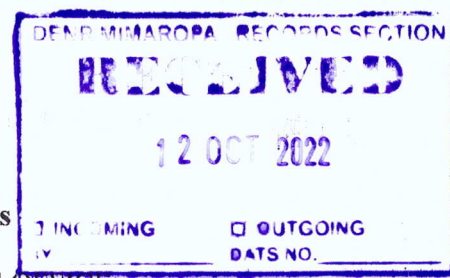

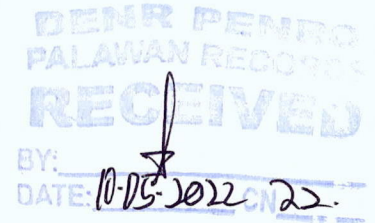

Respectfully submitted herewith is the consolidated apprehension report of Monitoring and Enforcement Section personnel of this Office. This is in compliance/justification to the actual accomplishment as compared to the target volume of apprehension of undocumented forest products for the 3rd Quarter based on the Approved Work and Financial Plan for CY 2022.

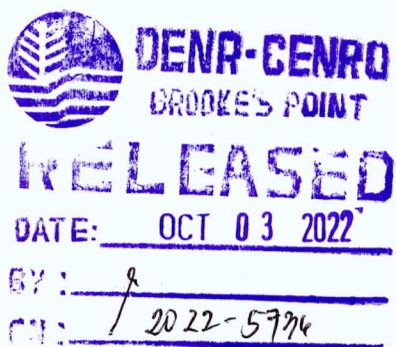
As per reports submitted, a total of **1,058.32** board feet of undocumented forest products (lumber and timber) were apprehended by the Joint Operation of personnel of Brooke's Point MPS-PNP and Palawan PPO Provincial Intelligence and Patrol Base II Lada Monitoring station of DENR-CENRO, Brooke's Point based on the record the total apprehended Forest product is equivalent to **55.9%** of the total target for the quarter which is **1,890** board feet. However the equivalent apprehended volume of Forest product to date had recorded **1,556.3** board feet or **20.58%** of the total target which **7,560** board feet for annual target.

The strengthening of linkages and continuous coordination with other concerned agencies and the intensified forest protection activities undertaken by the Enforcement and Monitoring Section personnel of this Office resulted to the reduced volume and incidences of apprehension. Moreover, the filing of cases against the identified violators/perpetrators facilitated during the previous years has been a great factor in increasing the community is public awareness/realization re: the importance of forest in facing with the global warming and also the office seriously/efficient implementing our existing environmental laws and policies. Likewise, Information Education and Communication Campaign/Activities have been intensified and regularly being conducted.

Further, aside from patrolling, monitoring and surveillance activities, existing livelihood programs such as NGP projects were introduced and established within the four (4) municipalities under the jurisdiction of this Office. In addition, continues coordination to the other law enforcement agencies through created of Multi Sectoral Forest Protection Committee in the Municipalities of Bataraza, Palawan had been crucial specifically in the determination and/or detection of existence/possibility of illegal activities in a particular area.



Continues monitoring of the Furniture shop and lumberyard to ensure that they comply with the necessary requirements based on the guidelines implemented by the office. 10. The office encourage the tree plantation owners to register with the office, to issue the corresponding permit for utilized in accordance with the due process.



Strengthening of linkages with the other law enforcement and concerned agencies like the PNP Maritime, PNP Municipal Police Station and Philippine Marines among other;4. Continuous coordination with Barangay Officials to solicit/encourage their support and active participation in the conduct of forest protection related activities within their respective areas of jurisdiction.5.
