Per memorandum, CENRO Roxas manifested that the planting sites of Pagdanan Timber Product, Inc. are located in the Barangays of Port Barton and Kemdeng, San Vicente, Palawan and along the National High-way of Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan. As such, there were no traces of illegal cutting within the abovementioned sites in San Vicente, Palawan. Further, the said areas were among the worst affected places during the onslaught of Typhoon Odette last December 17, 2021. While the said planting site (road sides) in Barangay Dumarao was affected by the road widening of DPWH.

Furthermore, CENRO Roxas have been conducting preventive measures to deter illegal environmental activities within its AOR like continuous LAWIN patrolling, Information, Education Campaign (IEC) programs and surveillance & monitoring activities which resulted to series of apprehensions. Likewise, part of the continuing measures is the involvement of the communities thru establishment of intelligence networks to act as agents in identifying environmental perpetrators.

Verification disclosed that the planting sites of Pagdanan Timber Product Inc. are located in the Barangays of Port Barton and Kemdeng, San Vicente, Palawan and along the National High way of Barangay Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan. Further, there were no traces of illegal cutting within the abovementioned sites in San Vicente, Palawan. Be informed that these areas are among the worst affected places during the onslaught of Typhoon Odette on December 17, 2022. While the said planting site (road sides) located in Barangay Dumarao was affected by the road widening of DPWH.

Moreover, this Office have been conducting preventive measures to deter illegal environmental activities within our jurisdiction such as continuous LAWIN patrolling, Information Education Campaign (IEC) programs, and surveillance and monitoring which resulted to series of apprehension incidents.

Lastly, part of our continuing measures is the engagement of the communities thru establishment of intelligence networks to act as agents in identifying violation and act also as advocates of forest conservation and protection works, it being the direct beneficiaries of the natural resource.

In compliance to the memorandum of OIC, ARD for Technical Services Maximo Landrito dated 15 August 2022 forwarded in this Office by the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office dated 06 September 2022 relative to the above subject.

Please be informed that on September 20, 21 & 28, 2022 the personnel of this Office conducted investigation regarding the alleged rampant illegal logging/cutting within Roxas and San Vicente, Palawan and illegal cutting within the *patanim* project of Pagdanan PLTP. Based on the conducted investigation, the *patanim* project of the said company was within Barangay Port Barton and Barangay Kemdeng, San Vicente, Palawan and in Barangay Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan. According to the Community People Organizations and Barangay Officials in the abovementioned Barangays in San Vicente, Palawan, they stated that there was no illegal cutting within the said projects since it was already damaged during the onslaught of Typhoon Odette on December 17, 2021. Further, the assigned team went to the said area and no traces of illegal cutting was observed. Also, Barangay Chairman Nardito Acierto of Barangay Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan, also a former employee of Pagdanan Timber Product Incorporated PLTP from 1980's to 1990's and until its last operation, stated that the *patanim* project was affected during the road widening project of DPWH.

With regards to the lumber dealers in Puerto Princesa City, this Office has no jurisdiction over them since the said city is under the jurisdiction of CENRO Puerto Princesa. While based on our records, the two (2) lumber dealers within our jurisdiction has already applied for renewal of their permits and was already forwarded to PENR Office while the rest was already advised thru letter to apply for the necessary permits as per existing laws, rules and regulations. However, the complaint relating to buying and selling of lumbers is out of our control since it is a business matter and that is on the owner/s prerogative.

Moreover, before the onslaught of Typhoon Odette, this Office have been intensifying our forest protection works and operations against anti-illegal logging throughout the area of responsibility of this Office which resulted to series of apprehensions of undocumented forest products, chainsaws and other implements involve as well as illegal quarrying within riverbanks. Said apprehension incidents have each corresponding report submitted.

In addition to the above activities, Information, Education Campaign (IEC) on the existing environmental laws, rules and regulations were also conducted in different Municipalities (Roxas, San Vicente, Dumaran and Araceli) participated by the communities and Barangay Officials to spread environmental awareness within their respective communities. Continuous LAWIN cybertracking patrolling within our conservation area was made to increase our visibility in the area and to deter illegal environmental activities.

This Office also tried to furnish a copy our report to the complainant but failed to do so since their address and/or contact number were not stated in their letter complaint.

In view of the foregoing, we recommend for continuous conduct of Information Education Campaign (IEC), LAWIN foot patrolling, and if possible additional permanent forest rangers as an additional manpower in implementing forestry and environmental laws, rules, regulations, and other activities of this office.

In compliance with the instruction of the Community Environment and Natural Resources Officer dated September 15, 2022, please be informed that the undersigned immediately proceeded to Barangay Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan to conduct investigation regarding the letter complaint of concern citizen (Mga Tao sa Roxas at San Vicente, Palawan) that there is an illegal cutting of trees specially the reforestration of former Pagdanan Timber Product Incorporated at the said Barangay.

Yesterday September 22, 2022 coordination was made to Barangay Chairman in person of Honorable Nardito Acierto of Barangay Dumarao, Roxas, Palawan based on the complaint of concern citizen (mga tao sa Roxas at San Vicente, palawan).

Upon interview to Barangay Chairman Acierto he said that no one was cut because the Pagdanan Timber Product Incorporated was has not planted in one area except the road of National Higway which has been affected by road widening in a recent years. (Note: The Barangay chairman is a regular employee of Pagdanan since 1980s to 1090s until the last operation of said company before it was closed)

That the permits given by the office is /are only a planted trees on a private property or a titled lands and the office also a record a certificate of verification that comes from the registered plantation that is being transported by the shippers.

That all have their baby bansawmill (Bansohan) have required to apply a Wood Processing Plant (WPP) and it was written by the CENR Office.

That the said falcata has been long time lost due to the operation of Sasot Furniture shop and veneering plant at Sitio Man-ag Barangay IV, Roxas, Palawan.

That this is a verybig lie because he/she didn't attach even pictures and doesn't intruduce their self for clarification and we have also a person of interest/suspect regarding this complaint and this is also a shipper that envy by his colleagues.

Please be informed that the undersigned conducted rough and thorough investigation last September 20, 2022 in regrds to alleged illegal logging within the area of San Vicente Palawan based on Memorandum issued from Assistant Secretary dated May 30, 2022.

Based on the ground investigation and data gathering, we observed no traces of the said alledged rampant illegal logging/cutting in the Forestland and illegal cutting of the patanim pagdanan PLTP in the Municipality of San Vicente. During interview to the community, PO's and Barangay official's in the said Municipality they mentioned that the onslaught of Typhoon Odette caused most of the damages in the environment.

Further be informed that harvesting of diregulated species where placed in private land, and it was properly monitored and documented by this office. All reported complaint by some concearn individuals was properly given some actions, intercepted and apprehended such illegal elements.

Furthermore, the Brgy Kemdeng and Poblacion of San Vicente, Palawan was denied the said allegation, and also the residents and local officials of Sto. Pagdanan of Barangay Port Baton of the same Municipality was denied the said concerned.
