

Submitted is the Progress Report on the target activity under the Management of Coastal and Marine Resources/Areas- Technical Assistance on Integrated Coastal Management (ICM). Please be informed that the following activities were conducted/accomplished following the Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) Technical Bulletin No. 2022-02.

**I. Inception Phase**

**Creation of DENR Regional Composite Team with clear-cut task and outputs**

This office already submitted names for the creation of the DENR MIMAROPA Composite Team on ICM Mainstreaming to CLUP through memorandum dated September 7, 2022 (attached), as to this date, the approved RSO have not yet received by this office.

**Status of the LGU's CDP, CLUP and ICM**

The filled-out form on the Status of the Local Government Units' (LGUs) Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP), Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) and Integrated Coastal Management Plan (ICMP) in the Province of Palawan has not yet completed. As of this date, only the Municipalities of Quezon, Rizal, Narra, Taytay, El Nido, Roxas, Araceli, Dumarán and San Vicente has input in the said form, however, the CENROs concern for the remaining LGUs who hasn't filled-out yet the form was requested by this office to provide the needed data for the ICM database. Attached is the updated form as of this date.

**Mapping of River Systems and ENR Profiling**

Attached are the maps of the river systems per municipality reflecting the major rivers. The maps were referred to the CENROs through memorandum dated September 27, 2022 (attached) for verification and validation.

**Identification of LGU to be prioritized for ICM mainstreaming**

Considering the criteria for prioritization to identify the Local Government Unit (LGU) for ICM mainstreaming, this office identified the Municipality of Narra. The said municipality is currently updating their Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) and has an existing Integrated Coastal and Fisheries Resource Management Plan (ICFRMP) for 2015-2024. In terms of partnership with the LGU, they have been actively involved in managing the Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary (RIWS) as one of the PAMB members.

Other activities conducted was the coordination with the LGU of Narra on August 10, 2022 and the Roll out of the Technical Bulletin No. 2022-02, conducted on September 13, 2022 at PENRO Training Hall, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.




## II. Mainstreaming Phase

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
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#### STEP 4. Analysis of the Situation







MUNICIPALITY OF ABORLAN, PALAWAN**





MUNICIPALITY OF FARACELI, PALAWAN**









**MAP SHOWS RIVER NETWORK SYSTEM T IN MUNICIPALITY OF BALABAC, PALAWAN**





**MAP SHOWS RIVER NETWORK SYSTEM T IN MUNICIPALITY OF CUYO, PALAWAN**




