

I. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

On December 11, 1998, Cawayan Upland Farmers Association (CUFA) was awarded with a two-hundred hectares (200.00) of land through Community Based Management Agreement. The association developed forty-three hectares (43 ha.). The location chosen as CBFM area is located at Bgry. Cawayan, San Agustin, Romblon.

II. LEGAL BASIS

Executive Order No. 263 dated July 19, 1995 (Adopting community-based forest management as the national strategy to ensure the sustainable development of the country's forestlands resources and providing mechanisms for its implementation)

DENR Administrative Order No 2004-29 dated August 25, 2004

Revised Rules and Regulations for the Implementation of Executive Order 263, Other Wise known as Community-Based Forest Management Strategy

III. FINDINGS

The monitoring team conducted an ocular site inspection on September 7, 2022 and has the following findings:

- 1. The forest protection strategies include crop rotation and agroforestry.
- 2. Forest trees in the site include Mahogany, Gmelina, and Ipil-Ipil. Fruit trees include Mango, Jackfruit, Coconut, Calamansi and Atis. There are annual crops such as sweet potato, cassava and banana, gabi and ube. Bamboos are also present at the site.

- 3. The Calamansi trees are at its prime and fruitful but sadly, the presence of several monkeys at the CBFM area have affected the harvest from a supposed 300 calamansi trees.
- 4. Copra production is the main source of livelihood of many members, producing an accumulated estimate of 1 and ½ tons of copra per quarter.
- 5. Three members of the organization have passed away namely Herminihildo F. Falcutila, Josef F. Fajutnao and Dominador F. Fajutnao.
- 6. No recent meetings were held for the past two years.


IV. RECOMMENDATIONS


