
SUMMARY OF ACCOMPLISHMENT

To date, the Lawin Team accomplished a total of 721.80 kilometers distance patrolled with within our area of jurisdiction/Conservation Area or an equivalent of 120.03% against our annual target 0f 600 kilometers.

Patrolling within the above period was maximized to surpass the targeted patrol/route. This is to ensure continuous monitoring and regular presence of our personnel within our territorial jurisdiction.

Furthermore, the sectors were deployed and continuing establishment Forest Product Monitoring Stations (FPMS) to intensify all environmental related activities in the field.






a) Patrol Route Location/s:





# **Forest Protection Effectiveness Report**

#### Region 04B - Coron

This reports presents trends in observations of forest condition, regeneration, threats and indicator species. The combined presentation allows for an evaluation if protection efforts are effective, conservation targets are met and the forest achieves the desired future forest condition. Protection efforts are effective, when records of forest condition, regeneration and indicator species show an upward trend towards more observations more and denser regeneration, particularly in degraded forest areas. Increasing trends in indicator species suggest that the improved forest condition is providing a better habitat for forest dependent species. All trends presented are put in relation to the patrol effort to provide comparability. Forest cover data were derived from 2003 and 2010 NAMRIA land cover maps.

#### **Trend in Threats**



A decreasing trend in threats in the forest conservation area mean effective forest protection; an increasing trend means the opposite.
