This pertains to the conducted operation for the retrieval of stolen boat which related to the incident on October 13, 2022 at PAMO-MSPLS, Barangay Old Guinlo, Taytay, Palawan.

Please be informed that on October 26, 2022, we the undersigned together with the personnel from FPMS – I Forest Ranger Michael Angelo M. Vasquez, Forest Protection Officers – Rennie O. Tenolite and Gilbert E. Angeles, personnel from FPMS – VI – Office Support Staff Richard M. Valones, Ricben R. Armenia, Erwin C. Balvin and personnel from 3rd Marine Company, Marine Battalion Landing Team-3 assigned at New Guinlo Patrol Base led by Detachment Commander Nestor Q. Halayap Jr. conducted the operation for the retrieval of the stolen boat based on the information given by a concern citizen. The team proceeded in the seaside of Puting Buhangin, Sitio Pinagpala, Barangay Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan which correspond to the information of the location of the stolen boat named "Jericho/Arjay", upon arrival the team immediately searched the dense part of the area and an approximately 10 meters from the shoreline, we found the exact location of the stolen boat but no one was seen or noticed in the area. It was observed that the location of the stolen boat was approximately 100 meters from more or less 20 households living in the area. Meanwhile, information gathered about the responsible on the incident of theft is the trawlers who live in Sitio Pinagpala, Barangay Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan.

Be informed further that the helm (timon), outrigger (katig) and anchor (pamondo) was not recovered and the boat had slightly damaged which possible made by the thief. Said recovered boat was brought to the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO), Barangay Old Guinlo, Taytay, Palawan for safe keeping purposes.

Thus, continuous patrol and monitoring within the vicinities of Sitio Pinagpala will be conducted to catch the thief of the stolen boat, regular visibility in the area to hinder illegal activities and strengthening the collaboration with the concerned BLGU and nearer barangays.


