**IMPLEMENTATION** 

Pertaining to the target activity on the conduct of Continuing Diving Training as part of Green Fins implementation under the Coastal and Marine Ecosystem Management Program (CMEMP) for CENRO Coron, Palawan, respectfully submitted is the activity report on 10day diving sessions and training facilitated by the Safety Stop Dive Shop as the contractor.

The said training was conducted on September 27-28, 2022, October 4-7 and 11-14, 2022 Eight (8) personnel from CENRO Coron underwent the refresher course for advance diving including series of diving sessions which aims to capacitate CENRO Coron divers with skills in relation to the implementation of Green Fins in Coron, Palawan and accumulate 50 dive logs pre-qualification for Green Fins Assessors Training.

The first day of the training focused on the refresher course and lectures about the advance diving skills such as deep diving, navigational diving and buoyancy control as well as assembling and disassembling the equipment/gears; and, safety precautions and other protocols of diving while the remaining 9-days focused on actual diving sessions in shipwreck diving sites to enhance the proper breathing and buoyancy of divers as well as to meet the number of logs needed for Assessors Training.

A total of 27-dives logs per participants were earned during these sessions with close supervision of dive instructors/masters where 3-dives with 1-1.5 hours dive interval were done per day. Orientation and dive site familiarization were also conducted on the boat by Dive Masters/Instructors before entering the water.


