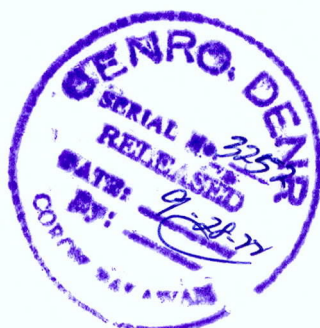

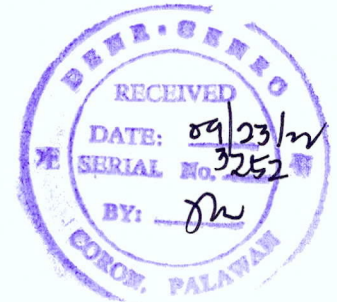

**SUBJECT : AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF 2022 INTERNATIONAL  
COASTAL CLEAN-UP (ICC) DAY ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2022**



Pursuant to the Special Order No. 2022-660 dated September 14, 2022 regarding the above mentioned subject with theme ***“Fighting for Trash Free Seas – Pilipinas: Ending the Flow of Trash at the Source”*** adopted from the Ocean Conservancy with practical solutions that empower people, strengthen science, engage everyone in solutions and promote good policies.

In connection to this, the DENR CENRO Coron spearheaded simultaneous coastal clean-up in collaboration with Local Government of Busuanga and Coron, Palawan on September 17, 2022 from 7:00 in the morning onwards at different identified sites in Busuanga and Coron.

A total of 288 sacks of trash were collected by more or less 911 individuals from different government agencies, non-government agencies, private sectors and other stakeholders in Busuanga and Coron, Palawan such as Philippine National Police (PNP), PNP Maritime, PCBSI, DepEd, Parole, DENR CENRO, Calamianes Association of Tourism Establishment (CATE), Calamianes Divers Association Inc. (CDAI), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), LGU and BLGU of said municipalities, Coron District Hospital, Palawan State University-ROTC, Navy Reservist, Calamianes Island Power Corporation (CIPC), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and youths. As observed, mostly of trash collected were plastics like PET bottles, plastic cups and different food packaging presumably from the adjacent communities present near the coastal areas as well as from improper waste management of boat operators, and some tourists/visitors.

Moreover, Scubasurero/underwater clean-up was also conducted at CYC Island and Arnis point with participation of 36 individuals from groups of PCG, CDAI and DENR CENRO Coron. The collected trashes underwater were composed of plastics, glass bottles, ropes, and nylons approximately 76 kilograms.

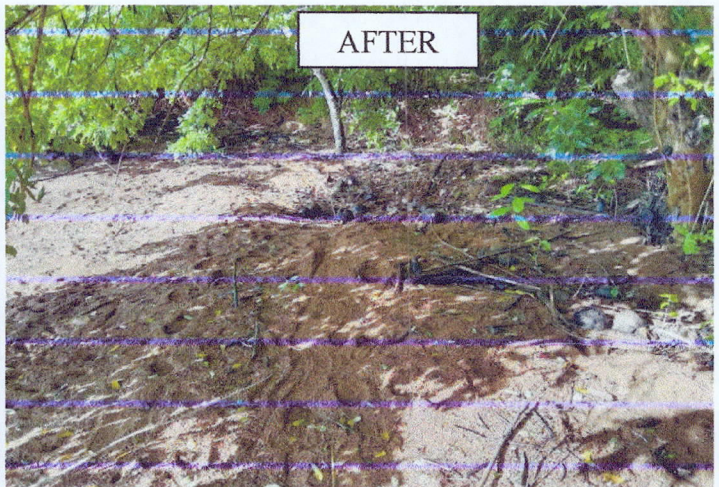
