


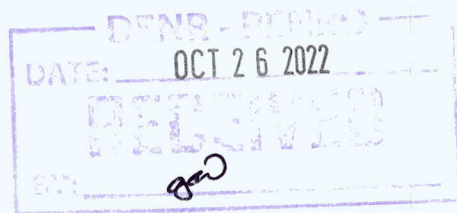

109 **I. PRELIMINARIES**

110  
111 The 3<sup>rd</sup> PAMB En Banc Meeting for CY 2022 of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park (MGGNP)  
112 was opened with an invocation then followed by singing the Philippine National Anthem with  
113 the aid of an Audio Visual Presentation (AVP).

PASu Malvin R. Rocero first acknowledged the presence of the MIMAROPA Regional Executive Director, Lormelyn E. Claudio, CESO IV, the three (3) Municipal Mayors of Magdiwang, Cajidiocan, and San Fernando, OIC PENR Officer Arnoldo A. Blaza, Jr., National Agencies representative, Academe, NGOs and POs, IP Representative, Barangay Officials from the seventeen (17) barangays, Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) staff, members of the secretariat, guests and visitors.

Hon. Arthur R. Tansiongco, M.D., Municipal Mayor of Magdiwang gave his welcome address for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter MGGNP PAMB En Banc meeting. He welcomed the PAMB Members and stated his gladness for sparing their time and effort to attend the 3rd Quarter PAMB En Banc meeting of MGGNP particularly since the meeting was in face to face since the pandemic. He also expressed gladness since the other two mayors from San Fernando and Cajidiocan were present to discuss important matters relating to the protection and conservation of the Protected Area. He also thanked and welcomed the Barangay Captains who are members of the PAMB for travelling to Magdiwang to attend the Meeting.

Hon. Atty. Marvin Gregg Ramos of Cajidiocan then gave a short message. He first acknowledged the PAMB members present during the meeting. Then, he stated that this is his first time attending the PAMB Meeting since he is a newly-elected Mayor of Cajidiocan and his presence in the meeting is a dedication of his commitment in the protection of our environment particularly of the Island of Sibuyan. He further stated that when we talk about Mt. Guiting-Guiting, it is also synonymous in protecting Sibuyan Island. The PAMB of MGGNP should not be limited in protecting the Park but also extend their commitment in protecting Sibuyan particularly when it comes to the issue of mining in the Island. He emphasized that the three Mayors were against irresponsible and unregulated mining. However, he pledged the people to understand them since there is a certain agency that regulates and monitors mining activities/permits. Hopefully, he then hoped that in the meeting, there will be a unity among the members of the Board to address the issue on the protection of Sibuyan against irresponsible and unregulated mining activities since as Local Chief Executives; they are here to support the people and the welfare of their constituents. And if there are any questions, they are much willing to answer it provided that it will be raised in proper means and not through the use of social media. Lastly, he thanked the Board for providing him an opportunity and he hoped that there will be a fruitful discussion of agenda that will benefit the MGGNP.

Then, Hon. Nanette Tansingco, M.D gave her message. She acknowledged the presence of Regional Executive Director Lormelyn E. Claudio, CESO IV, the two mayors, guests, visitors, and representatives from other government agencies. She stated that after many years of hiatus from politics, she is now present in attending the PAMB Meeting and as per her observation; it is very different from the past because of the mining issue. During her past term as mayor, there was also an issue in mining but it was abrupt. Then, she stated that she wanted to reiterate and emphasize what Hon. Ramos said that as the PAMB was created for the protection of Mt. Guiting-Guiting thus most of the agenda will be about the protected area. However, since MGGNP is synonymous to Sibuyan, the environment of the whole island should be taken into account. She stated that the PAMB members present during the meeting had different advocacies but had the same objective – the protection of MGGNP and the whole island of Sibuyan. She also informed the Board of the Task Force that she created, “Task Force Kalikasan”, which is composed of representative from different agencies in Sibuyan Island designated to protect the island’s environment. She also stated that as government officials, they are always vigilant and they are not silent when it comes to the issue of mining in San Fernando. Even though they are not in social media, they are working hand in hand for the protection and conservation of the environment. She also stated that last Tuesday, the officials of the three municipalities of Sibuyan met with the Regional Director of the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) and had an Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) Campaign. Together with the Officials, they went to the MGB to make it clear that Sibuyan is against mining and she inquired if there is any possibility to stop the exploration period of Altai Mining Corporation. No less than the director of the MGB said that the exploration is part of the process thus it will be difficult to halt the exploration as it is one of the processes involved in the MPSA given on 2009. She then stated



that rest assured, the LGUs are working hand in hand that hopefully it will not have a negative impact on the island. She assured that the three Mayors are one in opposing the irresponsible and destructive mining in Sibuyan Island. She then hoped that, after the meeting, there will be a clear understanding to all of the PAMB members that they are one in protecting the beautiful Sibuyan Island.

OIC PENR Officer Arnoldo A. Blaza, Jr. gave a short message. He stated that this meeting is an opportunity to share and discuss on what are things that will be beneficial for the biodiversity of MGGNP.

Philippine National Police, Cornel Domingo then gave a short message, he stated that in behalf of PNP Regional Director, he is giving his outmost gratitude for being invited in the meeting and extended his help in the protection and conservation of the protected area. He then stated that it will be an opportunity for him to be informed on the situation of MGGNP and the issues being tackled on the meeting.

DENR Regional Executive Director and PAMB Chairperson gave an inspiring message. She encouraged the PAMB Members to make the most and the best out of the meeting. As based on the agenda, she thinks there will be a lengthy discussion. She also believed s that the PAMB of MGGNP is doing its role in the protection of Mt. Guiting-Guiting as she had seen and witnessed the dedication of the MGGNP PAMB, especially Hon. Mayor Arthur Tansiongco that left an impression during the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter PAMB Meeting of 2022 because he is geared and firm towards the protection of the natural park. She then thanked the PAMB Members for being present for the meeting and for putting the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter PAMB Meeting on top of their priority list.

## **II. MEETING PROPER**

### **A. Introduction of PAMB En Banc Members, DENR Staff and Secretariat**

Member of the secretariat EcoMS I Nieves F. Penuliar acknowledged and introduced the members of the board in attendance headed by the Regional Executive Director, Lormelyn E. Claudio, CESO IV, the three (3) Municipal Mayors of Magdiwang, Cajidiocan, and San Fernando, National Agencies, representative of Academe, NGOs and POs, Barangay Officials from seventeen (17) barangays, Protected Area Management Office personnel, OIC PENR Officer Arnoldo A. Blaza, Jr., and members of the secretariat and visitors.

### **B. Roll call and Call to Order**

EcoMS I Nieves F. Penuliar officially roll-called the attendance of PAMB members from the Regional Office, Offices of the Congressman and Governor, the three (3) Municipal Mayors (Cajidiocan, Magdiwang and San Fernando), Department Heads of National Government Agencies, Non-Government Organizations, Peoples Organizations, Brgy. Local Government Units, Academe and Indigenous Peoples. Out of thirty-five (35) regular PAMB en banc members, twenty-five (25) were present; hence, a quorum was declared.

### **C. Reading and approval of the minutes of the previous meeting (May 18, 2022)**

Regional Executive Director, Lormelyn E. Claudio, CESO IV, and PAMB Chairperson presided the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter PAMB Meeting of MGGNP. The presiding officer asked the Board if there are any comments, suggestions or objections on the minutes of previous meeting. The PAMB Members were given copies of the minutes before hand for their review and reference. Since there were no comments and objections from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter PAMB En Banc minutes, Hon. Rommel Augustus Radan moved for the approval of the minutes of the previous meeting, it was seconded by Hon. Arthur R. Tansiongco and duly approved by the majority members of the PAMB.

### **D. Matters arising from the previous meeting**



Hon. Lormelyn E. Claudio, CESO IV, announced to proceed to PASu report on the agreement reached during the previous meeting.

**E. Report of the Protected Area Superintendent (PASu) on the agreement reached during previous meeting on May 18, 2022**

PASu Malvin R. Rocero reported that the following resolutions numbered from MGGNP-PAMB En Banc Resolution No. 2022-04 to 2022-07 and minutes of the previous meeting dated Mmay 18, 2022 were submitted to the Regional Executive Director/PAMB Chairperson for approval, thru the PENRO:

1. **PAMB Resolution No. 2022 – 04, S. 2022-** “A Resolution Approving The Work And Financial Plan For C.Y. 2023 of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park, Sibuyan Island, Romblon Amounting To Three Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (P 380,000.00) Representing The 75% And 100% Share of IPAF Collection From November 01, 2019 to February 28, 2022 for the Repair of Land Rover”;
2. **PAMB Res. No. 2022-05, S. 2022** “A Resolution granting Special Permit to Climb Mt. Guiting-Guiting to Mr. Ramoncito Ruiz and PAMO Personnel to conduct biodiversity and trail safety assessment.”
3. **PAMB Resolution No. 2022-06, S. 2022** “A Resolution Requesting ASEAN Ministers of Environment, NCCA, and DENR to assist the PAMB in the proposed proclamation of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park as ASEAN Heritage Park”.
4. **PAMB Resolution No. 2022-07, S. 2022-** “ A Resolution Approving The Work And Financial Plan For C.Y. 2022 of Mt. **F. Approval of the Agenda**

Hon. Lormelyn E. Claudio, CESO IV, then asked the Board if there are any additional agenda other than the five (5) agenda presented to be discussed in the meeting. Hon. Rommel Augustus Radan moved for the approval of the agenda, it was seconded by Hon. Samson Romero and approved by the majority members of the PAMB.

**G. Meeting Agenda**

1. **Reporting of LAWIN and foot patrolling within the buffer zones and inside Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park**

Forester I Rolly Morales reported the updates for LAWIN patrolling and foot patrolling within the proposed buffer zones and inside MGGNP from May 19, 2022 to August 23, 2022. There is a total of 36km patrolled from July 21 to August 23, 2022, totaling to 388.40 kms patrolled. He explained that the data to be presented are from the data generated from patrollers using LAWIN. He showed the map of Sibuyan Island and explained the area inside the protected area and timberland. He explained that the triangular shapes shown in the map are the area where threats, such as apprehensions, are found. However, since there had been some technical difficulties, the picture inside the map were not shown/projected. Then, Hon. Tansingco asked if For. Morales can state the municipalities and barangays where the illegal activities took place to inform the PAMB. For. Morales stated that in Brgy. Cambajao, the patrollers apprehended 20 pieces of lumber in June 2022. In Brgy. España, 23 pieces were apprehended on August 2022. In Brgy. Cambajao, there are 4 pieces (80bdf) apprehended on August 2022. Here further stated that most apprehensions happened in Brgy. Epaña, San Fernando, Romblon. Then, For. Morales explained their action taken was continuous patrolling. Hon. Claudio then asked PASu Rocero on status of the apprehended forest products and if there were any additional action taken, if there were filed



cases or if the Office issued Notice of Violation. For. Morales explained that most of the cases, the forest products were abandoned, however, there was a confiscated tricycle since it was carrying charcoal. The presiding officer then asked for a follow up of the status of the apprehension and PASu Rocero stated that they already have schedules for administrative hearing on the apprehended forest products. Then, the presiding officer suggested to conduct checkpoints in the hotspot areas. Hon. Ramos then asked to be recognized. He asked Forester Morales that since they are discussing accomplishment on patrolling, he asked the specific location the apprehension happened, if the forest products were apprehended within the private residence (houses) and such. For. Morales answered that the forest products are commonly apprehended along the highway, and sometimes can be found abandoned in the trail. Hon. Ramos then asked if they were found within the proposed buffer zones, protected area, and timberland. For. Morales then informed that some of the apprehensions were not in the mentioned areas, because there are some apprehensions of abandoned forest products that happened upon provided information from concerned citizens, Brgy. Officials, and LGU Park Rangers. For. Morales then reported that the patrolling can also happen within the timberland and not limited only on the protected area and they also act on reports concerning the environment of Sibuyan. For. Morales also said that when apprehending, they also check the species of the forest products to verify if they are naturally grown or planted trees. Hon. Claudio commented that based on the LAWIN Report, there should be more coordination with the LGUs and BLGUs on the patrolling and monitoring of illegal forest activities. While also strengthening the monitoring activities of the BLGUs and LGUs against illegal forest activities. Hon. Tansingco then asked if there were apprehensions inside the protected area and within the proposed buffer zones and highlighted that the patrollers should strengthen the patrolling and apprehension to ensure that no trees are cut inside the protected area, timberland, and proposed buffer zones. Then, Hon. Elizabeth Ibañez of Bayay Sibuyanon asked to follow up the status of resolution on the designation of timberland and agricultural forests surrounding Mt. Guiting-Guiting as proposed buffer zones. PASu Rocero answered this and informed the Board that the resolution has been approved in the Regional level and it will be submitted to the Biodiversity Management Bureau for endorsement to the DENR Secretary after the boundaries are checked by the PAMBCS. PASu Rocero then stated that on the report of For. Morales, that even though apprehensions happen in the local community or in the high way, when verified, the species of the logs/lumbers are from the timberland and protected area. And based on the LAWIN Report/Application, a lot of threats and cuttings are happening within the proposed buffer zones thus the area should be declared as MGGNP's buffer zone to ensure that less cutting will happen. PASu Rocero also made it clear that when the cutting happened inside, within, or outside the protected area, cutting trees without permit is still illegal and a violation of PD 705 and its IRR. Hon. Claudio agreed with this and reiterated that even the area is beyond the proposed buffer zones, we should still protect it in order to conserve the environment of Sibuyan. Hon. Claudio also shared to the Board the Application called Earth Ranger that was launched in PENRO Cayatoc, Palawan two (2) months ago, it was established in collaboration with the USAID. When using the Earth Ranger Application, anyone could do the reporting of illegal forest activities in the area. It helps in the enhancement of monitoring in Palawan particularly in Puerto Princesa, and it could also be used in Romblon in assistance with LAWIN. OIC PENR Officer Arnoldo A. Blaza, Jr. agreed to this and stated that the PENRO will coordinate with PENRO Palawan regarding the application of Earth Ranger. Hon. Mary Jane Rocero then suggested to have an outpost in the boundary of Brgy. Cantada and Silum to ensure that the illegal activities will be minimized in their area. Hon. Elizabeth Ibañez moved to pass **PAMB Resolution No. 2022-08, S. of 2022 "A Resolution Enhancing the Patrolling System against illegal forest activities in the Protected Area, Timberland, and beyond the proposed Buffer Zones through using/installation of Earth Ranger Application and Installation of Outpost in the boundary of Brgy. Silum and Cantagda"** it was seconded by Hon. Mary Jane Rocero and approved by the majority of the Board.

## 2. Proposed Tree Plantation with every BLGU/LGU

EcoMS I Nieves F. Penuliar then presented the rationale behind the proposed tree plantation of every BLGU/LGU. On the previous PAMB Meeting, the benefits were briefly discussed by PASu Rocero; if tree plantation will be established by every BLGU/LGU, in a few years' time,



it could become a communal forest and can be one of the solutions to help decrease the illegal forest activities inside the protected area. Hon. Tansingco agreed on this proposal and stated that in the past years, the LGU San Fernando had already established a tree nursery for this kind of project. They had already planted the seedlings from their nursery on several coastal areas together with PNP, BFP, and Coast Guard. Hon. Tansingco also plans to implement the said project to every barangay in San Fernando as the Barangays could also sell the seedlings and become as one of their sources of income. She also stated that since LGU San Fernando already had an existing tree nursery, she asked if technical assistance from the DENR could be provided. Hon. Claudio stated that the PAMB could pass a resolution to concretize the said project and reminded the Body that there is a Presidential Decree 1153 (PD 1153), Requiring the Planting of one Tree every month for Five (5) consecutive years by every citizen of the Philippines. The PAMB could pass a resolution reiterating the implementation of the Presidential Decree 1153 in Sibuyan Island in order to remind the local community that they are tasked to plant trees. Hon. Claudio also reminded the participants that on September 13, 2022, there will be a simultaneous National Tree Planting Activity and the DENR could help the LGUs locate specific sites for the Tree Planting to be spearheaded by the DILG. Hon. Claudio suggested that school areas could be used for this kind of project and it will further encourage the youth to embrace the concept of tree growing and the protection and establishment of forests. Hon. Arthur Tansiongco then stated that in Magdiwang, he had required the parents to plant ten (10) trees every year and he plans to continue the program. Magdiwang had already two (2) sites for this project thus the project will continue. He is now asking the barangay captains to adopt this project/activity in their respective barangays and every barangay captain should plant fifty (50) trees every year during Arbor Day. Hon. Claudio commended the projects of the mayors regarding the tree plantations in their respective municipalities. Hon. Rodne Galicia then raised the idea that the term "Tree Growing" should be used. He then asked the LGUs of their particular FLUPS and CLUPS because communal forests should have been integrated in FLUPs and CLUPs as well as the identification of municipal production forests. He also mentioned the role of the National Greening Program (NGP) that promotes the reforestation of forests in the country. It would be better that these matters will be provided of assistance by DENR because in the long term, we need to look back to FLUP and CLUP so tree planting and growing will be adopted by the municipalities. Hon. Claudio agreed to this as there should be a municipal production forest that will cater to the lumber needs of the community. The PAMO will then assist the LGUs on the tree planting/growing and the PENR Office will assist in the identification of the land/area to be used as identified in the LGU's FLUP and CLUP. Thus, Hon. Joven Rodeo moved to pass **PAMB Resolution No 2022-09 S. 2022, "A Resolution to identify a common area of every LGU as Municipal Production Forest in Accordance to FLUP and CLUP and Enhancement of already established Programs of every LGU relating to Tree Planting/Growing"**. It was seconded by Hon. Ornito Ramilo and approved by the majority of the Board.

### **3. Proposed continuation of Memorandum of Agreement with the three LGUs amounting to P1,000,000.00 each year**

Hon. Tansingco raised that she agrees on the continuation of Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) however, for this year, they can only provide P500,000.00 similar to the past MOA. They cannot increase the financial allocation from P500,000.00 to P 1,000,000.00 yet because there has been a decrease of funding given to the LGUs on their IRA. She suggested that the financial allocation stated in the MOA should remain to P500,000.00 because they had already submitted the funding allocation for 2023. Hon. Tansiongco and Hon. Ramos agreed to this since Magdiwang and Cajidiocan had a decrease in funding as well but they agreed to increase the funding once their IRA increased. Hon. Claudio gratefully thanked the three (3) Mayors for allocating budget for programs that aims to protect and conserve MGGNP. Hon. Rodne Galicia then raised the idea if the PAMB could ask for a financial commitment from the Provincial Government through a MOA similar to the MOA between the LGUs of Magdiwang. Since the Governor is part of the PAMB as well, maybe the Board can ask the Provincial Government of fund allocation for the protection and conservation of MGGNP. Hon. Claudio then instructed PASu Rocero to coordinate with the Provincial Government and the Office of the Congressman as well regarding this matter. She also stated that the PAMO should come up with the proposed



Work and Financial Plan for the Provincial Government. Utilization on the projects contained in the MOA should also be included in the presentation of the Work and Financial Plan in order to give the Provincial Governor and Congressman an orientation on how the fund will be utilized. She also commented that the utilization report should be given yearly to show the LGUs and the PAMB on how the fund was used. PASu Rocero stated that on August 16, 2022, he was instructed by the PENR Officer to attend a meeting with the Provincial Government of Romblon and he proposed a P1,000,000.00 budget similar to the MOA of the three (3) LGUs, the proposal had included the hiring of Park Ranger and this proposal had been submitted to the Provincial Planning Officer. Then, Hon. Ireen Roa asked if the members of the Indigenous People could be included as beneficiaries of the programs of the MOA such as conduct of IEC and hiring of Park Ranger since they do not have an allocated budget. She further stated that the IEC would be about mining since it is one of the pressing issues as of today. Hon. Ramos and Hon. Tansingco stated that LGU Cajidiocan and San Fernando will find ways to provide budget for the IEC of the IP community. They agreed to the sentiments of Hon. Roa since the ancestral domain is also inside the protected area and they will include them in the programs under the LGU. Hon. Ramonito Gubaton moved **PAMB Resolution No. 2022-10 “A Resolution Adopting the Renewal of Memorandum of Agreement with the Three (3) LGUs of Sibuyan Island (Magdiwang, Cajidiocan, and San Fernando) for CY 2023 for the protection and conservation maintenance of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park amounting to Php 500,000.00”**, it was seconded by Hon. Johnny D. Riano and approved by the majority of the Board. Then, Hon Darwin Ruado passed **PAMB Resolution No. 2022-11 “A Resolution Requesting the Provincial Government of Romblon on a financial commitment for the Protection and Conservation of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park”**, it was seconded by Hon. Rommel Augustus Radan and approved by the majority of the Board.

#### **4. Reiterating the Passing of Sangguniang Bayan Ordinance on the continuous financial support of LGUs to the protection and conservation of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park**

Hon. Arthur Tansiongco stated that the tree (3) Mayors had already talked about the passing of Sangguniang Bayan Ordinance on the continuous financial support of the LGUs for the protection and conservation of MGGNP and that they will lobby it to their respective Sangguniang Bayan Members.

#### **5.Preparation for the celebration of 27<sup>th</sup> Proclamation Anniversary of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park;**

EcoMS I Penuliar presented the previous activities conducted by the three (3) municipalities during the Annual Celebration on the Proclamation of. For CY 2023, the host municipality will be LGU San Fernando and among the proposed activities that they will conduct are; IEC (Dalaw Turo) with DepEd, Tree Planting, Clean Up, and Holy Mass. Hon. Tansingco openly accepted to host the 27<sup>th</sup> Proclamation Anniversary of Mt. Guiting - Guiting as Natural Park and agreed on the proposed activities. Proposal and formal meeting with LGU San Fernando will be conducted for the preparation of the Anniversary Proclamation.

#### **6. Other Matters**

Hon. Elizabeth Ibañez raised other matters after the discussion of the main agenda. Her first inquiry was about the status of the PASu assigned in MGGNP PAMO, secondly, the issue of threats of mining in Sibuyan Island particularly in the Barangays involved in the PAMB. Hon. Claudio asked to specify the details on the mining in Sibuyan mentioned by Hon. Ibañez. Hon. Ibañez explained that at present, to her knowledge there are several mining applications in Sibuyan Island aside from the exploration of Altai Mining. The applications are in Brgys. Otod, Agtiwa, España San Fernando, in Brgys. Cantagda, Danao, and Cambajao, Cajidiocan, and Brgy. Silum, Magdiwang. Even though the applications are not inside the protected area, the area being applied for had included some of the proposed buffer zones and allowing the mining activities within the proposed buffer zones will greatly affect the protected area and Sibuyan Island. To her knowledge, the mining permits are for open pit mining and large scale mining that will be a huge risk in the protected area. She further stated that the establishment of tree plantation and



457 municipal production forest will be useless if we allow the mining activities to happen. Thus, the  
458 PAMB should make an action in order to counter the permits, and since the three mayors are  
459 already present, it would be better if the Local Chief Executives will guide the PAMB Members  
460 in crafting a solution on this issue. At present, the Municipalities had issued resolutions against  
461 destructive and irresponsible mining as well as the Barangays. Hon. Tansiongco then stated that  
462 maybe the Body could make a resolution against mining activities in Sibuyan since the three  
463 mayors were already present in the meeting to further protect the Island of Sibuyan. Hon.  
464 Claudio then stated that the PAMB is created to carry out the intent of the NIPAS Act for  
465 MGGNP, and while the mining is the concern of the leaders, as representatives of their  
466 constituents, it would be better if the issue on mining will be dealt separately. She explained that  
467 the issue on mining which is still on the exploratory stage was emphasized during the meeting  
468 with the Mayors and their representatives a week before. It was explained to them that the status  
469 of the exploration of Altai is still in the exploration stage. As government employees and public  
470 servants, we should uphold integrity of other national laws that we carry out, like Presidential  
471 Decree 1586, Establishing an Environmental Impact Statement System, including other  
472 Environmental Management related measures and for other purposes, also known as the  
473 Philippine Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) System, is still the most thorough system of  
474 any development project in the given area and is being recognized for being a tool on the  
475 assessment of impact on the geo-physical, biodiversity, and socio-economic effects on the  
476 environment. Thus, it was explained in the previous meeting the activity of Altai is still in  
477 Exploration Stage and stopping the activity will pre-empt the other activities that Altai needs for  
478 their application. We also need to follow the established law mentioned in PD 1586 and its rules  
479 and regulations for other proposed projects. It was also agreed in the meeting that there will be a  
480 ground consultation on the Exploration Permit as there is a separate procedure on the EIA  
481 System that a consultation is needed. This activity is also known as Public Scoping, a proponent  
482 lead and will investigate the content of the Environmental Impact Assessment that will happen in  
483 the ground/field. Hon. Claudio also emphasized that as government officials like the DENR, it is  
484 also their duty to uphold the National Law and passing a resolution that bans/opposes the  
485 Exploration Stage could pre-empt the process of PD 1586. Further the PAMB may not be the  
486 body that should ventilate on it, instead she suggested that the Local Leaders could come up with  
487 the resolution in their respective municipalities. Hon Claudio then clarified that she was only  
488 explaining the process for the understanding of everyone in the meeting. She also restated that as  
489 part of DENR and government officials, we are part of implementing the National Law such as  
490 Mineral Production Sharing Agreement and opposing it through a resolution contradicts the  
491 essence of implementing the said policy. Hon. Ibañez then stated that prior to the meeting, some  
492 PAMB members had been planning to pass a resolution regarding the mining activities in  
493 Sibuyan because it might affect the protected area and since some areas of the proposed buffer  
494 zones is included in their application. Hon. Ibañez added that local communities had already  
495 passed resolutions regarding the mining activities in their areas and had been vigilant in signing  
496 papers/attendance sheets as they worry it might be used for pro-mining campaign. Hon. Claudio  
497 then explained that the exploration within the proposed buffer zones cannot be mapped out since  
498 they are still in their exploration stage. Since there is still no ECC application that states the  
499 bounds, we cannot still determine if the area is within the proposed buffer zones and we need to  
500 check first the project proposal of Altai. She also stressed that there will be a consultation that  
501 will happen in the ground as committed to Hon. Tansingco and the LGUs to be spearheaded by  
502 the Mines and Geosciences Bureau, PENRO Romblon, and Environment Management Bureau  
503 MIMAROPA that aims to explain and monitor their programs/projects. There will also be a  
504 committee/task force spearheaded by Hon. Tansingco and is composed by the representative of  
505 local leaders (Sangguniang Bayan Members), the DENR PENRO, and NGOs that will join the  
506 trekking to the area to check and monitor the extent of the exploration activity. Hon. Claudio  
507 then indicated that we need to be objective in these times and we need to carry out the mandate  
508 of DENR as well as protection of Mt. Guiting-Guiting and spearhead the implementation of  
509 ENIPAS Law, PD 705, and other environmental laws. She also repeated that protecting Sibuyan  
510 and the province of Romblon is the mandate of DENR. She then suggested the Board could craft  
511 a resolution that is geared in strengthening the active monitoring. She suggested to form a  
512 resolution that centers on the strengthening of monitoring of any activity related to mining in  
513 Sibuyan and not just under the Altai but in other proponent as well to ensure the protection of the



natural resources and such activities will not lead to adverse impacts to the environment, both biophysical and socio-economic. Hon. Claudio moreover made certain that once the proponent (Altai) will violate environmental laws, we can file a case against them. Hon. Ramos then mentioned that regarding the mining issues in Sibuyan, he would like to conduct a dialogue first with his constituents in Cajidiocan before they can take it to other platforms the issue of mining applications in Cajidiocan. This action will ensure clear communication with the stakeholders, LGUs, and NGOs. And it will give an avenue on how to counter such mining applications. Thus, Hon. Rodne Galicia moved to pass **PAMB Resolution No. 2022-10, S. 2022 “A Resolution strengthening the active monitoring of the PAMB on any activity related to mining to ensure the protection of Mt. Guiting-Guiting and Environment and Natural Resources in Sibuyan, Romblon.”** It was seconded by Hon. Tansiongco and approved by the majority of the board.

Hon. Ramos then gladly stated that LGU Cajidiocan is willing to provide an office for DENR Romblon. This Office will also be provided of computer equipment, supplies, and contractual staff, to ensure that DENR’s programs will reach the constituents of Cajidiocan. He elaborated that since the DENR Sibuyan Sub-Station in Tampayan, Magdiwang is far from Cajidiocan and lacks stable network connection, it is hard for his fellow citizens to avail the programs and services of DENR such as applications on permits. He stated that if there are any DENR personnel that are residents of Cajidiocan, they could be stationed in the Office provided by the LGU. Hon. Claudio praised the kindness behind the proposal of Hon. Ramos because it will be beneficial to all. Hon. Claudio accepted his offer with outmost gratitude and stated that she will have a talk with OIC PENR Officer Arnoldo A. Blaza Jr. and PASu Malvin R. Rocero on whom will be assigned in Cajidiocan. Hopefully, Hon. Ramos stated that this proposal will be pushed through on CY 2023 and he will include the proposal on their 2023 budget.

Hon. Claudio then indicated that as per discussed during their meet and greet with the Hon. Congressman Eleandro Madrona and Hon. Governor Jose Riano, one of the activities being planned is the conduct of IEC with Mayors of Romblon and their Barangay Captains. Hon. Claudio encouraged the other two mayors to have a type of “one-stop-shop” in their municipalities on the programs of DENR.

Hon. Tansiongco expressed that she had then been coordinating with PENRO Romblon to assign a DENR personnel in San Fernando that will handle, promote, and process DENR applications and programs. This action will also ensure that apprehensions of illegal forest products will be easier because DENR personnel will be closer in the area.

Hon. Tansiongco then stated that the construction of Ranger Station, a project in collaboration with the provincial government and spearheaded by LGU Magdiwang in the PAMO complex is already finished and could be used by the Rangers once connection of electricity and water is attached. He elaborated that the other projects like the Butterfly Garden located in PAMO will soon open to encourage the local community to admire the beauty of Sibuyan’s biodiversity.

Hon. Claudio expressed her gladness in the active commitments of the three mayors when it comes to the programs of the department and in protecting and conserving MGGNP, and hopes that this will continue.

Then, Hon. Gubaton asked the representative of the Indigenous Peoples why some of the IP leaders are not allowing the DENR patrollers to conduct patrolling in their area. Hon. Roa then answered that she will talk to the elders regarding this, however, a coordination should be conducted first to the chieftains before entering their areas. She stated that the patrollers could coordinate with the chieftains and their elders or through her before the conduct of the activity since the indigenous community is being vigilant on persons entering their area because of the mining issues. She said that maybe the elders in the area just protecting their lands from mining activities and it is better to coordinate with them.





Hon. Ibañez then followed up on the issue of assigning a PASu in MGGNP since PASu Malvin was promoted as Chief, Technical Services Division and currently reports in PENRO Romblon. PASu Rocero then stated since there had been a passed resolution regarding the designation of the next PASu, Forester III Manuel B. Romero attended the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter PAMB Meeting to observe and once the Regional Special Order on designation of PASu is issued, For. Romero will immediately assume the functions as PASu of MGGNP.

Hon. Claudio then thanked the Board for the fruitful conduct of the meeting and they were able to pass resolutions during the agenda discussion. She then ensured the Board regarding the mining application in Sibuyan, they will be comprehensive in reviewing the Environment Impact Assessment to make sure that the concerned agencies will take part and do their responsibilities. And she will also ensure that the buffer zones of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park will not be disrupted.


**H. Adjournment**

**WHEREAS**, during Phase-In Phase-Out of NIPAP held at Great Eastern Hotel in Manila the three (3) LGUs of Sibuyan Island (Cajidiocan, Magdiwang and San Fernando) committed to share financial support to sustain the protection, conservation and maintenance of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park;

**WHEREAS**, the termination of NIPAP project on September 2000 the limited resources coming from DENR Regular budget and the IPAF collection can no longer sustain the operation of the Protected Area Office to protect and preserved the biodiversity and integrity of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park;

**WHEREAS**, since CY 2008 - 2017 the three (3) LGUs are committed in the form of Memorandum of Agreement to allocate funds for the protection, conservation and maintenance of the park which was renewed every three (3) years;

**WHEREAS**, on August 23, 2022, during the PAMB En Banc meeting held at Magdiwang Public Plaza, Magdiwang, Romblon, it was raised to ask for an assistance from the Provincial Government for the protection, conservation, and maintenance of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park;

**WHEREAS**, the assistance could be provision of additional manpower to patrol the Protected Area and its proposed Buffer Zones, and formulation/development of projects geared towards the protection and conservation of MGGNP;

**WHEREFORE**, premises considered after due deliberation and upon motion of Hon. Darwin Ruado, seconded by Hon. Rommel Augustus Radan and approved by majority members of the PAMB of Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park; be it



Then, he stated that this is his first time attending the PAMB Meeting since he is a newly-elected Mayor of Cajidiocan and his presence in the meeting is a dedication of his commitment in the protection of our environment particularly of the Island of Sibuyan. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park from May 19, 2022 to August 23, 2022. There is a total of 36km patrolled from July 21 to August 23, 2022, totaling to 388.40 kms patrolled. He explained that the data to be presented are from the data generated from patrollers using LAWIN. He showed the map of Sibuyan Island and explained the area inside the Protected Area and Timberland. 	<p>found. However, since there had been some technical difficulties, the picture inside the map cannot be shown/projected. Then, Hon. Tansingco asked if For. Morales can state the municipalities and barangays where the illegal activities took place to inform the PAMB. For. Morales stated that in Brgy. Cambajao, the patrollers apprehended 20 pieces of lumber in June 2022. In Brgy. España, 23 pieces were apprehended on August 2022. In Brgy. Cambajao, there are 4 pieces (80bdf) apprehended on August 2022. Here further stated that most apprehensions happened in Brgy. España, San Fernando, Romblon. Then, For. Morales explained their action taken is continuous patrolling. Hon. Claudio then asked PASu Rocero on status of the apprehended forest products and if there are any additional action taken, if there are filed cases or if the Office issued Notice of Violation. For. Morales explained that most of the cases, the forest products were abandoned, however, there is a confiscated tricycle since it was carrying charcoal. The presiding officer then asked for a follow up of the status of the apprehension and PASu Rocero stated that they already have schedules for administrative hearing on the apprehended forest products. Then, the presiding officer suggested to conduct checkpoints in the hotspot areas. Hon. Ramos then asked to be recognized. He asked Forester Morales that since they are discussing accomplishment on patrolling, he asked the specific location the apprehension happened, if it were within the private residence (houses) and such. For. Morales answered that the forest products are commonly apprehended along the highway, and sometimes found abandoned in the trail. Hon. Ramos then asked if they are found within the buffer zones, protected area, and timberland. For. Morales then informed that some of the apprehensions are not in the mentioned areas, because there are some apprehensions of abandoned forest products that happen upon information from concerned citizens, Brgy. Officials, and LGU Park Rangers. For. Morales then informed that the patrolling also happens in the Timberland and not limited only on the Protected Area and they also act on reports concerning the environment of Sibuyan. For. Morales also said that when apprehending, they also check the species of the forest products to verify if they are natural grown or planted trees. Hon. Claudio commented that based on the LAWIN Report, there should be more coordination with the LGUs and BLGUs on the patrolling and monitoring of illegal forest activities. And also strengthen the monitoring of the BLGUs and LGUs against illegal forest activities. Hon. Tansingco then asked if there are apprehensions inside the Protected Area and within the Buffer zones and highlighted that the patrollers should strengthen the patrolling and apprehension to ensure that no trees are cut inside the Protected Area, Timberland, and Buffer zones. PASu Rocero then stated that on the report of For. Morales, that even though apprehensions happen in the local community or in the high way, when verified, the species of the logs/lumbers are from the Timberland and Protected Area. And based on the LAWIN Report/Application, a lot of threats and cuttings are happening within the proposed Buffer Zones thus the area should be declared as MGGNP's Buffer Zone to ensure that less cutting will happen. PASu Rocero also made it clear that when the cutting happened inside, within, or outside the Protected Area, cutting trees without permit is still illegal and a violation of PD 705 and its IRR. Hon. Claudio agreed with this and reiterated that even the area is beyond the Buffer Zones, we should still protect it in order to conserve the environment of Sibuyan. Hon. Proposed continuation of Memorandum of Agreement with the three LGUs amounting to P1,000,000.00 each year</b></p>	<p>a Presidential Decree 1153 (PD 1153), Requiring the Planting of one Tree every month for Five (5) consecutive years by every citizen of the Philippines. The PAMB could pass a resolution reiterating the implementation of the Presidential Decree 1153 in Sibuyan Island in order to remind the local community that they are tasked to plant trees. Hon. Claudio also reminded the participants that on September 13, 2022, there will be a simultaneous National Tree Planting Activity and the DENR could help the LGUs in locating specific sites for the Tree Planting spearheaded by the DILG. Hon. Claudio suggested that school areas could be used for this kind of project and it will further encourage the youth to embrace the concept of tree growing and the protection and establishment of forests. Hon. Arthur Tansiongco then stated that in Magdiwang, he had required the parents to plant ten (10) trees every year and he plans to continue the program. Magdiwang had already two (2) sites for this project thus the project will continue. He is now asking the barangay captains to adopt this project/activity in their respective barangays and every barangay captain should plant fifty (50) trees every year during Arbor Day. Hon. Claudio commended the projects of the mayors regarding the tree plantations in their respective municipalities. Hon. Rodne Galicia then raised the idea that the term “Tree Growing” should be used. He then asked the LGUs of their particular FLUPS and CLUPS because communal forests should have been integrated in FLUPs and CLUPs as well as the identification of municipal production forests. He also mentioned the role of the National Greening Program (NGP) that promotes the reforestation of forests in the country. It would be better of these matter will be provided of assistance by DENR because in the long term, we need to look back to FLUP and CLUP so tree planting and growing will be adopted by the municipalities. Hon. Claudio agrees to this as there should be a municipal production forest that will cater to the lumber needs of the community. The PAMO will then assist the LGUs on the tree planting/growing and the PENR Office will assist in the identification of the land/area to be used as identified in the LGU’s FLUP and CLUP.</p> <p>Hon. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park. Hon. Rodne Galicia then raised the idea if the PAMB could ask for a financial commitment from the Provincial Government through a MOA similar to the MOA between the Local Government Units of Magdiwang. Since the Governor is part of the PAMB as well, maybe the Board can ask the Provincial Government of fund allocation for the protection and conservation of Mt. Guiting- Guiting Natural Park. Hon. Claudio then instructed PASu Rocero to coordinate with the Provincial Government and the Office of the Congressman as well regarding this matter. She also stated that the PAMO should come up with the proposed Work and Financial Plan for the Provincial Government. Utilization on the projects contained in the MOA should also be included in the presentation of the Work and Financial Plan in order to give the Provincial Governor and Congressman an orientation on how the fund will be utilized. She also commented that the utilization report should be given yearly to show the LGUs and the PAMB on how the fund was used. PASu Rocero stated that on August 16, 2022, he was instructed by the PENR Officer to attend a meeting with the Provincial Government of Romblon and he proposed a P1,000,000.00 budget similar to the MOA of the three (3) LGUs, the proposal had included the hiring of Park Ranger and this proposal had been submitted to the Provincial Planning Officer. Then, Hon. Ireen Roa asked if the members of the Indigenous People could be included as beneficiaries of the programs of the MOA such as conduct of IEC and hiring of Park Ranger since they do not have an allocated budget. She further stated that the IEC would be about mining since it is one of the pressing issues as of today. Hon. Ramos and Hon. Other Matters</b></p>	<p>EcoMS I Penuliar presented the previous activities conducted by the three (3) municipalities during the Annual Celebration on the Proclamation of Mt. Guiting-Guiting as Natural Park. For CY 2023, the host municipality will be LGU San Fernando and among the proposed activities that they will conduct are; IEC (Dalaw Turo) with DepEd, Tree Planting, Clean Up, and Holy Mass. Hon. Tansingco openly accepted to host the 27<sup>th</sup> Proclamation Anniversary of Mt. Guiting - Guiting as Natural Park and agreed on the proposed activities. Proposal and formal meeting with LGU San Fernando will be conducted for the preparation of the Anniversary Proclamation.</p> <p>Hon. Elizabeth Ibañez raised other matters after the discussion of the main agenda. Her first inquiry is about the status of the PASu assigned in MGGNP PAMO, secondly, the issue of threats of mining in Sibuyan Island particularly in the Barangays involved in the PAMB. Hon. Claudio asked to specify the details on the mining in Sibuyan mentioned by Hon. Ibañez. Hon. Ibañez explained that at present, to her knowledge there are several mining applications in Sibuyan Island aside from the Exploration of Altai Mining. The applications are in Brgys. Otod, Agtiwa, España San Fernando, in Brgys. Cantagda, Danao, and Cambajao, Cajidiocan, and Brgy. Silum, Magdiwang. Even though the applications are not inside the Protected Area, the area being applied for had included some of the proposed buffer zones and allowing the mining activities within the buffer zones will greatly affect the Protected Area and Sibuyan Island. To her knowledge, the mining permits are for open pit mining and large scale mining that will be a huge risk in the Protected Area. She further stated that the establishment of tree plantation and municipal production forest will be useless if we allow the mining activities to happen. Thus, the PAMB should make an action in order to counter the permits, and since the three mayors are already present, it would be better if the Local Chief Executives will guide the PAMB Members in crafting a solution on this issue. At present, the Municipalities had issued Resolutions against destructive and irresponsible mining as well as the Barangays. Hon. Tansingco then stated that maybe the Body could make a Resolution against mining activities in Sibuyan since the three mayors is already present in the meeting to further protect the Island of Sibuyan. Hon. Claudio then stated that the PAMB is created to carry out the intent of the NIPAS Act for Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park, and while the mining is a concern of the leaders, being representative</p>	<p>Hon. 	<p>of their constituents, it would be better if the issue on mining be dealt with separately. She explained that the issue on mining which is still on the exploratory stage was emphasized during the meeting with the Mayors and their representatives a week before. It was explained to them that the status of the exploration of Altai is still in the exploration stage. As Government Employees and Public Servants, we should uphold integrity of other national laws that we carry out, like Presidential Decree 1586, Establishing an Environmental Impact Statement System, including other Environmental Management related Measures and for Other Purposes, also known as the Philippine Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) System, is still the most thorough system of any development project in the given area and is being recognized for being a tool on the assessment of impact on the geo-physical, biodiversity, and socio-economic effects on the environment. Thus, it was explained in the previous meeting the activity of Altai is still in Exploration Stage and stopping the activity will pre-empt the other activities that Altai needs for their application. We also need to follow the established law mentioned in PD 1586 and its rules and regulations for other proposed projects. It was also agreed in the meeting that there will be a ground consultation on the Exploration Permit as there is a separate procedure on the EIA System that a consultation is needed. This activity is also known as Public Scoping, a proponent lead and will investigate the content of the Environmental Impact Assessment that will happen in the ground/field. Hon. Claudio also emphasized that as government officials like the DENR, it is also their duty to uphold the National Law and passing a resolution that bans/opposes the Exploration Stage could pre-empt the process of PD 1586. Further the PAMB may not be the body that should ventilate on it, instead she suggested that the Local Leaders could come up with the resolution in their respective municipalities. Hon Claudio then clarified that she is only explaining the process for the understanding of everyone in the meeting. She also restated that as part of DENR and government officials, we are part of implementing the National Law such as Mineral Production Sharing Agreement and opposing it through a resolution contradicts the essence of implementing the said policy. Hon. Ibañez then stated that prior to the meeting, some PAMB members had been planning to pass a resolution regarding the mining activities in Sibuyan because it might affect the Protected Area and since some areas of the proposed buffer zones is included in their application. Hon. Ibañez added that local communities had already passed resolutions regarding the mining activities in their areas and had been vigilant in signing papers/attendance sheets as they worry it might be used for pro-mining campaign. Hon. Claudio then explained that the exploration within the proposed buffer zones cannot be mapped out since they are still in their exploration stage. Since there is still no ECC application that states the bounds, we cannot still determine if the area is within the buffer</p>

	<p>zones and we need to check first the project proposal of Altai. She also stressed that there will be a consultation that will happen in the ground as committed to Hon. Tansingco and the LGUs to be spearheaded by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau, PENRO Romblon, and Environment Management Bureau MIMAROPA that aims to explain and monitor their programs/projects. There will also be a committee/task force spearheaded by Hon. Tansingco and is composed by the representative of local leaders (Sangguniang Bayan Members), the DENR PENRO, and NGOs that will join the trekking to the area to check and monitor the extent of the Exploration activity. Hon. Claudio then indicated that we need to be objective in these times and we need to carry out the mandate of DENR as well as protection of Mt. Guiting-Guiting and spearhead the implementation of ENIPAS Law, PD 705, and other environmental laws. She also repeated that protecting Sibuyan and the province of Romblon is the mandate of DENR. She then suggested the Board could craft a resolution that is geared in strengthening the active monitoring. She suggested to form a resolution that centers on the strengthening of monitoring of any activity related to mining in Sibuyan and not just under the Altai but in other proponent as well to ensure the protection of the natural resources and such activities will not lead to adverse impacts to the environment, both biophysical and socio-economic. Hon. Claudio moreover made certain that once the proponent (Altai) will violate environmental laws, we can file a case against them. Hon. Ramos then mentioned that regarding the mining issues in Sibuyan, he would like to conduct a dialogue first with his constituents in Cajidiocan before they can take it to other platforms the issue of mining applications in Cajidiocan. This action will ensure clear communication with the stakeholders, LGUs, and NGOs. And it will give an avenue on how to counter such mining applications</p> <p>Hon. Ramos then gladly stated that LGU Cajidiocan is willing to provide an office for DENR Romblon. This Office will also be provided of computer equipment, supplies, and contractual staff, to ensure that DENR's programs will reach the constituents of Cajidiocan. He elaborated that since the DENR Sibuyan Sub-Station in Tampayan, Magdiwang is far from Cajidiocan and lacks stable network connection, it is hard for his fellow citizens to avail the programs and services of DENR such as applications on permits. He stated that if there are any DENR personnel that are residents of Cajidiocan, they could be stationed in the Office provided by the LGU. Hon. Claudio praised the kindness behind the proposal of Hon. Ramos because it will be beneficial to all. Hon.
