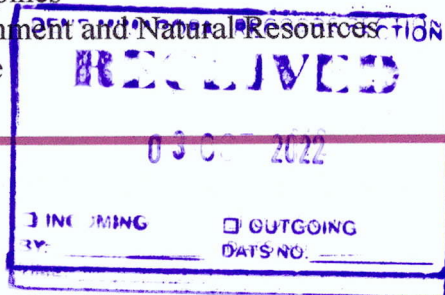

MALBOG, BUENAVISTA, MARINDUQUE**

In compliance with the target activities for CY 2022, respectfully submitted is the Third Quarter Report on the formulation of Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) and Five-Year Work Plan (FYWP) for the Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) Area located in Brgy. Malbog, Buenavista, Marinduque, to wit:

Vision Mapping and Formulation of Strategies and Activities are important milestone activities indicated in the Forest Management Bureau (FMB) Technical Bulletin (TB) No. 20 or the *“Enhanced Guidelines and Procedures in the Preparation/Updating of the Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) and Five-Year Work Plan for CBFMA”* to attain the mission and vision of the CBFMA-awarded People’s Organization (PO). On August 11 and 12, 2022, a workshop was conducted regarding the said milestone activities at the Covered Court of Barangay Malbog, Buenavista. The event was attended by the PO Planning Team, other PO members, staff from Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) and representative from Barangay LGU.

On the first day of the activity, flyers about Gender and Development (GAD) were distributed to the participants while waiting for the arrival of the other PO members. The participants also filled-up the attendance sheet.

The activity was formally started with a short invocation. Following the opening prayer, the attendees were oriented with the objectives of activity and its significance in the preparation of the CRMF and FYWP for their CBFM area. Before the workshop proper, a short discussion

about Magna Carta for Women and Violation Against Women and Children was conducted by Miss Azalea S. de Castro, Gender and Development (GAD) Information Officer.

After the discussion on GAD, a map showing their CBFM area and other important features were presented to be used in vision mapping. The participants were advised to consider the laws, rules and regulations being implemented by the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) in their plans and activities. They were also reminded that the output in the activity will be the basis on the formulation of the FYWP. During the activity, the attendees were given a time to discuss among themselves and told them to draw their future plans and goals within the CBFM area in the provided map. Generally, the plan concentrated in reforestation activity by planting native species of forest trees, specifically narra, and in livelihood aspect through planting high value crops (fruit trees), annual crops (vegetables and other cash crops) and dwarf coconut plantation establishment intended for cocosugar production. The results of vision mapping were analyzed and consolidated per activity and were indicated in the template for the FYWP.

On August 12, 2022 Formulation of Strategies and Activities was conducted. The formulated Vision, Mission, Goals and Objectives (VMGOs) as well as the identified Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Challenges (SWOC) on the previous workshops were reviewed to serve as guide for this activity. This activity aims to formulate strategies and plan for activities to attain the Organization's VMGOs in four different aspects such as Forest and Forest Resources, Organization, Livelihood and Linkage to Partner Agencies (Government Agencies and Non-Governmental Organizations). This is also for the PO to cope up with their weaknesses and overcome the challenges through their strength and in order to maximize their opportunities. During the workshop, the participants presented and discussed their outputs and the significance of each in the attainment of the purpose of the association.

The results of the two-day workshop were gathered for consolidation and preparation of the draft CRMF.
