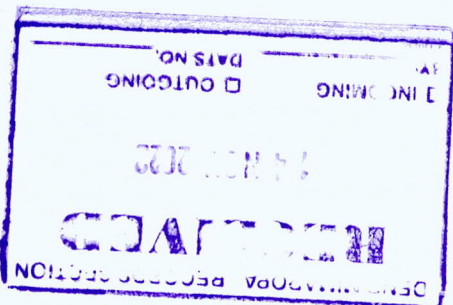

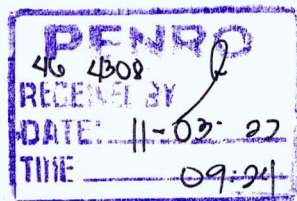
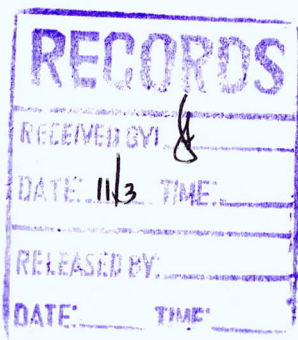

**SUBJECT : REPORT ON THE CONDUCT LEARNING EVENT ON IMPORTANT ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS, POLICIES, RULES AND REGULATIONS ON INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP VOLUNTEERS FOR DEPUTATION AS SPECIAL DEPUTY ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICER (S/DENRO) AND WILDLIFE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER (WEO)**

In line with the with the P/A/P Activate/Revitalize MFPCs, Individuals and Group Volunteers for Deputation as Special Deputy Environment and Natural Resources Officers (S/DENROs) and Mobilization of Wildlife Enforcement Officers (WEOs), CENRO San Jose, Occidental Mindoro through its Enforcement and Monitoring Section conducted a meeting with Task Force Cali-Kasan, Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) and Barangay LGUs of Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro on April 07-08, 2022 at Holiday Ocean Resort, Brgy. Iiron, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro and Labros Adventure Camp, Brgy. Concepcion, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro to conduct a learning event on important environmental laws, policies, rules and regulations for deputation of individual and group volunteers as S/DENROs and WEOs. The meeting was participated by 53 participants consisting of 38 males 15 females.

On the first day at Holiday Ocean Resort, Brgy. Iiron, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro, the meeting started with an opening prayer and singing of the Philippine National Anthem that was followed by a welcome message from Hon. Merlita Ildefonso, Brgy. Captain of Brgy. Iiron, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro. PB Ildefonso expressed his gratitude towards the participants from BLGUs and MENRO of Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro and the Enforcement and Monitoring Section of DENR CENRO San Jose for giving time to attend at the said event and in order the capacitate the participants the knowledge in protecting the environment.

After that, CENR Officer Efren L. Delos Reyes commended the efforts and projects of the Task Force Cali-Kasan in the past events when it comes to the protection of the environment and natural resources. CENR Officer Delos Reyes also explained the importance of being deputized by the DENR because it would be a great collaboration and effort between the LGU and the DENR for the protection of the environment.

The first resource speaker was Prof. Doreen R. Mascareñas from Marinduque State University, who discussed the status of biodiversity in the Philippines including the benefits from it and ecosystem services by powerpoint presentation. She also emphasized that the



Philippines is one of the 18 mega-biodiverse countries in the world and rich with species of flora and fauna.

After the presentation of Prof. Mascareñas, the duties and responsibilities of DENROs and WEOs were discussed by Development Management Officer (DMO) IV Margie D. Ochoa from the DENR MIMAROPA Regional Office. DMO IV Ochoa presented the requirements for the application of individual and group volunteers as DENROs and WEOs like bio-data, PDS and police clearance. She also states that being a DENRO and WEO is not an easy job and will take courage and knowledge about the importance of the environment. DMO IV Ochoa also discussed the Presidential Decree 705 or the Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines specially Section 77 of the said decree which states the cutting, gathering and transporting of undocumented forest products is a major violation.

Following this, the Department Administrative Order (DAO) 97-32 or the Rules of Administrative Adjudication of illegal forest products and the machinery, equipment, tools and conveyances were discussed by none other than the Chief of Legal Division, DENR MIMARIP Region, Atty. Gandhi G. Flores. Atty. Flores discussed the salient features of the said DAO and explained the time when the DENROs or WEOs can apprehend and seize the illegal forest products and conveyances used in the illegal activity and emphasizes that a due process must occur in all proceedings. Atty. Flores also lauded the DENR CENRO San Jose for being pro-active and for submitting resolutions and filing of cases. Atty. Flores ended her topic while giving motivational messages to the participants.

The meeting on the first day was adjourned at 5:00 in the afternoon with Atty. Gandhi G. Flores closing the program and expressing gratitude to the participants who attended the said event.

On the second day at Labros Adventure Camp, Brgy. Concepcion, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro, the Rules and Procedure of Case Filing and Prosecution on Environmental Cases were briefly discussed by Atty. Joseph D. Delos Santos, the Deputy Chief of Legal Division from DENR MIMAROPA Region. Atty. Delos Santos discussed that in order for a valid search and arrest to be implemented properly a valid search warrant and warrant of arrest shall be issued by the Judge upon application by the interested parties. He also discussed that the search warrant should be implemented with particularity and general search warrant is not allowed. From this point, Atty. Delos Santos, states that the requirements for a valid arrest and search warrant must be strictly complied of before an arrest and search can be conducted by the Forest Rangers or the incoming DENRO's and WEO's and also by a normal citizen.

After that, another resource speaker from Tamaraw Conservation Program, Dr. Mikko Angelo G. Reyes, tackled the Basic Wildlife Identification, Care and Handling Techniques. But before he get started he introduce himself as the Provincial Veterinarian formerly practiced he's profession at Semirara. And afterwards the discussion started, when handling birds, in particular eagles. Dr. Reyes talks about the basic handling when a wild life has been captured or in rescue operations. Dr. Reyes also presented the Endemic flora and fauna and other wildlife that resides here in Mindoro Island. He talks in particular 3 species of wildlife, which are snakes, birds, and amphibians such as the Bayawak.

The final topic of the learning event was the Republic Act 9175 or the Chainsaw Act of 2002 that was briefly discussed by EMS Chief, Forester III Hector S. Aragon, Jr. Forester III Aragon first discussed the different classification of lands which are agricultural land, forest land, mineral land and natural parks. Forester Aragon also emphasized the Section 77 of Presidential Decree 705 and cited some previous arrest of illegal activities and cases that DENR CENRO San Jose took action. As to RA 9175 or the Philippine Chainsaw Act, Forester Aragon explains the violations mentioned in the said law which pertains to the illegal use of chainsaw without a valid permit from the office of the DENR CENRO San Jose, as well as



tampering of the chainsaw's serial numbers. Forester Aragonés, Just like PD 705 explains and illustrates by example their previous arrest and cases filed in violation of RA 9175.

The meeting on the second day was adjourned at 5:00 in the afternoon with CENR Officer Efren L. Delos Reyes citing the importance of the protection of our environment and natural resources, closing the program and expressing gratitude to the participants who attended the said event.

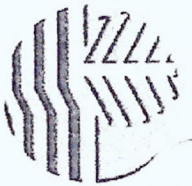
