# I. Background

The subject of this report emanates from the letter complaint of the Villareals against the Bañez family regarding the illegal cutting of trees within the area at Purok II, Brgy. Batasan, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro claimed and occupied by the Villareals.

#### III. Antecedent Facts

a) November 05, 2019

Forest Technician II Christian Jay Villarosa and Forest Protection Officer Louie James Antonio conducted an investigation regarding the complaint of Mr. and Mrs. Villareal at Purok II, Brgy, Batasan, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro. Based on their investigation, it was Mr. Reynante Bañez and Mangoy Bañez also known as Junjun Labiaga are allegedly responsible for the cutting of Ipil trees and Bamboo which was used for backyard fencing. After thorough investigation, it was found out at that it was "Ipil-ipil" not instead of Ipil tree as reported, hence, 8 pcs. of Ipil-ipil trees and 11 Bamboo were cut from the said area of Mr. Villareal.

b) November 21, 2019

An Administrative Hearing was conducted at the CENR Office, Brgy. Labangan, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro presided by Development Management Officer IV Wilfredo A. Aben. The hearing was attended by the first and second party along with their witnesses. The first party claims that the area was inherited by their parents from their grandfather Ricardo Gallego Villareal whom he acquired from Teofilo Lacibar, also the uncle of the Ricardo Gallego Villareal. Hence, the first party claims that they have pertinent documents for acquiring the area but failed to show it. According to the statement of Ernesto Villareal, the disputed area was first borrowed by the

With the following findings and antecedent facts, the team is recommending the following actions to be taken:

- 1. Creation of a composite team to conduct an actual and in-depth investigation.
- 2 That the actual cultivated area into agricultural must be segregated and subject to be awarded to the actual occupants.
- The area under E-NGP must be secured and protected from intrusion by squatters.
- 4. An "Status Quo" order is also an alternative resolution is also recommended.


