REPORT ON ATTENDANCE TO A WORKSHOP

Title of the Meeting/ Event: MPA Network- Level Enforcement Planning Workshop

OBJECTIVE OF THE WORKSHOP:

1. Formulation of MPA Network-Level Enforcement Plan

SALIENT POINTS OF THE DISCUSSION

- 1. Mr. Russel Climaco of WWF-Philippines presented the summary of activities they conducted in Roxas, Palawan for NEPMPAN project.
- 2. Proposed amendments to the Municipal Fisheries Ordinance of the Municipality of Roxas were presented by Atty Gerthie Anda and company from the Environmental Legal Assistance Center. These amendments include: Section 59. Functions of MFARMC, Section 69. Duties and Functions of Bantay Dagat, Sections 84-109. Penalties/ Fines, and Section 110. Establishment of Trust Fund. The participants decided wheter to retain or modify the proposed amendments.
- 3. The participants came up with their comments and proposals for the Northeast Palawan Marine Protected Area Environmental Law Enforcement and Operational Plan as the

a. Formulation of regulations like 1) joint monitoring; 2) identify fishery/ aquatic resources which need to be regulated (e.g. closed season, moratorium, collection of lobster fry, "pahibas")

b. MCS (monitoring, control, surveillance): joint enforcement team and plansharing of enforcement strategies, data on fishers, permit holders; based on enforcement strategies and targets, intelligence data can be shared

c. Agreement: rotating chairmanship; sharing of resources (equitable sharing based

on capacity/ IRA

d. Cyanide Detection Test Facility in Roxas

e. Commitment by every LGU to strictly enforce their municipal fisheries ordinances

- f. Public dissemination of NEPMPAN, ordinances, common violators/ culprits; use of social media, radio program on NEPMPAN efforts and initiatives
- 4. Bantay Dagat personnel of Roxas should be deputized based on the existing rules and regulations of BFAR and there should be a continuous deputization since they are under
- 5. Measures to ensure that informal settlers will not return to the area after receiving the compensation should be included in the implementing guidelines of the abovementioned ordinance.
