Respectfully submitted is the report on the inspection and monitoring of the CBFM-CARP project CY-2022 of Bantoto-Abaroan Farmers Multipurpose Cooperative (BAFARMAI) conducted on July 29, 2022. The project is entitled as Agroforestry Plantation and a combination of fruits trees and vegetables with Lagundi Honey Production.

During monitoring, the PO already established their nursery. The seeds of Calamansi that have already sprouted and other seedlings that have already grown are taking care-off by individual/PO beneficiary. Almost all of their target seedlings have been accomplished waiting for the right time of transplanting to the plantation site.

However, it was observed that the seedlings grow slowly maybe the nutrition available from the soil may not be sufficient for their growth due to unhealthy soil used and not in proper care and maintenance. As a MEO assigned to monitoring these are my recommendations:

- 1. Use of organic fertilizer like manure from cow/carabao to become healthy seedling and their nursery area,
- 2. The nursery area is in one place for proper care and constant monitoring, and
- 3. Establishment of fences and nets to avoid the attack of livestock and wild animals including rodents like mice/rats.


With the above, the undersigned MEO will continuously monitor and supervise the project activities to ascertain the completion of the project.



Respectfully submitted is the report on the inspection and monitoring of the CBFM-CARP project CY-2022 of Macatumbalen Community Based Forest and Coastal Management Association (MCBFCMA) for CY 2022. The project is entitled as livelihood erosion and Bamboo plantation.

During monitoring the nursery site of bamboo seedlings production together with the PO's Project Manager; Jimmy Tablazon, so far, they already completed bamboo seedlings of 2,000 pcs wherein the target produced is based on the Work Financial Plan (WFP).

During monitoring, the PO already established their Nursery (Bamboo) under the sheds of forest trees and is ready for transplant to the planting site.

As MEO assigned in the monitoring, below are the recommendations, to wit:

- 1. Advised the recipient PO to complete the total target of other species seedlings needed based on WFP,
- 2. PO members of (MCBFCMA) currently continue conducting the strip brushing and site preparation for the upcoming transplanting of the bamboo seedlings,
- 3. Prepare the nursery for Gmelina seedlings instead of Mahogany as required in the WFP.

With the above, the undersigned MEO will continuously monitor and supervise the project activities to ascertain the completion of the project.


