










Figure I. The undersigned and PAMO personnel during the conduct of ground truthing within the habitats of corals, mangroves and seagrass.








Figure II. The undersigned and PAMO personnel during the conduct of assessment within the habitats of mangroves and seagrass.

The DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR), MIMAROPA, a national government agency with office at Brgy. Santa Monica, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan, Philippines represented by FELIZARDO B. CAYATOC in his capacity as Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer of DENR-PENRO Palawan, herein referred to as the FIRST PARTY,

And -

MARIEL M. PALADAN of legal age, Filipino and with residence address at Bgy. Poblacion, Aborlan, Palawan hereinafter referred to as "SECOND PARTY";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the First Party is in need of the services of the Second Party who shall perform the work not performed by the permanent personnel of the First Party:
