The HCVA project will support the enhancement of SEAMS and BAMS by formulating a tool that would cover and combine the two systems. They initially call this project BEAMS or the Biodiversity and Economic Assessment and Monitoring System.

Prof. Mallari and Ms. Rina respectfully asked why does SIBOL project particularly the HCVA program has to undergo a PAMB resolution where in fact they only support the plans and programs of MMPL based from its PA Management Plan 2021-2030.

Ms. Rina and Prof. Mallari understood and stated that they are willing to comply for the progression of the program.

Day 2: Approved Agenda

Agenda 2:

Marites Tauro of the National Museum presented the proposed activity for agenda 2.

She explained that Mr. Pierre de Vallombreus was a French photographer who is fond of taking photos of IPs and started taking pietures of Tau't bato tribe as early as 2016 whereas his pietures were even showcased at the National Museum Manila, Philippines and have published a book of the same subject back in 2018.

Ms. Tauro elaborated that Mr. Vallombreus is not under a contract thou he has an agreement with the National Museum whereas he allowed to take pictures of the Tau't bato and the product will have combined property rights.

The result of the activity will be displayed in the National Museum.

Ms. Jeanne T. Tabangay motioned to defer the proposal and will be accommodated once pertinent documents are secured. This motion was seconded by Dr. Lita B. Sopsop.

Agenda 3:

This agenda was presented by Mr. Keith Fabro a Contributor of Mongabay.com.

He first discussed the result of his recently conducted project "Effect of Climate Change to the basketry industry of IPs inside MMPL".

He then discussed his new proposal "Interview Pala' wan Indigenous leaders and women basket weavers to produce a multimedia journalistic story highlighting how solar energy empowers them in continuing their basketry and other associated traditions, while helping authorities in forest conservation".

As its title suggest Mr. Fabro seeks to know how solar set panels provided by the provincial government helping IPs in basket making. PENRO Felizardo B. Cayatoc moved for the approval of the project pending completion of documents required by the PAMB. The motion was seconded by Dr. Lita B. Sopsop.

Agenda 4:

The presentation was delivered by Dr. Margaret M. Calderon of the College of Forestry and Natural Resources, University of the Philippines Los Baños.

She explained that project aims to review existing policies on almaciga resin tapping, Document local or indigenous almaciga resin tapping knowledge and practices and their relation to resin yield, establish the technical/scientific basis for determination of almaciga resin quota, build partnership, develop almaciga resources research and development directions and lastly, craft and advocate a draft policy that will rationalize the utilization of almaciga resources in the country.

Dr. Calderon stated that the study site of the project will be in the area of SPABP, Amas, Brooke's Point, Palawan and that they would like to Ms. Jeanne T. Tabangay moved for the approval of the project and it was seconded by Dr. Lita B. Sopsop.
