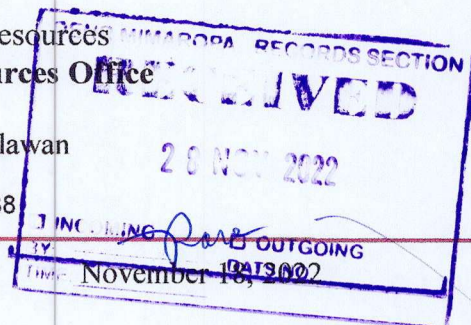



Respectfully submitted is the report relative to the above-mentioned subject. The CBFM Team conducted an evaluation and/or assessment together with PO Chairperson and members dated September 28, 2022, located at Brgy. San Jose, Roxas, Palawan.

Through Executive Order No. 263 July 19, 1995, CBFM San Jose Multi- Purpose Cooperative (SJMPC) was awarded CBFM with CBFMA No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-0000- 12 on October 13, 2000, contains an area of, more or less 788.38 hectares of old-growth and residential forest awarded area for forest protection, rehabilitation, development, management, and utilization through the community-based forest management strategy.

Please be informed that the SJMPC is chaired by Mr. Jaime Dagot with a total of Fifty-Two (52) actual beneficiaries composted of 31 men and 21 female. The People's Organization (PO) is a recipient of 50 hectares of CBFM-CARP Agro-Forestry and Backyard Gardening on 2010.

The People's Organization (PO) contracted 50 hectares of CBFM-CARP in 2010. However, they failed to complete only planting almost 10 hectares out of the 50 hectares target based on the approved Work and Financial Plan (WFP).

Further, the CBFM Staff were assisted by the CBFM-PO Chairperson, Jaime Dagot, and Punong Barangay during the monitoring and assessment of CBFM. The Punong Barangay disbelieves with the Chairperson of CBFM in the Barangay San Jose due to some reasons and she is aware of issues and concerns in his leadership. Moreover, the SJMPC officers and other CBFM Members are no longer active.

However, their association still continues by lending to their members at low interest. They acquired two lots with building for the association and it is currently being rented out as Canteen.

Allegedly because of their personal experience in the leadership of the late CENRO Angeles they decided voluntary surrender of CBFMA. But considering the reasons embodied in their letter that officers and members were already inactive in all CBFM activities coupled with uninterested to implement and comply the terms and conditions stipulated in their agreement and in the capacity to pay the accumulated amount required in the CBFM project the office recommends for ultimate cancelation of this tenurial instrument.



The said cooperative is no longer interested to implement its plans and programs coupled with inactive officers and members the office of the PENRO concurs with the recommendation of CENRO to cancel the CBFMA and forwarded to Regional Office. Therefore, The Regional Office concurs with the recommendation of CENRO/PENRO and forwarded to the USEC for Field Operations.

Relative to this, the Regional Office sent a Regional Special Order (RSO # 30, 2017) creation of a team to validate the voluntary surrender of CBFMA of San Jose Multi-Purpose Cooperative, Inc. followed by a memorandum to submit the resolution signed by all members of the Cooperative authorizing the Chairman and BODs to surrender on their behalf the CBFM area before this recommendation for final cancellation of the CBFM Agreement to the Office of Undersecretary for Field Operations. CENRO immediately sent as response for their compliance memo instruction but up to now no order of cancellation has been received re: cancellation of CBFMA to People's organization San Jose Multi-Purpose Cooperative (SMPC).


Recently, in our monitoring and assessment Chairperson Dagot confirmed don't want to go back to CBFM. Moreover, the SJMPC officers and other CBFM Members are no longer active but there are those who want to take over their CBFM desires to be a re-organized by having re-election under select new set of officers from their current members who are more eager to continue the management and development of the CBFM area. In case they decide to take over and need assistance from our office to facilitated the re-organization process.

Thus, the CBFM Staff will recommend the following:


1. Assist schedule a consultation meeting w/ the officers and members of the PO to discuss on the revival of their CBFM Project and the conduct of election process to com-up w/ a new set of Officers;
2. To schedule another consultative meeting to tackle the updating of their Management Plan, Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) and their Annual Work Plan; and
3. To identify alternative livelihood opportunities/ project to the PO, a follow meeting w/ also be facilitated for the purpose including the likelihood of CARP and NGP projects in their CBFM area.

Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum dated August 26, 2016 of PENRO Juan C. dela Cruz of the province of Palawan regarding the voluntary surrender of the Community-Based Forest Management Agreement (CBFMA) of San Jose Multi-Purpose Cooperative, Inc.

San Jose Multi-Purpose Cooperative, Inc. is a holder of Community-Based Forest Management Agreement (CBFMA) No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-00-12 issued by then OIC-PENRO Segundino T. Martin on October 13, 2000. It covers an area of 788.38 hectares located at Brgy. San Jose, Roxas, Palawan and has a duration of 25 years, to expire on October 13, 2025, renewable for another 25 years in accordance with existing policies/regulations.

Per letter dated July 30, 2016 of the Board of Directors, the Chairman and the Vice-chairman, the CBFMA is being voluntarily surrendered for the following reasons:

1. The members are already inactive and cannot implement the terms and conditions stipulated in the CBFMA Agreement;
2. No capacity to occupy and maintain the area;
3. Non acceptance of the members of the CBFMA area; and
4. Incapacity to pay the accumulated amount of the CBFMA Project.

The Board of Directors and members of the Cooperative in their meeting held on July 30, 2016 passed a Resolution favorably endorsing the cancellation/voluntary surrender of the CBFMA of San Jose Multi-Purpose Cooperative, Inc. per memoranda dated October 17 and 18, 2016 of the CENRO, Roxas, Palawan and the PENRO, Palawan respectively.

This Office concurs with the recommendation of the PENRO/CENRO concerned.

This AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) - Palawan, for and in behalf of the Republic of the Philippines, hereinafter referred to as the DENR, and SAN JOSE MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE (SJMPC), with postal address at Barangay San Jose, Roxas, Palawan, hereinafter referred to as the CBFMA Holder.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the DENR has the authority and jurisdiction over the forest lands to be included in the CBFMA.

WHEREAS, the CBFMA Holder has resolved to enter into a Community-Based Forest Management Agreement (CBFMA) over the area in the aforementioned area pursuant to the provision of DENR Administrative Order No. 96-29.

WHEREAS, the concerned LGUs having joint responsibility with DENR over community-based management in accordance with the Local Government Code, endorse this CBFMA.

WHEREAS, implementation of the agreement shall include the following components:

- a. forest rehabilitation, including agro-forestry;
- b. forest protection;
- c. development of alternative livelihood opportunities not necessarily dependent on forest products;
- d. forest products utilization; and
- e. other activities that may be identified in the future consistent with the Community Resources Management Framework (CRMF) of the area including that of the Terms and Conditions cited in the PCSD Authorization.


WHEREAS, the DENR and the CBFMA Holder agreed to enter into Community-Based Forest Management Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the DENR agrees to devolve to the CBFMA Holder the responsibility for managing Seven Hundred Eighty Eight and 38/100 (788.38) hectares of forest land located at Barangay San Jose, Roxas, Palawan, Region 4 - Island Province, Philippines, hereinafter referred to as the CBFMA AREA, the description and boundaries of which are shown in the attached map which forms part of this AGREEMENT.

OBLIGATIONS OF PARTIES

1.0 The DENR shall:

- 1.1 Protect and ensure exclusive occupation and the use of the forest land covered by this CBFMA and the forest products therein to the CBFMA Holder, subject to prevailing laws, rules and regulation and prior rights;
- 1.2 Provide assistance to the CBFMA Holder as part of the DENR's normal operations, more particularly in the preparation, updating and implementation of the Community Resources Management Framework (CRMF), Resource Use Plans (RUPs) and Annual Work Plans (AWPs);

1.3 Deputize qualified members of the CBFMA Holder as Environment and Natural Resource Officers (ENROs) upon request of the CBFMA Holder pursuant to DAO No. 41, series of 1991 and other pertinent regulations; and,

1.4 In case the province is under logging moratorium, exempt the CBFMA area.

2.0 The CBFMA Holder shall:

2.1 Immediately assume responsibility for the protection of the entire forest-lands within the CBFMA area against illegal logging and the other unauthorized extraction of forest products, slash-and burn agriculture (kaingin), forest and grassland fires, and other forms of forest destruction; and assist DENR in the prosecution of violators of forestry and environmental laws;

2.2 Follow all duly-promulgated laws, rules and regulations pertinent to forest management;

2.3 Prepare and implement CRMF, RUP and Annual Work Plans with assistance from DENR and LGU and other agencies;

2.4 Formulate and implement benefit sharing schemes among its members; and,

2.5 Pay the required forest charges and other fees.

3.0 OTHER CONDITIONS:

The DENR shall give first priority to the CBFMA Holder in obtaining privilege to extract, utilize and dispose any mineral resource and minor forest product found within the CBFMA area, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.

4.0 DURATION OF CBFMA

This Agreement shall have a term of twenty five (25) years counted from the date this Instrument is notarized and be eligible for renewal thereafter for an additional twenty five (25) years subject to compliance by the CBFMA Holder with the terms of this Agreement and other pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

5.0 RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES


Any disputes among the parties here to arising from or related to the provisions of this Agreement shall be settled by arbitration, with each party represented by one (1) arbitrator and a third arbitrator named by the two (2) parties. If it is not possible to settle disputes through arbitration, the disputes shall be submitted for the decision to the appropriate court of law having jurisdiction on the matter.

6.0 TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT OF CBFMA

The CBFMA may be terminated based on the non-performance of the PO of violation of any provision herein stated by any of the parties. Further, this Agreement may be amended and supplemented with conformity of both parties.

7.0 FORCE MAJEURE

If any event of FORCE MAJEURE and other cause such as earthquakes, typhoons, storms, flood, epidemics and other similar phenomenon affecting the Performance of the People's Organization, the PO shall give notice to DENR within thirty (30) days after the occurrence, including a statement describing the force majeure and its effect upon the PO's ability to perform under the conditions of the CBFM. the parties shall meet regarding action to be taken within five (5) days after such notice.



8.0 **PENALTY CLAUSE**




1. The officers and members of this cooperative were already inactive in all CBFM activities.

4. Incapacity to pay the accumulated amount acquired in the CBFM projects.







Respectfully submitted is the report relative to the above-mentioned subject. The CBFM Team conducted an evaluation and/or assessment together with PO Chairperson and members dated September 28, 2022, located at Brgy. Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan.

Through Executive Order No. 263 July 19, 1995, Uplanders Farmers Multi-Purpose Cooperative (UFMPC) was awarded CBFM with CBFMA No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2001-21 on November 06, 2001, contains an area of, more or less 1,825 hectares of old-growth and residential forest awarded area for forest protection, rehabilitation, development, management, and utilization through the community-based forest management strategy.

Please be informed that the Uplander s Farmers Multi-Purpose Cooperative (UFMPC) is chaired by Mr. Bernardo Castillo with a total of Fifty-Two (52) actual beneficiaries composed of 31 men and 21.

The People's Organization (PO) is a recipient of 50 hectares of CBFM-CARP Agro-Forestry and Backyard Gardening on 2010. The PO benefited Water system project and Carabao dispersal in 2010 from PCART but failed to complete.

Further, the CBFM Staff were assisted by the CBFM-PO Chairperson, Bernardo Castillo, and former Punong Barangay Heginio Lagan and the current Punong Barangay Nardito Ancierto (2002 BOD Chairman of UFMPC) in conducting monitoring and assessment of CBFM and the current Punong Barangay he is strongly opposing the re-activation of CBFM in the Barangay Dumarao due to some personal reasons.

Based on the previous report these are the issues and concerns raised in March 23, 2018 unresolved conducted together with PENRO CDS Staff:

1. Overlapping of Katala Foundation Inc. local conservation area for Philippine Fresh Water Turtle (Bakoko) to CBFM area consisting of 377 hectares,
2. Barangay Ecotourism Site inside the CBFMA;
3. Titled lots an Alienable and Disposable Lands within CBFMA; and
4. Reforestation of Mr. Macabutas as his penalty within the CBFMA and Watershed area of Brgy. Dumarao.

Furthermore, there was a complaint against the CBFM-UFMPC that their area overlapped with the RCC-ICC R4-028-002 dated May 10, 1990 of the Samahang Pagkaunlaran ng mga Katutubong Cuyonon and Tagbanua (SPKCT) represented by Hernanie Dadores and they were awarded first than CBFM. But SPKTC right now they are under renewal of their RCC.

In addition, there were residents and People Organization (Green Star Association) show their desire to CBFM-PO of UFMPC when it becomes active again, this Green Star Association (Association of Ilonggo at Ilian Ilian Dumarao, Roxas) and/or willing take over the Area if the UFMPC failed to reactive/reorganized due to that they were not sure if the CBFM area of UFMPC covers the Ilian ilian, Dumarao area where most of them resides.

Moreover, the UFMPC officers and other CBFM Members are no longer in active but desires to be a re-organized by having re-election under select new set of officers from their current and younger members who are more eager to continue the management and development of the CBFM area.

Accordingly, like other CBFMs that are inactive, they still want to be active again. The remaining and existing PO members and officers signify their intention to be reactivated and seeking our assistance in the reorganization.

Thus, the CBFM Staff recommends the following:

1. Assist in the PO a consultation/ meeting with the existing/remaining officers and members of the PO to discuss on the revival of their CBFM Project and the conduct of election for the new set of Officers;
2. To schedule another consultative meeting to tackle the updating of their Management Plan, Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) and their Annual Work Plan; and
3. To identify alternative livelihood opportunities/ project to the PO, a follow meeting w/ also be facilitated for the purpose including the likelihood of CARP and NGP projects in their CBFM area;
4. Delineation of CBFM boundary; and
5. Survey of different activities of occupants within CBFM.

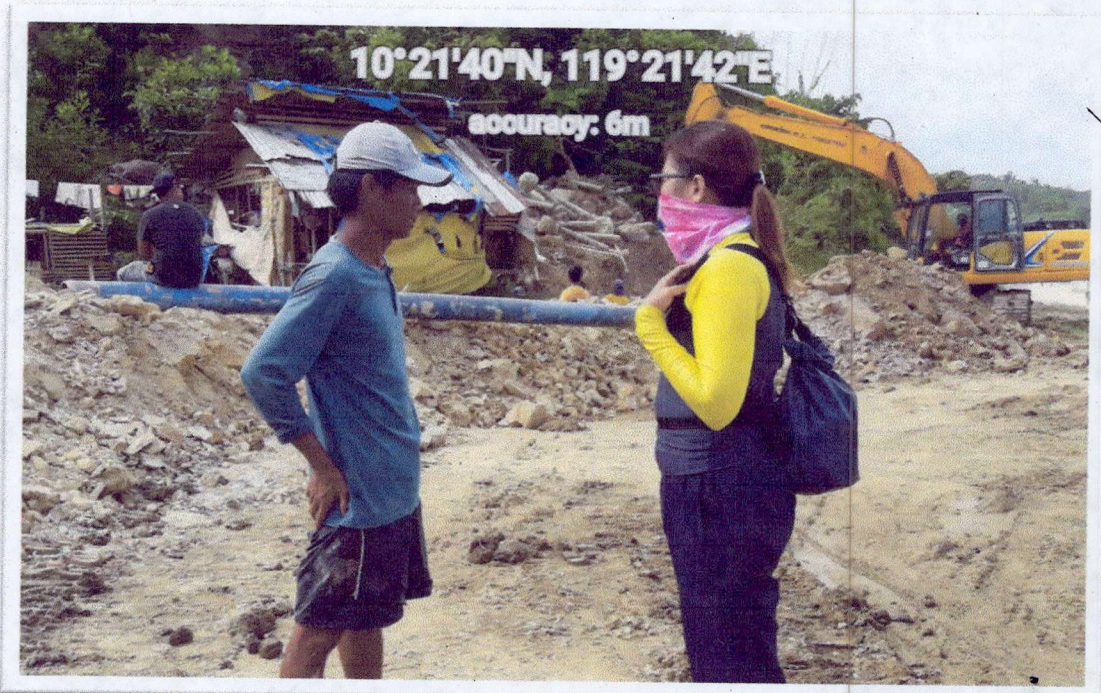



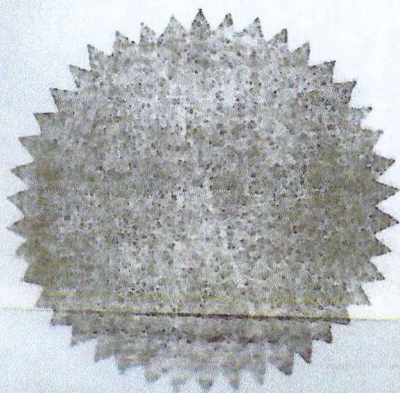

This AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) - Palawan, for and in behalf of the Republic of the Philippines, hereinafter referred to as the DENR, and UPLANDERS FARMERS MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE, with postal address at Barangay Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan, hereinafter referred to as the CBFMA Holder.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the DENR has the authority and jurisdiction over the forest lands to be included in the CBFMA.

WHEREAS, the CBFMA Holder has resolved to enter into a Community-Based Forest Management Agreement (CBFMA) over the area in the aforementioned area pursuant to the provision of DENR Administrative Order No. 96-29.

WHEREAS, the concerned LGUs having joint responsibility with DENR over community-based management in accordance with the Local Government Code, endorse this CBFMA.






WHEREAS, implementation of the agreement shall include the following components:

- a. forest rehabilitation, including agro-forestry;
- b. forest protection;
- c. development of alternative livelihood opportunities not necessarily dependent on forest products;
- d. forest products utilization; and
- e. other activities that may be identified in the future consistent with the Community Resources Management Framework (CRMF) of the area including that of the Terms and Conditions cited in the PCSD Authorization.

WHEREAS, the DENR and the CBFMA Holder agreed to enter into Community-Based Forest Management Agreement;


NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the DENR agrees to devolve to the CBFMA Holder the responsibility for managing One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Five (1,825) hectares of forest land located at Barangay Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan, Region 4 - Island Province, Philippines, hereinafter referred to as the CBFMA AREA, the description and boundaries of which are shown in the attached map which forms part of this AGREEMENT.

OBLIGATIONS OF PARTIES

1.0 The DENR shall:

- 1.1 Protect and ensure exclusive occupation and the use of the forest land covered by this CBFMA and the forest products therein to the CBFMA Holder, subject to prevailing laws, rules and regulation and prior rights;







- 1.2 Provide assistance to the CBFMA Holder as part of the DENR's normal operations, more particularly in the preparation, updating and implementation of the Community Resources Management Framework (CRMF), Resource Use Plans (RUPs) and Annual Work Plans (AWPs);
- 1.3 Deputize qualified members of the CBFMA Holder as Environment and Natural Resource Officers (ENROs) upon request of the CBFMA Holder pursuant to DAO No. 41, series of 1991 and other pertinent regulations; and,
- 1.4 In case the province is under logging moratorium, exempt the CBFMA area.

2.0 The CBFMA Holder shall:

- 2.1 Immediately assume responsibility for the protection of the entire forestlands within the CBFMA area against illegal logging and the other unauthorized extraction of forest products, slash-and burn agriculture (kaingin), forest and grassland fires, and other forms of forest destruction; and assist DENR in the prosecution of violators of forestry and environmental laws,
- 2.2 Follow all duly-promulgated laws, rules and regulations pertinent to forest management;
- 2.3 Prepare and implement CRMF, RUP and Annual Work Plans with assistance from DENR and LGU and other agencies;
- 2.4 Formulate and implement benefit sharing schemes among its members; and,
- 2.5 Pay the required forest charges and other fees.

3.0 OTHER CONDITIONS:

The DENR shall give first priority to the CBFMA Holder in obtaining privilege to extract, utilize and dispose any mineral resource and minor forest product found within the CBFMA area, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.

4.0 DURATION OF CBFMA

This Agreement shall have a term of twenty five (25) years counted from the date this Instrument is notarized and be eligible for renewal thereafter for an additional twenty five (25) years subject to compliance by the CBFMA Holder with the terms of this Agreement and other pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

5.0 RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

Any disputes among the parties here to arising from or related to the provisions of this Agreement shall be settled by arbitration, with each party represented by one (1) arbitrator and a third arbitrator named by the two (2) parties. If it is not possible to settle disputes through arbitration, the disputes shall be submitted for the decision to the appropriate court of law having jurisdiction on the matter.

6.0 TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT OF CBFMA

The CBFMA may be terminated based on the non-performance of the PO of violation of any provision herein stated by any of the parties. Further, this Agreement may be amended and supplemented with conformity of both parties.

7.0 FORCE MAJEURE

If any event of FORCE MAJEURE and other cause such as earthquakes, typhoons, storms, flood, epidemics and other similar phenomenon affecting the Performance of the People's Organization, the PO shall give notice to DENR within thirty (30) days after the occurrence, including a statement describing the force majeure and its effect upon the PO's ability to perform under the conditions of the CBFM. the parties shall meet regarding action to be taken within five (5) days after such notice.
