Based on the report submitted he was able to coordinate with the office of Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) and ascertained the following information.

That about 3,000 hectares covered by Fishpond Lease Agreement (existing and expired FLAs) within the municipalities of San Jose and Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro and approximately 10% of these areas are being used for Salt Production particularly during summer; That the salt is considered as secondary product of the Fishpond Development however, the agency has no existing data on the total salt production. That, the BFAR is currently conducting research study and consultation meeting with the salt producers in relation to the pending House Bill on the subject matter.

Likewise, he learned also, that there is an existing cooperative (Tamaraw Salt Producers Cooperative) of Salt based in San Jose, Occidental Mindoro, whose members are both holders of Fishpond Lease Agreement and private landowners. The CENRO is currently coordinating to gather information to be submitted to that office soonest.




