Please be informed that the undersigned with LMO II Elvie G. Base had join the celebration of 24th year of Presidential Proclamation Number 32, which declared the El-Nido – Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA) on October 8, 1998. Anchored on the theme "ENTMRPA for a protected future," the Protected Area Management Office led by Protected Area Superintendent Mildred Suza, prepared various activities to commemorate the law that ensured a long-term protection and maintenance of the island's biological diversity.

On October 4, a coastal clean-up was held at Lamoro Beach, in Bgy Pasadeña, which was participated by 55 individuals composed of representatives from Joint Task Force Malampaya, NAVSOG - Naval Special Operation Group, 23rd Marine Company Marine Battalion Landing Team - 3, Philippine Coastguard (PCG) and Protected Area Management Office (PAMO). The volunteers joined hands to make the 1.27 kilometer coastline litter-free as they collected approximately 325 kilos of mixed wastes, such as disposable plastic products, Styrofoam and fishing line.

On October 5, an Information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaign was held at the El Nido Elementary School which was participated by 50 students from Grades 5 and 6. The campaign included the presentation of the ENTMRPA profile and the PA's flagship species, which is the marine turtle.

The following day, Paoi, the mascot of the flagship species, led a motorcade around the town. Later that day, a simple culminating program in Brgy. Maligaya was held to recognize stakeholders and partners who have relentlessly showed their support in upholding the ecological integrity of ENTMRPA.

During the program, DENR MIMAROPA Regional Executive Director Lormelyn Claudio sent her congratulations through a video message. She said she was grateful to the Protected Area Management Board and the rest of the stakeholders for the progress of ENTMRPA in terms of the implementation of related local ordinances and resolutions. She emphasized that El Nido is one of the five priority sites for the Green Economy Model (GEM), hence persistent protection and conservation efforts from everybody is expected to help maintain the beauty and cleanliness of El Nido.

The Director also acknowledged the private sectors especially the El Nido Chamber of Commerce Incorporated (ENCCI) for their active participation in securing equilibrium between tourism and environmental protection. RED Claudio also lauded the LGU for their good governance, as well as the construction of the state of the art Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP), which is a compliance with Republic Act 9275 or the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004. The STP is operating to address the wastewater problems in the municipality.

Coincidentally, the activities were also set as the country declared the year 2022 as the National Year for Protected Areas (YoPA)

Palawan PENRO Felizardo B. Cayatoc, and Taytay CENRO Alan L. Valle of CENRO also sent their greetings and great hopes for ENTMRPA through video messages. Meanwhile, Municipal Administrator Raffy Cabate imparted in his message that he looks forward to ensuring the town's strict compliance with existing rules and regulations amidst all the challenges that they may confront them. Sangguniang Bayan member Sonny Llanera and El Nido Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officer (MENRO) Raul Maximo were also present to grace the program.

Other stakeholders and partners present are Malampaya Foundation Incorporated (MFI), Palawan Council Sustainable Development (PCSD), Municipal Tourism Officer (MTO), ENCCI, BELTTOA, Travel and Tours Organization, JTFM 23rd MC MBLT-3, Barangay Officials of Barangay Maligaya, ENTMRPA-PAMO staff and DENR CENRO Taytay staff.
