RESOLUTION

GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ALL ACCREDITED CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS BY THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF MARINDUQUE IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) FOR THOSE EXISTING BELOW FIVE (5) YEARS AND FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00) FOR THOSE OPERATING FOR FIVE (5) YEARS AND ABOVE, AND APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Marinduque (PGM) recognizes the contributions of CSOs in the socio-economic development of the province as well as in providing humanitarian services to the constituents of the province;

WHEREAS, aside from its representation to the Local Special Bodies that is responsible for crafting development plans of the province, the CSOs have also been a partner of the province in all aspect of its promotion and advancement;

WHEREAS, in recognition thereof, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds it imperative to provide assistance to the CSOs, financial or otherwise, for them to continue its good deeds and in achieving their goals and objectives that is all bound for the general welfare of the province;

WHEREFORE, on motion of the Chairperson of the Committee on Civil Society Organizations, Honorable Mercedes R. Rejano, duly seconded by Honorable Antonio L. Mangcucang III, it was:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to grant financial assistance to all accredited Civil Society Organizations by the Provincial Government of Marinduque in the amount of thirty thousand pesos (P30,000.00) for those existing below five (5) years and fifty thousand pesos (P50,000.00) for those operating for five (5) years and above, and appropriating necessary funds for the purpose.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Provincial Governor, the Provincial Budget Officer, the Provincial Accountant, the Provincial Treasurer, the Provincial Auditor, Provincial Planning & Development Office, and to all the accredited CSOs of the province for their information, guidance and appropriate action.
