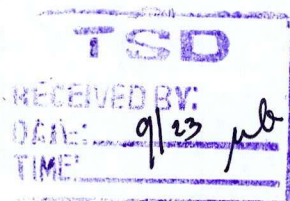
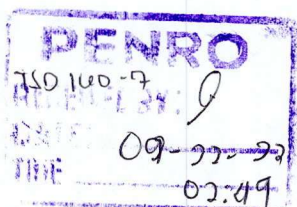



NARRATIVE REPORT


