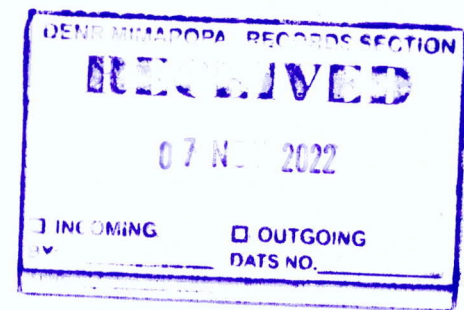

DESCRIPTION OF OPERATIVE TECHNIQUE: Patient's name and planned procedure verified. Patient in supine position under general anesthesia. Asepsis and antisepsis done. Skin markings made. An S-incision encompassing the nipple-areola complex and previous excision site was made and carried down by layers. Superior flap mobilized up to the clavicle and latissimus dorsi. Inferior flap mobilized up to the sternum and upper border of the rectus abdominis. Proceeded with mastectomy, separating the breast from the pectoralis major using electrocautery. Proceeded with axillary lymph node dissection. Thoracodorsal and long thoracic nerves were preserved. Hemostasis ensured. Washing with NSS. JP drain placed, secured to the skin using Silk 3-0. Closure of layers with Polysorb 3-0, inverted T technique. Skin closure using Polysorb 4-0. Sterile dressings placed. Patient tolerated procedure well.
