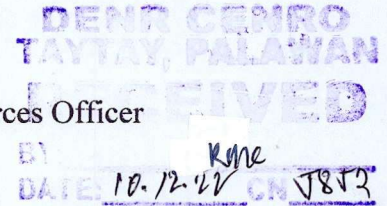

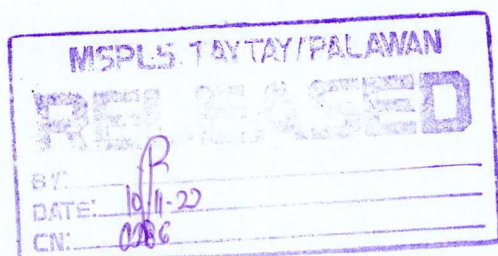
This pertains to the request of representation from this Office of the Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) of Barangay Cataban in cleaning/clearing drive at Kuyawyaw Falls in preparation of the re-opening of tourism activities within Taytay, Palawan.

Please be informed that on October 7, 2022, this Office assisted the personnel from Municipal Tourism Office of LGU Taytay, fraternity/sorority of Taytay, tour guides of Kuyawyaw funded by BLGU Cataban, Barangay Officials of Cataban and different sectors in the conduct of the above-mentioned activity.

The said activity includes the clearing of uprooted/fallen trees caused by typhoon Odette that blocked the paths going to the first (1st) to third (3rd) falls as well as branches of trees that fell into the river, however some of the fallen trees were not taken due to its size and insufficient manpower. Furthermore, Barangay Kagawad John Rey Rodriguez suggested together with BLGUs of Cataban to request a chain block to the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Taytay that can be used to haul the said trees at the same time a registered chainsaw.

Likewise, the BLGU Cataban will inform this Office for the assistance on the possible schedule of the next cleaning/clearing drive at Kuyayaw Falls, Barangay Cataban, Taytay, Palawan for the continuation of the said preparation for tourism activity.
