

Dear RED Claudio:

We are writing in connection to the requirement of Mining Projects within a Protected Area to secure a **Protected Area Management Bureau (PAMB) Clearance** from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR).

Please be informed that MacroAsia Corporation (rights transferred in 2021 to MacroAsia Mining Corporation or MMC) entered into an agreement with the Republic of the Philippines through the DENR/MGB with Mineral Production Sharing Agreement denominated as MPSA 220-2005-IVB granted on December 01, 2005, for a nickeliferous area encompassing an area of 1.113.9 hectares located in Barangays Ipilan, Mambalot and Maasin in Brooke's Point, Southern Palawan. The approval of said MPSA is prior to Proclamation No. 1815, s. 2009 (Mt. Mantalingahan Protected Landscape), which was signed on June 23, 2009. The said Proclamation states that:

"Any valid contract, permit or license for the extraction or utilization of natural resources therein already existing prior to this Proclamation shall subject to national interest and existing laws, rules and regulations, be respected until its expiration. Areas covered by such contracts, permits or licenses which are found not viable for development after assessment and/or exploration shall automatically form part of the MMPL. Likewise, all property and private rights within the MMPL already existing and/or vested prior to this Proclamation shall be respected in accordance with existing laws."

In this regard, may we request from your good office to consider the premises stated in the Proclamation for a PAMB Clearance Certificate. Should there be a need for an area verification of the MPSA viz the MMPL final area, our Company, thru its Operator, Calmia Nickel Inc. (CNI), is willing to shoulder the necessary costs that may be incurred incidental to the field verification. If it is amenable to your Office, the Company is also willing to shoulder the cost of engaging the services of a Geodetic Engineer (GE) deputized



by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) to provide technical expertise in the field verification and/or relocation.

Also attached in this letter is a map of the Mt. Mantalingahan Protected Landscape with the location of the Company's MPSA Area and the Approved Survey Plan of the MPSA, both of which are from the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) MIMAROPA for your reference.

The Technical Working Group (TWG) of MMPL PAMB is composed of six (6) members and the meeting was attended by three (3) regular members, therefore, had no quorum. Since there is no quorum, the TWG meeting was diverted into MMPL TWG Special meeting.

The meeting was attended by 8 guests, 2 from SIBOL, 2 from Macro-Asia, 2 from MGB thru online and 2 from Calmia Nickel Inc. also thru online.

Presentation of reviewed Section of MMPL Management Plan in connection to High Conservation Value of SIBOL project to be conducted in Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape	The subject activity focuses on the possible assistance/intervention of the SIBOL project in the finalization of MMPL PAMP 2021-2030 thru High Conservation Value Assessment (HCVA) program. FTI Cantuba discussed the initial assessment, commitment and decision made by the TWG members in the amendment of the MMPL PAMP 2021-2030 prior to the comments and instruction from the RED.	It was mentioned during the meeting that Conservation International (CI) and SIBOL had a complementation agreement pertaining to their programs in MMPL. One of those is the that site-specific approach wherein each project will not intervene or set another program specially of the same nature in the same area. Since HCVA is also bounded by the agreement and was set on specific sites (Barangays) only, the PAMO suggested to apply the HCVA program all-over MMPL to get holistic information.
	Two main programs under the MMPL PAMP 2021-2030 was identified for assistance by SIBOL, these are the Biophysical and Socio-Economic. Mr. Ramil Cyril Dacillo of SIBOL discussed the HCVA program in which three (3) survey activities could provide the data needed in the Bio-physical and Socio-Economic information gap of MMPL PAMP 2021-2030. The meeting was attended by guests from concern offices such as Mines and Geoscience Bureau (MGB), Calmia Nickel Inc. and Macro-Asia Mining corporation.

Despite the lack of quorum, Mr. Fabello of PCSDS and Ms. Ubani of DENR suggested and requested to continue with the discussion to make use of the time and effort of the present members, guests and PAMO staff and to initially hear and record important matters connected to the subject.

The PAMO thru the APASu discussed the actions taken by the PAMO based on the request for PAMB clearance by Macro-Asia thru Mr. Belgium Tandoc last March 11, 2022. In response, the PAMO conducted initial assessment last March 21, 2022 and required the proponent to provide the following documents.

- NCIP Clearance
- Area Clearance
- Barangay Resolution
- Municipal Resolution
- Proponents profile
- Copy of proponent's business permit

and on June 28-30, 2022 MMPL staff conducted site validation/ ground inspection of Macro-Asia Mining Corporation (MMC). However, data gathered is incomplete due to bad weather condition and other hindrances. Only 10 out of 30 corners were found.

The PAMO requested to continue the activity per emailed letter dated July 09, 2022 to Mr. Belgium S. Tandoc, Vice President for Business Development of Macro-Asia Mining Corporation, unfortunately, there is no response.

The guests agreed to continue with the discussion but no decision/motion was made.

The following subject matter were brought up and clarified during the discussion:

- 1. It would be better to have an MGB representative in the conduct of area validation based on the instruction of higher DENR Office. MGB representative present during the meeting replied that the request is possible if coordinated in advance.
- 2. The proponent has no objection with the validation activity of the PAMO.
- 3. The MPSA was approved first before the declaration of MMPL.
- 4. Request by the PAMO of list of other possibly approved MPSAs or applications inside the protected area. Noted by MGB.
- 5. One of the instructions of the Regional Office is to conduct inventory of resources in the area, in connection to this, the PASu asked what particular resources are to be inventoried. MGB representative suggested to refer on the old EIA of Macro-Asia. The suggestion was noted by the PASu.
- 6. Mr. Omar Alfonso of Macro-Asia said that one of the requirements for SEP clearance is the Biodiversity Assessment. Mr. Fabello added that it could be shared to the PAMB. The matter was noted by the PASu.
- The PAMO, present TWG members and Macro-Asia agreed to focused on locating the rest of the boundary corners of MPSA 220-2005-IVB before resolving data needed for inventory of natural resources.
- 8. PASu suggested that PAMO staff/team is available for the continuation of validation of activity on 3rd week of October and representative of Macro-Asia said that they will inform higher office for confirmation.

	On August 26, 2022 a memorandum dated August 18, 2022 was received by the PENRO thru channel from the OIC-Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services bearing instruction to verify the boundaries of the MPSA with completed staff work submitted to the Regional Office and presented to the PAMB.
