



 ✓ IUU Fishing advantage is its covert nature;
- Need to keep the general public engaged and up-to-date on what is happening with IUU fishing;
- Science-guided and evidence-based planning for targeted, purposive, and measurable reduction of IUU fishing in hotspot areas;
- Provide basis to increase resources needed and generate additional support from community and other groups to eliminate IUU fishing in a whole-of-government / whole-of-community approach.

c. Why IUU Fishing Index and Threat Assessment Tool (I-FIT Tool)

- '"IUU fishing in the Philippines is believed to be widespread although its actual magnitude remains to be quantified." (NPOA-IUU, EO 154, s. 2013)
- current measures are output-based (e.g., number of patrols, number of apprehensions, cases filed, settled, etc), while useful, do not show state of IUU fishing and its impacts
- VIIRS Boat Detection, AIS) and anonymous reports only provide a partial perspective on the IUU fishing occurrence / incidences
- global/regional rankings are valuable at a macro level but too focused on international commitments and too generalized to sufficiently inform fisheries management at the LGU and even at the FMA or at the country level






Figure X. PAMB members thru virtual appearance.
