On October 11, 2022 in the morning, the Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Team in connection with the implementation of Green Economy Model (GEM), conducted information dissemination in Barangay Teneguiban regarding the DENR's services and programs as well as the implementation of environmental laws to strengthen the awareness of the community.



Among those presented in IEC  
Were the Forestry Code of the Philippines  
(P.D.705), Chainsaw Act (P.D. 9175),  
Tenurial Instrument within and outside  
Protected Area, land titling,  
Water Code of the Philippines (P.D. 1067)  
and Mining Act (R.A. 7942)




An Open Forum followed the presentation to address the issues and concerns of the community.

### Issues and Concerns

Most of the issues and concern raised were about (1) possible reclassification of timberlands into agricultural lands or classification of unclassified public forest (2) tax declaration issued over timberland; (3) allowable easement on seashore and river; and (4) rights of Indigenous People (IPs) on the ancestral land.

Teneguiban is the ninth largest barangay of El Nido as to land area with 3,749.30 hectares: 1,326.77 or 35.4% of which is alienable and disposable and 2,422.54 or 64.6% is public forest; and among the barangays covered by the petition of Indigenous Group of Tagbanua Tandulanen for issuance of Certificate of Ancestral Domain Title. Preponderance of barangay population were occupying the easement, mangrove and forest land as the land area is dominantly timber or forest land. In order to legalize their stay in timberlands, the residents were looking forward for the reclassification/classification of timberland/public forest lands so that they can apply for titling since the application for tenurial instrument is a long process and costly. Occupants within easement were also asking for the allowable easement and for possible relocation if they will be displaced from the present abode.

All these issues and concern has been properly addressed by the team.



### Recommendation:

1. Convey to the higher Office the necessity of reclassification/classification of timberlands/public forest lands. The last land classification in El Nido, Palawan was in 1998.
2. Maintain updating to the BLGU of the actions on the issues and concern it raised.

Respectfully submitting is the above subject as accomplishment on C.4 Conduct of Information Drive to communities to disseminate ENR laws and policies under Green Economy Model Approved Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for CY 2022.

On October 11, 2022 in the afternoon, the Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Team carry on the information dissemination about DENR services and programs and environmental laws in Barangay San Fernando, El Nido, Palawan. This barangay is not among the barangays that are subject of the implementation of Green Economy Model Project. However, the team included the barangay in IEC so that the residents will understand the government's goal in protecting and conserving the prime eco-tourism destinations of the country by delineating and cleaning the easements.



Among the topics being discussed by the team were the salient provisions of Presidential Decree 705 or the Revised Forestry Code, the Republic Act No. 9175 or Chainsaw Act, the tenurial instrument issued within protected areas and forestlands, processing of land titling, Presidential Decree 1067 or the Water Code, Republic Act No. 7942 or the Mining Act of 1995 and the implementation of Green Economy Model (GEM) Project.

Response of the Barangay Local Government Unit and of the community to the implementation of GEM Project is positive. They also want the project to be implemented in their barangay to delineate and clear off the easement for public use.

San Fernando does not have much issues and concerns. Though largely of San Fernando is within timberlands/public forest lands, occupants are holder of tenurial instrument such as Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC) and Community Based Forest Management Agreement (CBFMA).

- 1. Result of the assessment of Certificate of Stewardship Contracts
- 2. Allowable easement
