Compliance Monitoring Unit together with the CBFM Unit of CENRO Puerto Princesa conducted a compliance monitoring on the People's Organizations which were awarded with CBFM Agreement. There are sixteen (16) CBFMAs awarded within the jurisdiction of CENRO PPC and six (6) were monitored this quarter.

## 1. BAGOBUK (Bagong Buhay Kay Kristo Community Multi-Purpose Cooperative)

The BAGOBUK (Bagong Buhay Kay Kristo) Community Multi-Purpose Cooperative was awarded with CBFM Agreement No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2002-31 issued on October 22, 2002, covering a total of two hundred ten (210) hectares of forest land located at Barangay Napsan, Puerto Princesa City. The BAGOBUK MPC was registered with Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) with Registration No. LGA-CA No. 0348 dated September 21, 1999, issued at Calamba, Laguna. BAGOBUK MPC was organized through the spirit of social cooperation among the lowlanders and the indigenous people of Barangay Napsan. Originally the BAGOBUK MPC has 83 members, it was reduced to forty-five (45) and now none of them are still active.

They are once a beneficiary of an agroforestry plantation project which was funded by Philippine Tropical Forest Conservation Foundation (PTFCF) through the help of Enterprise Works Worldwide/Philippines (EWW/P), who provided technical assistance.

In the year 2012, the BAGOBUK MPC became a partner of DENR in implementing the National Greening Program (NGP) and was given a contract of thirty-three (33) hectares coffee plantation.

After such activities, this office struggled in communicating with the chairman or any of its members to get an update with regards to the status of their cooperative and CBFM.

Since it was pioneered by a Catholic priest and previously managed by a nun, we have also tried to inquire with the local Catholic parish in the area, unfortunately, they informed us that they were not familiar with the project.

Given the circumstances and the absence of any members that will guide the team to have an ocular inspection of the area, for several years, we were not able to inspect or monitor the CBFM area.

On January 31, 2020, the CENRO sent a letter with attached *PABATID* (notice for the members of the cooperative to coordinate to this office) addressed to Barangay Captain Gerry M. Acosta of Brgy. Napsan seeking his assistance in locating and to convening the members of CBFM-PO of BAGOBUK.

On August 26, 2020 in an effort to convene the members of the cooperative, we again went to Barangay Napsan. We coordinated with the Barangay to get an update on the status of the letter and the *pabatid* that we have sent on January 31, 2020, but per information from Brgy. Kagawad Jeany Manito, no member or official had come to their Office to ask regarding the posted *pabatid*.

Last year, to give the cooperative another chance to coordinate and inform this Office if their organization still exists and still willing to continue with the CBFM, another coordination and inquiry with the Baragangay was conducted.

On March 10, 2021, another notice was posted in Barangay Napsan Bulletin Board requesting the officers and members to coordinate to the DENR CENRO within 15 days from the date of posting, if they are still interested to continue the CBFM. Unfortunately, 15 days had passed but no communication or manifestation was received coming from any member or officer of the cooperative.

Fortunately, during inquiry with the Barangay, a certain IPMR and Bgy.Kagawad Lowing Camal informed us that he knew the area of the CBFM of BAGUBOK. Guiding the team, he brought us in an area along Napsan road and pointed areas that he claimed to be part of the CBFM area. In it, a trail/access road was observed, and portions of the CBFM area have already occupied by claimants as evidence by the presence of fences. Accordingly, the CBFM area is also within the CADT of SAMAKANABA.

The PO has been negligent in the performance of their duty especially in forest protection where intrusion by land speculators as mentioned by Kgwd. Camal can be attributed. The lack of coordination to this Office for several years despite notices, non-submission of 5 year and annual work plan can be qualified as a non-performance on the part of the PO. And on that account, it may be inferred that they no longer interested to continue with the CBFM. This unit has done its part to reach out for them to be able to extend technical and other help that we are capable of, but such effort is to no avail.

In the CBFM Agreement, it was stated that its implementation shall include forest protection, and under the "Obligation of Parties" item no. 2.1 states that the CBFM holder shall: "Immediately assume responsibility for the protection of the entire forest lands within the CBFM area against illegal logging and other unauthorized extraction of forest product, slash and burn agriculture (kaingin)..." and under item No. 6 under "Termination of Contract-The CBFMA may be terminated based on the non-performance of the PO...".

In addition, per Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) DAO 96-29 of EO 263, Article II Section I provides that "The principal participants in CBFMP shall be the local communities as represented by their organizations, herein referred to as People's Organizations (POs). Since their organization no longer exists, the **BAGOBUK** is no longer qualified to continue the CBFM.

In view of the above, the undersigned recommends the cancellation of the CBFM issued to BAGOBUK.

## 2. Candes Marketing Cooperative (CMC)

The Candes Marketing Cooperative (CMC), with office located at Sitio Candes II, Bgy. Bacungan, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan, is an organization registered with the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) under Registration No. 95-04020662 dated October 17, 2011. Currently, it has a total of more or less 150 members/beneficiaries.

On June 7, 2000, a Community Based Forest Management Agreement (CBFMA) No. RIV\_PAL CBFM-00-07 was entered between them and the DENR. In the CBFM they were given the responsibility to protect and opportunity of managing the 740.88 hectares of forestland located at So. Candes II, Barangay Bacungan.

In 2013, the said Cooperative was a recipient of Spring Development Sagana at Ligtas sa Lahat (SALINTUBIG) Project –Water Supply Level II. The said project was funded by Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) together with the City Government of Puerto Princesa and the City Engineering Department. The said project was now functional and already beneficial to the members of the Cooperative and the neighboring community.

In 2016, the CMC was awarded with a project entitled "Agroforestry, Timber and Fuel Wood Production" under the funding of CBFM-CARP-158. It has a total area of 50 hectares that was implemented within the CBFM area. Out of 50 hectares, 20 hectares was allotted for forest tree plantation, 20 hectares for fruit trees, 10 hectares for fuel wood production and 1.25 hectares for the cash crops intercropped within the plantation. The project has a total project cost of ₱858,480.00 with direct investment cost of ₱686,784.00 and ₱171, 696.00 for supervision and management.

On November 23, 2016, the cooperative was issued Resource Use Permit with a total allowable cut of 125,196 lineal meters for 500 hectares rattan production area.

In 2019, CMC has updated their Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF). It is currently pending at the higher Office for affirmation.

During monitoring, the Chairman mentioned that they encountered several problems in the protection of their CBFM area. One of these is that the area is remote, hilly and trekking is the only mode of its accessibility. Another problem is that most of the members who were still active are women which make it difficult for them to conduct regular forest patrolling.


Alleged illegal selling of areas of non-members who have claim within CBFM area was also one of the issues the organization is facing.

Currently, no activities are being conducted in the area. With regard to their organization, they still manage to have a meeting every Saturday though most of them do not participate. According to the chairman, she does not oblige them to attend regularly for most of them are working except if there is an urgent matter that the cooperative need to discuss.

Due to financial difficulties, they were not able to renew their CDA registration. Their lack of funds and manpower also resulted to their failure to implement all their proposed physical target for year 2022 as indicated in their CRMF.

Last year, a Non-Government Organization (NGO) named Assert-CBFM conducted a series of seminars, workshops and trainings regarding rattan production for CBFM PO's. One of the fortunate PO's to joined the said activity in the CMC. According to the Chairman, the said NGO commit to also provide financial support to their organization that they are expecting to receive before this year end.

The onslaught of typhoon Odette also affected the CBFM holder, their Cooperative Hall was damaged by the typhoon. Construction of new the hall is on-going but according to the chairman, construction materials needed for the reconstruction are not yet all completed.

## 3. Candes III Marketing Cooperative

The Candes III Marketing Cooperative was awarded with a CBFM Agreement No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2005-40 issued on November 20, 2005 covering a total area of four hundred sixty-three (463) hectares of forest land located at Sitio Candes III, Barangay Bacungan, Puerto Princesa City. It is registered with Cooperative Development Authority with Registration No. CDA-9520-04023470 issued on June 13, 2013 in Calamba, Laguna.

In 1998, Japan Overseas Forestry Consultants Association (JOFCA) granted a project for the implementation of Community Based Agro-Forestry and Reforestation Project. The Candes III MPC was a recipient of the Biodiversity Conservation in Puerto Princesa's Northwest Area and its Attached Interconnected Ecosystem which was funded by USAID Phil-Am Fund in 2014. The said project had implemented a total of one hundred fifty (150) hectares enrichment planting using endemic species. They were also a beneficiary of UNDP Small Grant Project (SGP4) for the implementation of Rehabilitation and Conservation of Bacungan Watershed thru Agroforestry and Reforestation from 2012-2014. This project includes nursery management, planting of endemic tree species, establishment of firebreaks, assisted natural regeneration, conduct of foot patrolling and establishment of watch tower.

In 2016, they also undertake the implementation of Improving Lives of Upland Dwellers thru the Implementation of Functional CBFM funded by UNDP-SGP5 and Enrichment Planting of CBFM Forest funded by USAID.

On 2019 their CRMF was updated and currently pending affirmation at the regional Office. On their 2020-2030 plan the cooperative proposed the following activities supposed to be accomplished this year: 1. Increase of forest vegetation, 2. Establishment of livelihood projects/enterprises, 3. Nursery production, 4. Establishment of watch tower and checkpoint, 5. Rattan enrichment, 6. DENRO deputation and etc.

Last year they have started their ecotourism activity. A waterfall located within CBFM area was developed into a bathing site and cottages made of light materials were constructed. Entrance and tour guide fee were collected to visitors/ tourist.

On August 16, 2022, the CBFM Po entered and agreement with Puerto Princesa City Water District for the development of Bacungann Water System Development Project. In the said MOA, members of the C3MC will be given preferential privilege in hiring of labors needed for the implementation of the project. Two of their members will be employed as dam caretaker and forest ranger when the project starts to operate. And the C3MC will be receiving 100 cubic meters every month.

## 4.SALVACION PAGKAKAISA PANGKALIKASAN ASSOCIATION, INC.

The Salvacion Pagkakaisa Pangkalikasan Association, Inc. was formerly known as Salvacion Marketing Cooperative was awarded with CBFM Agreement No. 00-08 issued on June 7, 2007 with a total of 602.53 hectares of forest land located at Barangay Salvacion, Puerto Princesa City. The organization was registered with Securities and Exchange Commission with Registration No. CN201506124 dated March 26, 2015. Currently they were only 15 members/beneficiaries left and out of 66 original members.

In 2009, the PO was granted with CBFM – CARP Project entitled Agroforestry Plantation in Combination with Cashew and Vegetable Production with a total project cost of ₱856,766.25. Although they have completed the target accomplishment on year 2011, the monitoring shows low survival rate of the planted trees that can be attributed to poor maintenance and protection.

The PO aside from CARP had also acquired funding from the Department of Agriculture for Native Bag weaving but did not prosper and they stopped their production due to low sales, marketing problem and linkage to promote the product. In 2016, the PO planned to establish a Goat Raising Project as part of their livelihood program to help their members in generating additional source of income but this project did not materialize.

On 2017, another CARP project entitled "Agro-forestry plantation in combination with fruit trees, and vegetable demo farm" was again granted to them. Monitoring and inspection were conducted simultaneously on March 12, 2020 for the billing of their retention fee. However, inspection shows that the 50 hectares plantation were not able to meet the required 85% percent requirement survival rate required for the payment of retention fee. Up to this date the cooperative has yet to claim the retention fee due to low survival rate.

The PO had also contracted a total of 200 hectares for the Enhanced NGP for 2017 but they were not able to get the retention due to low survival rate.

Currently, no other project was undertaken within the CBFM area.

# 5. SAN RAFAEL TANABAG CONCEPCION MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE

The San Rafael Tanabag, Concepcion Multi-Purpose Cooperative (STCMPC) was one of the first cooperatives that has been awarded of a CBFM Agreement. The CBFM Project covers three (3) barangays of Puerto Princesa namely San Rafael, Tanabag and Concepcion covering a total area of five thousand (5,000) hectares of forestland with CBFM Agreement No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-98-03 issued on February 12, 1999. The STCMPC is registered with Cooperative Development Authority with registration no. LGA 2512 issued on June 28, 1998. The STCMPC originally had 433 members but currently all of them are already inactive.

On 2018, the CBFM unit had a dialogue with the then Barangay Captain of Concepcion Mr. Rolando Antolo, one of the Barangays where the CBFM is located. He mentioned that it is been a long time since the STCMPC has become inactive, and he has already issued a resolution that the CBFM members that area residents of his barangay are no longer interested in the reactivation of the cooperative.

On 2020, the CBFM unit thru this Office issued a notice which was forwarded to Brgy. San Rafael, Tanabag and Concepcion addressing the CBFM members of the defunct STCMPC to communicate to this Office as soon as possible if they are still interested to the reactivation of their CBFM, unfortunately, no coordination was received.

Last year, another PABATID were posted in three Barangays where the CBFM area is located. They were given 15 days to communicate to this Office if they are still interested with the project. Unfortunately, no letter or communication was received coming from any members or previous officer of the cooperative up to this date.

According to the Punong Barangay of San Rafael, the CBFM area was already occupied by various claimants and illegal forest activities are alleged being committed.

The PO as per record based on previous monitoring has been inactive for several years; hence the CBFM project has been long neglected. It has been negligent in the performance of their duty especially in forest protection where intrusion by land speculators can be attributed. The lack of coordination to this Office for several years despite notices can be qualified as a non-performance on the part of the PO. And on that account, it may infer that they no longer interested to continue with the CBFM.

In the CBFM Agreement, it was stated that its implementation shall include forest protection, and under the "Obligation of Parties" item no. 2.1 states that the CBFM holder shall: "Immediately assume responsibility for the protection of the entire forest lands within the CBFM area against illegal logging and other unauthorized extraction of forest product, slash and burn agriculture (kaingin)..." and under item No. 6 under "Termination of Contract-The CBFMA may be terminated based on the non-performance of the PO...".

In addition, per Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) DAO 96-29 of EO 263, Article II Section I provides that "The principal participants in CBFMP shall be the local communities as represented by their organizations, herein referred to as People's Organizations (POs). ## 6. TAGBUROS AQUA-VENTURE MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE

The Tagburos Aqua-Venture Multi-Purpose Cooperative, Inc. (TAVEMCO) was awarded with CBFM Agreement No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-00-19 issued on August 17, 2000 with a total area of 275 hectares of mangrove and coastal area located at Sitio Aplaya, Barangay Tagburos, Puerto Princesa City. TAVEMCO was registered with the CDA with Registration No. LGA-5011 issued on July 10, 2001. There were forty-nine (49) active members at that time but at present, more or less only 15 members are active.

TAVEMCO has a contract with DENR-Comprehensive Site Development under the Mangrove Rehabilitation Sub-Project (MRSP) of Sub-Site Management Office (SUSIMO). It aims to rehabilitate and protect two hundred seventy-two (272) hectares of mangrove area within the CBFM.

On January 17, 2017, CENRO PPC scheduled a meeting/re-orientation for the members of TAVEMCO. Issues discussed involves their appeal on their interrupted project in Cowrie Island due to land claim dispute which is still unresolved up to this day.

The cooperative has already renamed their Organization into Tagburos-Aqua Venture Producers Cooperative.

Currently, no activities are being undertaken by the cooperative aside from random foot patrolling. During the site inspection, it was observed that there are settlers within and adjacent to the mangrove area within the CBFM. Some portions of the mangrove covered by the CBFM was severely damaged by the onslaught of typhoon Odette.
