasions to discuss the said project considering that portions of the proposed project will directly pass through the titled property of Gorong Bay Resort Corporation.

A perusal of the documents provided to my client could not readily disclose the actual location of the proposed project though the coordinates of the project were indicated. Thus, he would like to request that he be given ample time to verify the said coordinates which you claim to be within the easement and mangrove area/river. Considering that the title to the property does not specifically indicate mangrove area/river except the salvage zone along Line 2-3, he is therefore constrained to request his technical personnel based in Manila to conduct a thorough study of your proposal, not to mention its environmental impact on the intended use of the titled property of Gorong Bay Resort Corporation as residential areas. Relative to this, and to allow his consultants to arrive at a fair and diligent recommendation on the matter, please provide us with your Initial Environmental Impact Assessment and your Environmental Compliance Certificate as well as the detailed program of works for the said project - to include the entirety of the project. not only for this particular phase. My client's environmental managers would be interested in being informed of the methodology/process or procedure by which waste water from sewage would be treated as these are the very matter or substance that will be conveyed through the pipes that will be laid within his titled property.

Also, in view of the fact that you claim that your project will be located on the mangrove area/river, there is a need to specifically delineate the river/mangrove area by having a relocation survey vis-a-vis the technical description of the title to the land held by Gorong Bay Resort Corporation. My client proposes a joint survey on the matter with his Geodetic Engineer.

My client would be most willing to cooperate with the government on its projects which will be beneficial to the community. Meanwhile, until and unless he received the documents requested and pending a joint relocation survey, please suspend all works proposed to be done on the property of Gorong Bay Resort Corporation. Thank you.
