

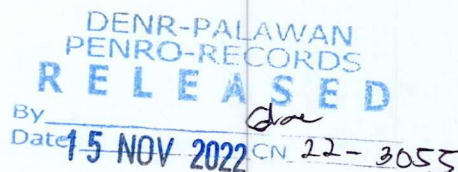

- The walls and ceilings of photo booth for crocodile holding photo opportunities damaged by typhoon were repaired and holes of roof were plastered;


E. In-Situ Conservation Activities

- i. August 1 - Joined the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) Team in the presentation to the Members of Sanggunian Bayan of Bataraza the report of validation of crocodile sightings in Brgys. Taratak and Rio Tuba;
- ii. August 10 - joined the assessment of situation regarding an accidentally-captured crocodile and carried out intensive IEC activity in Brgy. Buenavista, Puerto Princesa City, as per request of PCSD;
- iii. August 11-12 - participated in the conduct of crocodile population count, habitat survey and mapping, and CEPA activities in Brgy. Malitub, Bataraza, as per invitation of PENRO-Palawan;
- iv. August 17 – joined the river transect and conducted IEC activity in Brgy. Macarascas, Puerto Princesa City, as per request of PCSDS;
- v. August 22-23 – Animal Keeper III participated as Resource Person in the training on Basic Wildlife Identification and Handling conducted by Conservation International in Brgy. Aribugos, Brooke's Point, as per request of PCSDS;
- vi. August 29-September 1 – joined in the search for problem crocodile, investigation and assessment of situation, and in the conduct of IEC activity in Brgy. Canipaan, Rizal, as per request of PCSDS
- vii. September 11-17 – Animal Keeper III participated as a Resource Person in a Practicum on Human-Crocodile Conflict (HCC) Management conducted by Biodiversity Management Bureau

F. Other Notable Activities

- i. The repair of breeding pens in P43/44 is ongoing, but due to frequent heavy rains, the draining of ponds has always been postponed;
- ii. Tall grasses in breeding pen area were mowed using the grass cutter borrowed from PENRO-Palawan;
