Please be informed that CDS Staff went to the Mangrove Eco-Park Workshop organized by LGU San Vicente on September 5, 2022 at Barangay Port Barton, San Vicente, Palawan.

The ECOMS I Corvera and FT II Sumandal lectured about mangrove conservation, the importance of mangroves and it current threats. The existing laws on mangrove were presented like the PD 705, PP 2152, RA 7161 and PCSD AO 11. It is explicitly stated that it is illegal to cut mangroves and mangroves are considered as core zones in the ECAN Map of PCSD. The LGU is reminded that no permanent structures should be erected in the mangrove area and no cutting or clearing shall not be allowed.


