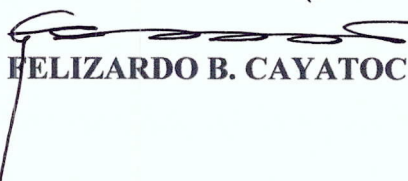

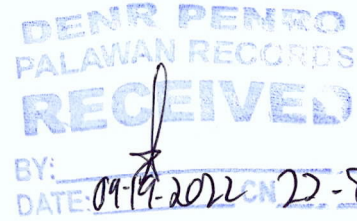

Respectfully submitted is the Patrol Plan for the 4th quarter of CENRO – Coron Lawin Unit/Team.

This patrol plan aims to be implemented and enforced within our area of jurisdiction to maximize the presence of our enforcement personnel which will serve as a deterrent to environmental offenders and other similar illegal activities may arise therein.

Above patrol plan was based on our previous Lawin monitoring and patrolling accomplishment within our Forest Conservation area (FCA). Including outside FCA which would be identified or noted with similar activities therein.

These areas includes areas of Forestlands, watersheds, and mangroves. Same includes portions/areas of Busuanga Pasture Reserve (BPR) areas where prone of activities which needs regular monitoring and thru an augmentation activities with BPRMO.

Furthermore, the Lawin Teams/Patrollers presently ongoing on establishment of Forest Product Monitoring Stations (FPMS) on designated potential areas in support and to strengthen our monitoring activities.

Conservation targets	Thru a massive team efforts of regular patrolling and implementing law enforcement on natural forest sites, watersheds and mangrove areas: a.) Incidents of slash and burn farming (kaingin), timber poaching and charcoal-making will be reduced by an approximate by 15% within the next Ten (10) years. Based on our 2017 record counts of 304 illegal cuttings/timber poaching, 141 counts of charcoal making and 141 record counts of slash and Burn (Kaingin). b.) Wildlife Sanctuaries and Refuge sites shall be rehabilitated and lessen the illegal hunting of wildlife species by 20% encounter rate within the next Ten (10) years. c.) Consequently, there shall be a sustainable or rather increase volume of water discharge/supply by reducing forest loss at around 20% within the next Ten (10) years. d.) Having a community responsible, well inform and oriented programmed and limitations and proper engagement in acquiring of any forest products.

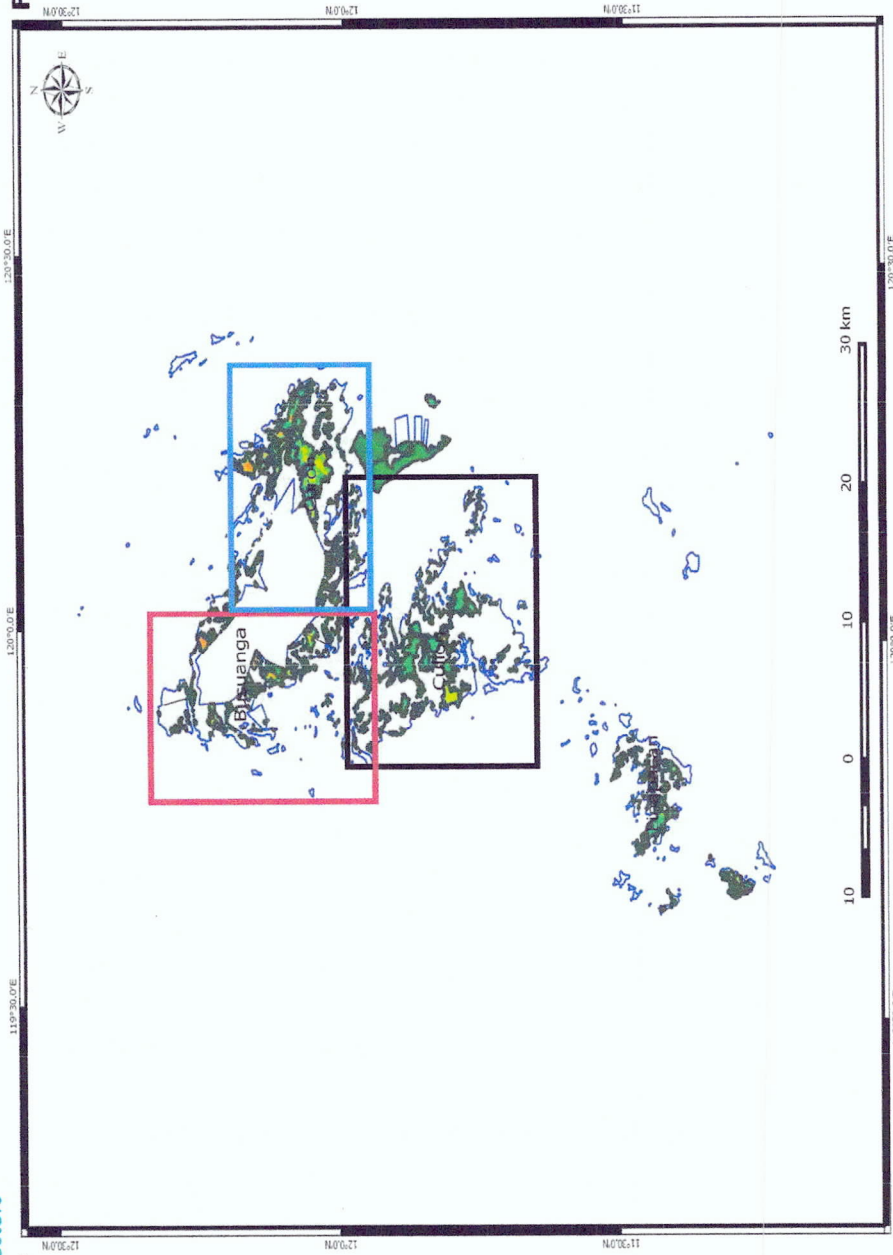
