MARIBONG, BARANGAY PLOT INTERIOR, SOFRONIO ESPAÑOLA, PALAWAN LAST OCTOBER 5, 2022**



This is to inform that the undersigned MMPL Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) personnel successfully conducted the 3rd quarter BMS FGD and distributed 30 pcs sugar and coffee container at So. Maribong, Barangay Pulot Interior Sofronio Española, Palawan last October 5, 2022.

The activity started at around 10 in the morning and was participated by 16 people consisted of 12 Males and 4 Females.

Three (3) main subjects were discussed during the meeting such as the wildlife observation, terrestrial resources and issues and concern inside the protected area.

One of the female participants told that she has observed flock of talking mynahs and blue napped parrots resting above the canopy of a tree somewhere while going home from buying goods downtown. Others told that they have seen a Palawan peacock peasant and a Tabon bird pecking on the ground somewhere inside the forest of MMPL.

In the terrestrial resources that the community get from MMPL, Buntot Tigres, Sambong, Makahiya and Banaba, herbal plants to cure kidney problems.

During discussion regarding issues and concern, the same female participants told that the presence of Tabon bird and Palawan peacock peasant has gradually declined since the operation of CitiNickel mining corporation although the said mining area is outside the protected area.

Additionally, Panglima (IP leader) Lonesio Aplino and Panglima Kenesio Malasan told that they have observed that Almaciga trees in their area are dying from improper and over tapping and requested for assistance for the proper utilization and permitting of Almaciga collection. The PAMO staff advised the two IP leaders to get assistance from the Barangay and write a letter of request to the PAMB to properly address their concern with the involvement of other concern agencies such as DENR CENRO Brooke's, PCSD, NCIP and MLGU.

Before homebound, the PAMO staff distributed 30 pcs sugar and coffee container to the FGD participants as part of the CEPA target under DENR Work and Financial Plan 2022.


The participants were only 16 but to maximize the time, MMPL PAMO staff decided to hand over the rest of the sugar and coffee container to the present FGD participants provided that they also distribute them to their family and friends.

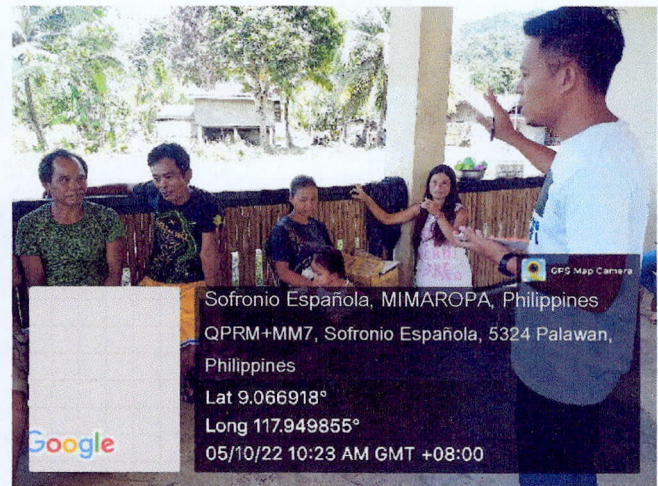
