Dear RED Lormelyn C. Claudio,

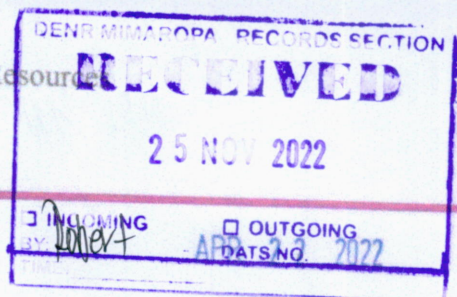

Lourdes, Magsaysay, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro in relation to DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2021-27 re "Prescribing the Guidelines on the Issuance of Provisional Agreement for All Tenure Instruments Issued Under the Forestry Sector".

Subject: Renewal BFD CTF No. 3 of Mrs. Wilhelmina C. Sanchez located at So. Sto. Cristo, Barangay Lourdes, Magsaysay, San Jose, Occ. Mindoro

In relation with DENR Administrative Order No. 2021-27 prescribing the guidelines on the issuance of provisional agreement for all tenure instruments issued under the forestry sector, I would like to state my case on the renewal of my BFD Communal Tree Farm Lease Agreement to SIFMA.

Herewith the following Statement of facts to support my request for issuance of renewal/conversion of tenure:

- BFD CTF Lease Agreement No. 3 issued to Mrs. Wilhelmina C. Sanchez expired 2006 and renewal applied thereafter till now unresolved
- Area is located in So. Sto. Cristo, Barangay Lourdes, Magsaysay, San Jose, Occ. Mindoro
- Covered area: 21 hectares
- Planted trees Mahogany, Gmelina, Teak, Ipil-ipil, casoy, mango enz.
- Indorsement to renew as SIFMA (Memo April 2, 2018 zle attachment) Reference was DAO 1998-24
- Follow up on April 24, 2019 of indorsement to CENRO office by applicant in compliance with Memo of October 8, 2018
- On November 8, 2019 during our meeting at the Regional office, RO advised to continue conversion to CBFM (CBFM- LIKAP).
- Application of CBFM-LIKAP is ongoing for years. Compilation of all needed supporting papers took a long time and never completed, by the time supporting papers reach the Cenro office, some papers expired already and have to be updated again.
- Requesting members to attend meetings and gathering their signature is very difficult. Mostly are working to earn a living and my area is the only one planted with forest trees.
- My area is twice hit by a heavy typhoon. Fallen trees are left to rot. Just like the typhoon of December 25, 2019. Inventory of damage/fallen trees with CENRO office personnel went up to almost a thousand trees (1000). Request: asked for a special permit to cut/haul the fallen trees but it is not possible without a TENURE.
- If Tree farm Lease Agreement and/or AgroForestry Farm Lease Agreement which has expired can be converted to SIFMA, in my case my BFD CTF has expired, can I appeal for consideration to convert it to SIFMA. Can I pursue further my filed SIFMA application in accordance with DAO 2021-27

Socialized Industrial Forest Plantation (SIFP) refers to a tract of land planted primarily to trees and other products to support manufacturing and processing facilities and/or to supply wood and energy requirement.

Where is the promise of **security of tenure** to participants who supported projects to plant trees, reforest, in line with the policy of the Government to ensure the development and management of forest land resources on a sustainable basis, promote equitable distribution of natural resources, provide a healthy environment, and promote economic upliftment of the people.

Appealing for your support and hoping to acquire the proper tenure so that the planted trees may not go to waste.
