Please be informed that the PAMO-RIWS personnel conducted the synchronized Philippine Cockatoo population count from April 28, 2022 to September 23, 2022.

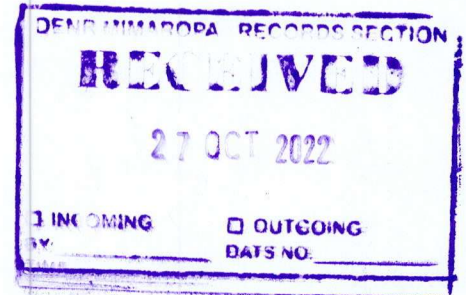

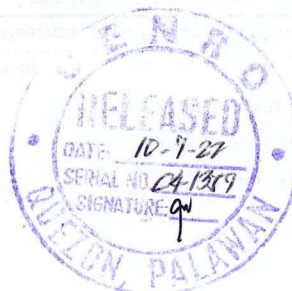

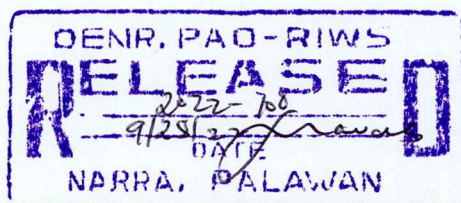

Please be informed that population count of Philippine Cockatoo for the 2nd and 3rd quarter were conducted in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary and in its adjacent barangays in the municipality of Narra. The synchronized Katala population count were done atleast twice a week from April 28, 2022 to September 23, 2022.

An average of 71 individuals was observed by the PAMO staff from the month of April to June 2022. As cited in the Patrol report of the KFI from January to April, individuals observed in adjacent barangays in the morning crossing from Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary and flies back in the afternoon ranges from 38 to 91 individuals. It was also noted that the individuals crossing to forage in mainland is lesser than the number observed in Rasa Island. On March to April 2022, 148 and 151 individuals was observed at the traditional roosting site, while on May 2022, 110 individuals were recorded and on June 2022, 190 individuals were the highest counts observed and recorded in the traditional roosting site by the wardens as cited in KFI Patrol Report.


On July 1 – September 23, 2022, an average of 55 Katala Individuals were observe crossing from the island to the mainland particularly in Uliran, Borbon, Parco Beach and Antipuluan Beach Areas. It was also noted that lesser number of Katala individuals flies back in the afternoon, than the number of individual crossing in the mainland starting from 5:00 o'clock in the morning. Most of the Katala individuals only forages in the mainland until past 10:00 o'clock in the morning and flies back early to the island as cited by Ms. Veronica Marcelo, one of the volunteers in KFI who regularly conducts synchronize Katala population counting activity. As cited in the KFI Patrol Report for the month of July 2022, the highest count of Katala in the traditional roosting site was 167 individuals. While on September 14, 2022, a total of 112 Katala individuals was observed roosting in the island.


On the other hand, citation of Katala individuals were observed and reported in residential areas of other barangays in Narra, Palawan particularly in Malinao, Malatgao and Ipilan.

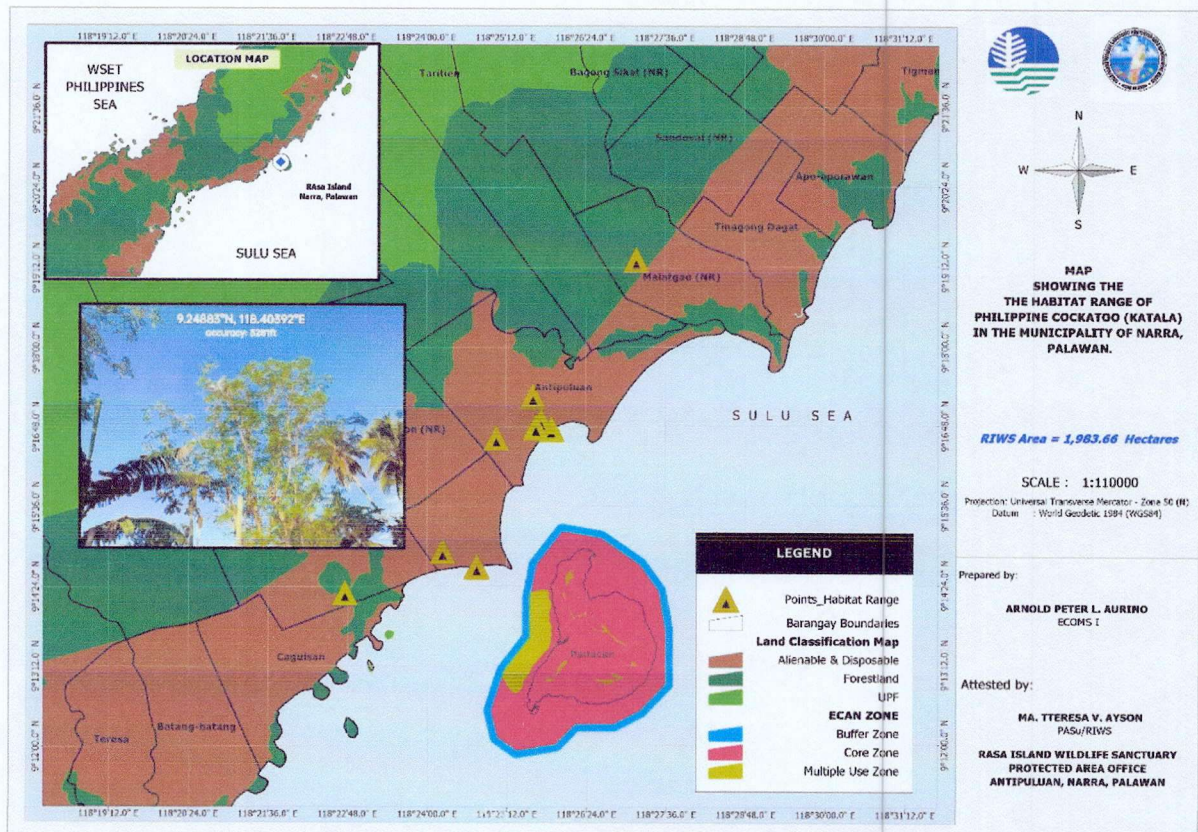
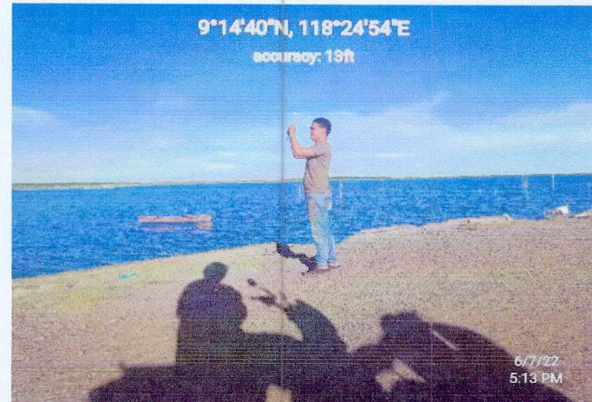
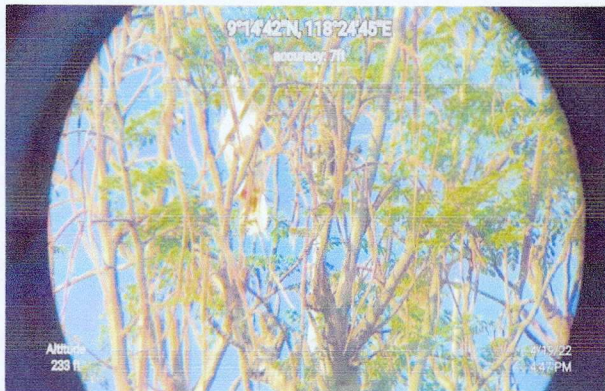
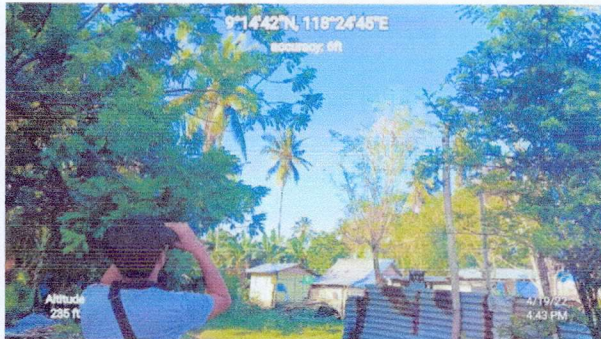
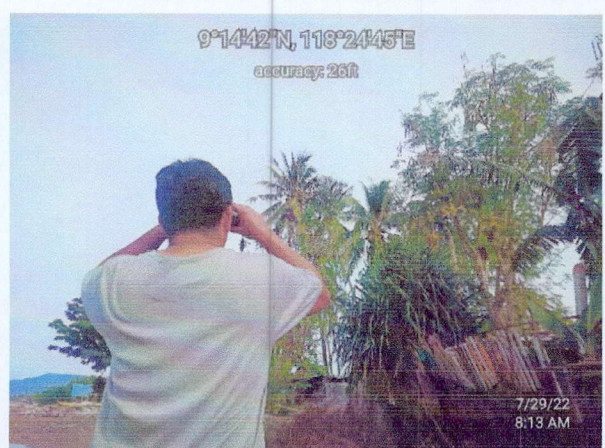
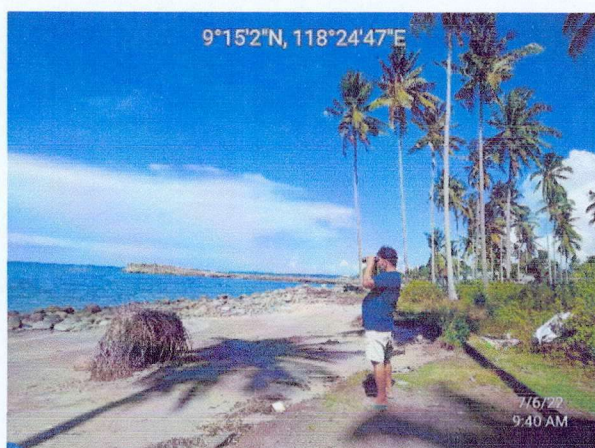


Figure 1. Map showing the Habitat Range of Philippine Cockatoo (Katala) in the Municipality of Narra, Palawan
