The team will gather the required information, documentation and witnesses for the completeness of the cases build-up of all environmental violations and other appropriate cases before the proper court.





Medardo G. De Lemos.

Together with the undersigned, Cenro Coron personnel and Mr. Rudolfo Cadampog of Sagip Coron Movement, the team have conducted ocular/on-site surveillance and investigation at CBDP, Proposed Public Market Project, Proposed Government Building Projects and Illegal mountain quarry sites in Coron, Palawan.

As mentioned during the meeting, the NBI will gather needed information, documentation and witnesses for the completeness of their case build-up of all the environmental issues mentioned above hence this office is anticipating on their future action.






