

I. Special Events and Celebration

1. World Rangers Day

On July 25, 2022, IEC team of CENRO Brooke's point conducted an Honorary Program for the Fieldmen and Forest Rangers of CENRO Brooke's Point. It started with the message of CENRO Conrado M. Corpuz emphasizing his gratefulness to the field men for their great contribution in protecting the environment. IEC Team also prepared an Audio Visual Presentation of the field men in action. As part of the program, CENRO Corpuz prepared a simple token that was given to them that day.

4. International Coastal Clean-up

On September 15, 2022, CENRO Brooke's Point Planning Officer Rachel Appie, Information Officer Marie Kris Matibag and EMB Environmental Monitoring Officer Ralph Noel Navarro conducted a prior meeting for the conduct of coastal clean-up with the partner stakeholders at Barangay Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan. It was attended by SK Officials and Purok leaders of the said barangay. The team discussed about the guidelines and health protocols for the clean-up. Introduction to RA 9003 or The Ecological Solid Waste Management was also presented.

On September 17, 2022, in celebration of International Coastal Clean-up, the IEC Team of CENRO Brooke's Point mobilized the volunteers, coordinated the activity and facilitated the conduct of coastal clean-up in Sitio Marabahay, Barangay Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan. To facilitate the clean-up activity, CENRO Brooke's Point divided the coastal areas into 16 stations and participants into 16 groups. IEC Team of CENRO Brooke's Point together with SK Officials and Rio Tuba Youth Organization were designated as coordinators and facilitators of the activity.

The event was held together with 160 (109 male; 51 female) representatives/volunteers from other government agencies and private organizations, to wit: MENRO Bataraza, Barangay LGU (Riotuba), Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation, Coral Bay Nickel Corporation, Grace Guardians, Alpha Kappa Rho, Sigma Beta, Kappa Rho Kappa, Alpha Phi Omega, Palawan Charity Riders Club, Hans Vience Lance Company, Western Philippines University, DepEd and CENRO Brooke's Point personnel. A total of 191 sacks or 1,705 kilograms of trash were collected. The wastes collected by the participants were transferred to the Municipal Sanitary Landfill by the LGU SWM.

A total of one hundred (100) participants from CBNC, SK Federation of Barangay Rio Tuba, Rio Tuba Youth Organization and CENRO Brooke's Point participated the event in which 100 bamboo tinik and bamboo patong seedlings were planted in the 0.5 hectares area.

Series of IECs conducted and reporting of OJTs re: Learnings acquired

IEC Team of CENRO Brooke's Point conducted IEC and field exposure for the twenty five (25) On-the-Job Trainee from Western Philippines University to inform on other programs monitored by the DENR and see on the ground the activities conducted and implemented.

On August 3, 2022, Mine site Tour in Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation and field exposure in rehabilitation area and Bamboo Setum of Coral Bay Nickel Corporation was conducted. Through coordination with the management of the two private companies, the activities were successfully conducted.

RTNMC thru MEPEO personnel conducted IEC on the programs and rehabilitation efforts conducted by the company to restore and manage the natural resources within the mine site. Operations of the company were also discussed to enlighten the Youth on the positive and negative impact of mining. After the discussion, the team conducted tour in Mangingidong Ecosystem Restoration Laboratory and showed the efforts and success of the area in terms of rehabilitation. Also, RTNMC personnel showed the areas being developed and promoted for nature tourism activity within the mine site. The tour program of RTNMC ended in Tanauan area wherein a short program was conducted.

In the afternoon, the group proceeded to TSF 1 of CBNC. The operation and process conducted in hydrometallurgical plant was discussed by Engr. Briccio Abela. In addition, they specifically discussed how they successfully rehabilitated TSF 1, from barren area and now become one of the most successful and model reforestation area not just in the Phillipines but also globally. CBNC staff showed the TSF 1 status today, the fully grown trees, fruit trees and crops that can be harvested. Aside from TSF 1 area, the group were also toured in the Bamboo Setum of CBNC wherein they have discussed their efforts and success stories in propagating and nurturing bamboo materials.

On the next day, August 4, 2022, the group travelled to Ursula Island with the assistance and support of CBNC. Protected Area staff conducted briefing on the Do's and don't's within the island. The following are the activities conducted for the two-day IEC and field exposure in the island:
