Submitted is the Third Quarter CY 2022 Accomplishment Report in handling of marine turtle in the Province of Marinduque.

Based on the report, twelve (12) Green sea turtle hatchlings were collected and released at Lupac nesting site, Lupac, Boac, Marinduque. According to Mr. Emilio M. Mangol, a resident and in charge of nesting site, the hatchlings were accidentally found at the salvage zone crawling toward the sea.

Furthermore, a dead marine turtle was found in the coastal area of Barangay Daykitin, Buenavista. Based on investigation, the turtle has no injury and presumably dead for almost seven days. However, a plastic material seen in the throat and presumed that it mistaken as food. The carcass was buried along coastal area of Barangay Daykitin.

In addition, twenty (20) pieces of marine turtle tags with alphanumeric codes 2261A to 2280A and five (5) copies of the Marine Turtle Field Guide were received by Conservation and Development Section (CDS) from Regional Office last September 9, 2022.

The carcass was buried along coastal area of Barangay Daykitin.
3. That on September 9, 2022, Conservation and Development Section (CDS) was received the twenty (20) pieces of marine turtle tags with alphanumeric codes 2261A to 2280A and five (5) copies of the Marine Turtle Field Guide from the Regional Office.
