The original scheduled training set on April 25 – May 4, 2022 was postponed but this was promptly communicated to the participants through BMB Memorandum dated 25 April 2022.

The Training was participated in by: (1) Protected Area Superintendents and GIS Specialists of legislated protected areas undertaking Protected Area Management Plan (PAMP) preparation process from Regions 2, 5, 7, and 8; (2) GIS Specialists of legislated protected areas not undertaking PAMP preparation process from CAR, MIMAROPA, Regions 1 and 3; and (3) Representatives each from the National Parks Division, Coastal and Marine Division and Biodiversity Policy and Knowledge Management Division.

In line with the objectives of the training to promote learning and understanding of the criteria, data requirements, and procedures in determining the PA management zones using sound science and innovative use of technology (GIS and Remote Sensing) and to assist the PAMO personnel in identifying the management zones of their respective protected areas, this Bureau advises the participants of the training to cascade the knowledge and experience to other protected areas of their concerned regions. The same was advised to the participants of the training for the Luzon and Visayas Cluster and we have already provided them relevant training materials.
