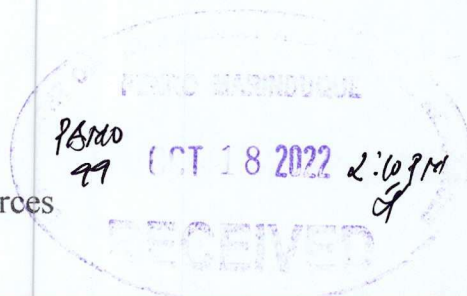

SUBJECT : REPORT OF COMMUNICATION, EDUCATION AND PUBLIC AWARENESS (CEPA) AND CONSULTATION MEETING AT BARANGAY BOL, BOAC, MARINDUQUE ON OCTOBER 13, 2022,

Respectfully submitted is the report of the Communication, Education, and Public Awareness (CEPA)/consultation meeting relative to the on-going implementation of the Inventory of Alienable and Disposable (A&D) Lands, Property, and Private Rights and the proposed installation of an additional 138 witness monuments within Marinduque Wildlife Sanctuary (MWS).

Please be informed that on October 13, 2022, the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) have conducted CEPA/consultation meeting held at Brgy. Boi, Boac, Marinduque. This was attended by representatives of the concerned LGU headed by Barangay Chairperson Crisostomo N. Monterey, stakeholders from the barangay and PAMO staff and personnel. Before proceeding with the main activity, I oriented the participants through powerpoint presentation on the purpose of the meeting/CEPA. I started my lecture with the introduction of our protected area encompassing the legal basis for the proclamation, its profile, area and coverage, administrative jurisdiction (*Municipalities and Barangays covered*) and the management of said resources (*the composition of the MWS-Protected Area Management Board (PAMB)*). I subsequently shared about the biodiversity (*fauna & flora*) as the MWS is considered a Key Biodiversity Area and an Important Bird Area (*KBA & IBA*) due to the presence of trigger species such as the *Philippine Duck*, *Philippine Cockatoo*, and *Green-Raquet Tail*. I also presented the locally extinct species, locally-known species of birds, including mammals, and several types of trees that can be found therein, as well as some of the other features of MWS.

On the other hand, I elaborated the ecosystem services when it comes to provisioning, regulating, cultural and supporting services that our protected area provides to the communities inhabiting within and nearby MWS. I also presented the challenges that are faced by the PAMO

in the management and protection of protected area and the different prohibited acts specified in Section 20 of the Expanded National Integrated Protected Area System (ENIPAS) Act of 2018. Likewise, the management interventions being done by the PAMO to address the identified issues and concerns were also presented.


Relative to the main purpose of the meeting, which is the Inventory of Alienable & Disposable (A & D) Lands, Property, and Private Rights within the protected area or Marinduque Wildlife Sanctuary (MWS) for CY 2022, I presented the activities performed by the PAMO as of July 2022 in connection with said activities. It is for the Protected Area (PA) managers to have data or information that will serve as the basis for policy making in order to create appropriate guidelines, rules, and regulations to effectively manage MWS. Included in my report is the list of claimants who were included in the cadastral lots and the map showing those lots covered by the protected area.

Relative to the demarcation project, the undersigned informed the attendees that as of this year, a total of 408 monuments have been demarcated within the boundaries of MWS and 283 signages have been installed. In addition, I added that an additional 138 witness monuments will be installed in MWS this year.

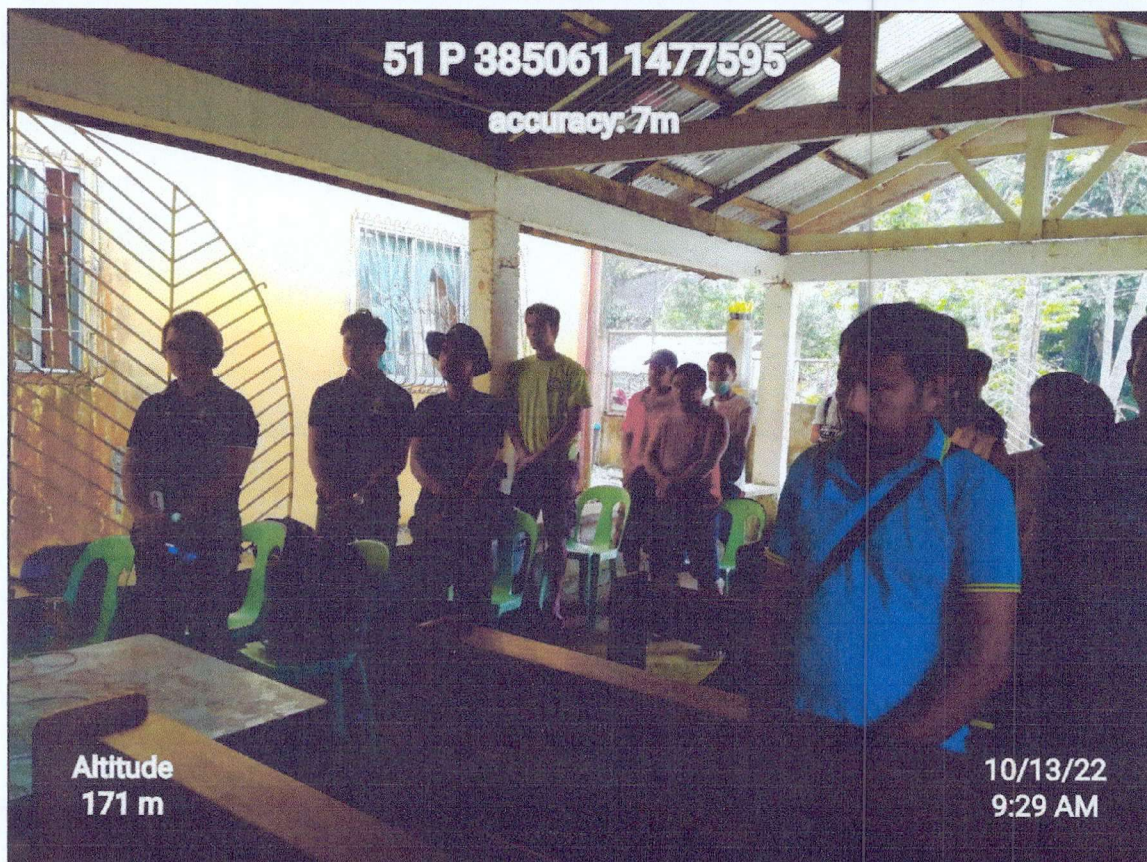

EMS II Alvin L. Pergis discussed the profile of MWS.



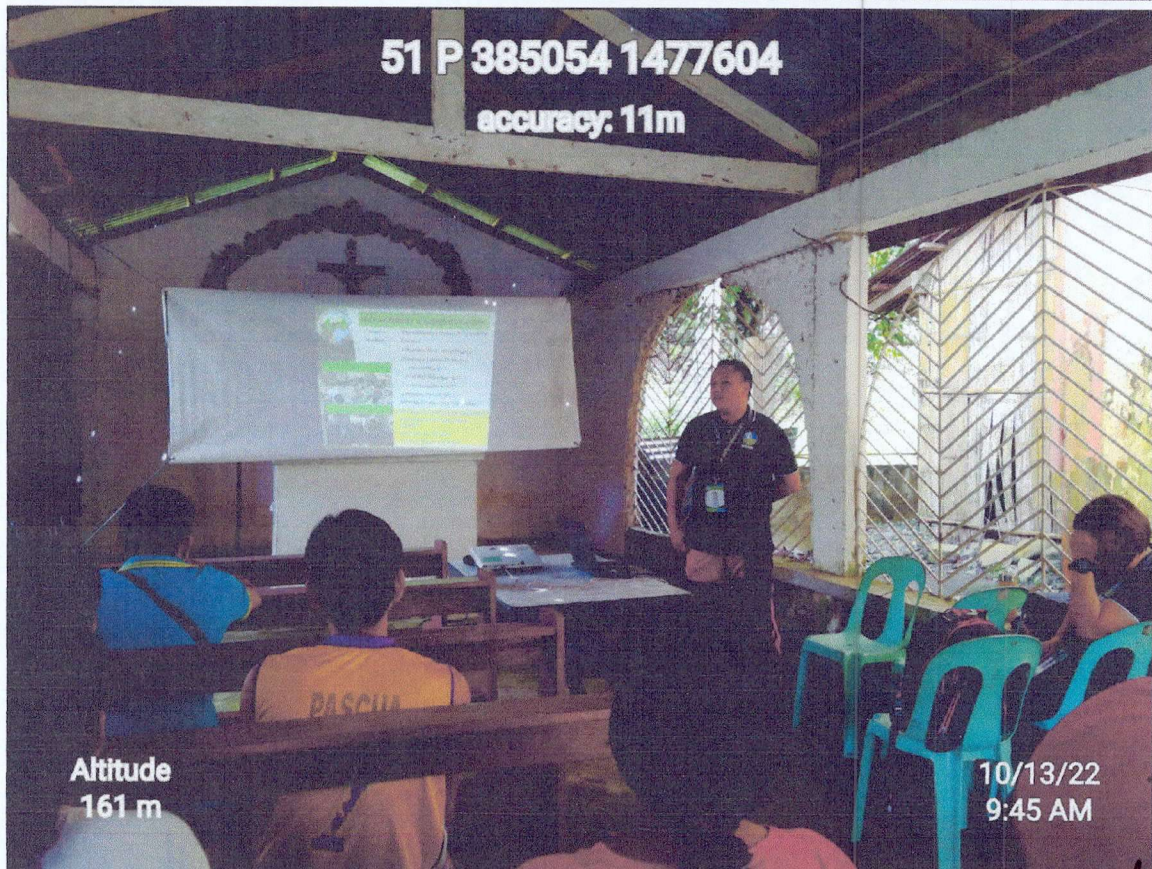
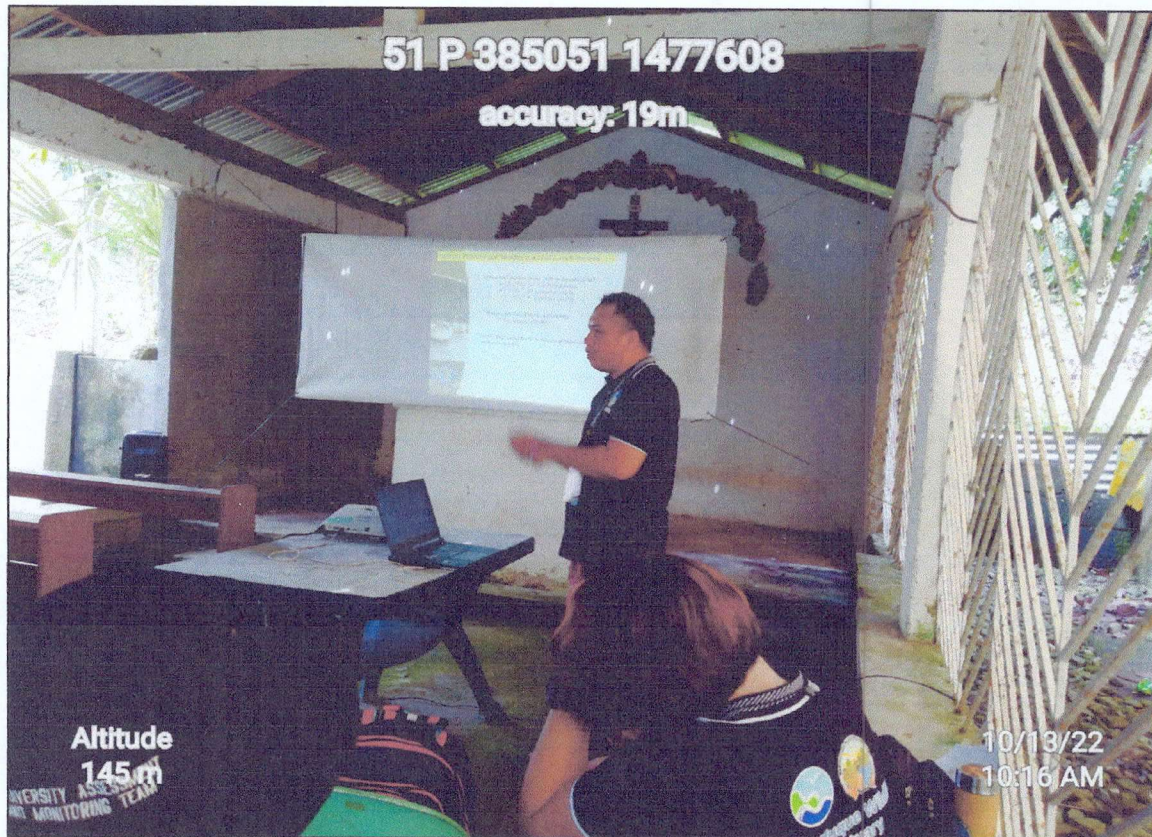
