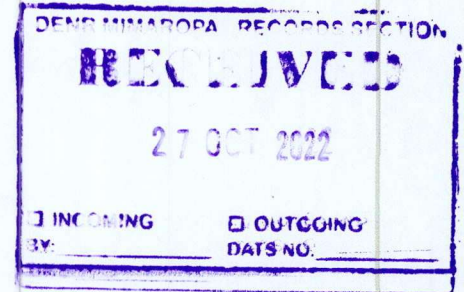

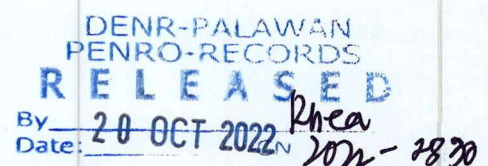


Respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated October 10, 2022 of Staff of PAMO regarding the above mentioned subject with attachment.

This is to inform that the undersigned MMPL Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) personnel successfully conducted the 3rd quarter BMS FGD, distributed 34 pcs sugar and coffee container part of the CEPA target under DENR Work and Financial Plan 2022 and also joined the IEC campaign of CENRO Quezon at Marayparay, Brgy. Tagusao, Quezon, Palawan last September 22, 2022

The FGD started at around 10 in the morning and was participated by 21 people consisted of 16 Males and 5 Females.

Three (3) main subjects were discussed during the FGD such as the wildlife observation, terrestrial resources and issues and concern inside the protected area.

In terms of wildlife observation, the community said that they now infrequently observe avifauna such as Blue napped parrot, Jungle fowl and Talking mynah in their areas and sadly, the same goes to terrestrial resources. One example is Ripitik and Salong which are used as fire fuel. The community said that they now have to go deeper in the forest before seeing the resources.

Going to the issues and concerns, the community told the MMPL staff that illegal land selling is rampant in their area. They even informed that some protected area occupants were allegedly sold their own land and open a new one just to be sold later on.

In response to the issue brought by the FGD participants, the MMPL staff suggested to settle the issue in accordance to their indigenous and customary laws if in case there is conflicting claims and considering that IPs are the ones involved in the illegal selling of land.

Furthermore, the PASu explained that transfer of claim or occupation within the protected area is only allowed between the IPs up to the nearest keen.

Before the FGD ended, the PAMO staff also distributed 15 pcs sugar and coffee container to the FGD participants as part of the CEPA target under DENR Work and Financial Plan 2022.


In the afternoon, at approximately 2:00 PM, the PAMO staff proceeded to the location of the IEC campaign wherein they shared the information pertaining to the profile and MMPL and distributed 19 pcs sugar and coffee container as prizes for the question and answer portion during the said activity.


The IEC campaign was jointly facilitated by CENRO Quezon personnel coming from Conservation and Development Section, Enforcement and Monitoring Section and Regulating and Permitting Section.


Subjects such as the DENR Mission and Vision/Organizational Structure, Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation, Ecological Solid Waste Management (RA 9003), Salient Features of PD 705, Land Management and Disposition, Rules and Regulations on Wood Charcoal, Legal Easement (DAO 2021-07), Safe Space Act (RA 11313), the Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape Profile and the NGP and Revised FMB Technical Bulletin No. 30 were discussed.


