



This pertains to the target activity on the implementation of Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) for initial components for establishment/ disestablishment-boundary modification of El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected (ENTMRPA) area under Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF).

Please be informed that on August 3, 2022, the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) of ENTMRPA facilitated the Technical Working Group (TWG) meeting at the Conference Room of this Office to fast track the on-going PASA activities. The said meeting was attended by a total of twenty-five (25) participants composed of 13 males and 12 females from Indigenous People Mandatory Representative (IPMR), Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), Municipal Environment and Natural Resources (MENRO), Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO), Office of the Municipal Agriculturist (OMA), Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau (MGB) MIMAROPA, CENRO Taytay, El Nido Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ENCCI), LGU Masagana, Corong-corong, Maligaya and PAMO ENTMRPA.

The undersigned presented the PASA milestones of ENTMRPA and reiterate the procedural guidelines in the conduct of PASA while SVEMS Mildred A. Suza informed the TWG members of the revised proposed Regional Special Order (RSO) team composition and the tentative schedule of the public consultation for twenty-one barangays within the protected area. Further, Forest Technician I Lanie Jane Rey discussed the PA boundary and the maps per barangay highlighting the PA zoning e.g., terrestrial *Multiple Use Zone (MUZ)* and *Strict Protection Zone (SPZ)* including the river tributaries and road network. CDS Chief Clarissa P. Pador as well explained how to accomplish the PASA form 1 for on-site observation and PASA form 2 for Key Informant Interview (KII).

During the discussion, the PASA team agreed to harmonize the validation of PA zoning vs. CLUP and ECAN maps. Thus, the team organized a spatial planning team composed of the GIS experts from the team to focus on data organization and analysis for the final map of the proposed PA. The team also clarified to PCSD that the conduct of PASA shall involve rapid biodiversity assessment within the selected study sites and no wildlife extraction will be involve in the process. The activity shall only involve spot mapping wherein important features shall be recorded and their relative location shall be presented in the map. The team also agreed to present the preliminary result of the assessment to the Sangguniang Bayan for their information.

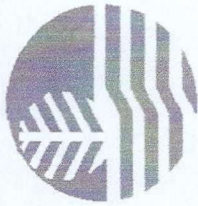

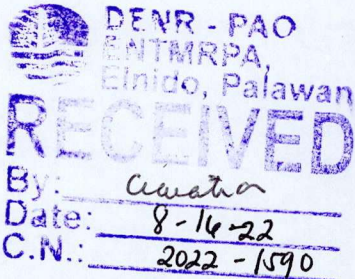

This pertains to the target activity item b. of the Work and Financial Plan 2022 under Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) for initial components for establishment/disestablishment-boundary modification of El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected (ENTMRPA).

Please be informed that on August 9, 2022, the undersigned together with the PASA team and PAMO staff of ENTMRPA facilitated the conduct of public consultation held at the covered court of Barangay Sandoval, Taytay, Palawan. The said activity was attended by a total of 20 participants composed 10 male and 10 female from Barangay key officials, People’s Organization, Farmers Association, and Religious Sector.

Forest Ranger Herson Y. Caliao presented the Protected Area profile of ENTMRPA while Forest Technician I Lanie Jane A. Rey discussed the map of barangay Sandoval that falls within the PA including the land classification of Barangay Sandoval, the river tributaries and the PA management zones. Afterward, the team facilitated the open forum to accommodate the issues and concern from the key participants of PASA. Hereunder are the highlights of discussion during the activity.

Issues and concerns raised during the open forum	Response
1. Punong Barangay Manuelito Legion of Sandoval requested to locate the exact boundary of the PA on the ground so that they can decide whether to reduce or extend the PA boundary within their barangay. He also informed the team that there are occupants in the area.	CDS Chief Clarissa P. Pador responded that if there are any environmental topographies like watershed or river that drains in Bacuit Bay, they will be used to support the modification of boundaries of the existing PA under the NIPAS. She also informed PB Legion that the Office may track the record of the occupants within the PA through the Socio-Economic and Assessment Monitoring System (SEAMS) data that was conducted in 2018. She clarified further that based on the record, there are no households recorded during the SEAMS survey and perhaps there are new occupants in the said area.

2. Mrs. Consuelo Z. Magdayao from religious sector asked the PASA team if her area in Sitio Pinagkulitan is within the PA. According to her, they had already developed the area and planted with Cashew in the 1970s and owned a tax declaration and Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC).	The team responded that part of her area is located in Barangay Mabini wherein still within the PA and classified as timberland. CDS Chief Pador explained that a tax declaration is not conclusive evidence of ownership but rather a document that the holder has a claim over property and serves as the basis for the collection of real property tax. The team further noted the verification of Mrs. Magdayao CSC status at CENRO Taytay as well as other CSC holder in Barangay Sandoval that falls within the PA.

After the open forum, the PASA form 2 was administered to the key informants of Barangay Sandoval, Taytay, Palawan. Follow-up questions were also asked by the interviewers to elucidate responses from the key informants.

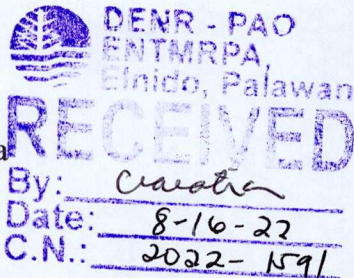

This pertains to the target activity item b. of the Work and Financial Plan 2022 under the Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) for initial components for establishment/disestablishment-boundary modification.

Please be informed that on August 10, 2022, the undersigned together with the PASA team and PAMO staff of ENTMRPA facilitated the conduct of public consultation at Barangay Cataban, Taytay, Palawan. The said activity was attended by a total of twenty-two (22) participants composed of 10 males and 12 females from local government officials, People’s Organization, Fisherfolk Association, Farmers Association, BFARMC, Indigenous People, and Senior Citizen.

During the preliminary, Kagawad Yolanda A. Tumampil gave the welcome message in behalf of the Punong Barangay Jon O. Tumampil. Park Maintenance Foreman (PMF) Jenuel P. Casel gave the opening message highlighting the purpose on the re-conduct of PASA activity pertaining to the request of Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) to assess the suitability and non-suitability of the PA. Forest Ranger Herson Y. Caliao presented the ENTMRPA profile while Forest Technician I Lanie Jane A. Rey discussed the PA boundary of Barangay Cataban that falls within the PA including the built-up areas, mangrove forest, inland waters, land classification (*unclassified public forest, timberland, and alienable and disposable land*), and the PA management zones. Afterward, the team facilitated an open forum to accommodate the issues and concerns of the key participants of PASA. Hereunder are the highlights of the discussion during the activity.

Issues and concerns raised during the open forum	Response
1. Mr. Domingo Omegan of Farmer’s Association requested to exclude the A&D areas in Barangay Cataban, Taytay, Palawan.	PMF Jenuel P. Casel responded that they may submit a resolution with their reasons to exclude and remove the A&D areas in Barangay Cataban that falls within ENTMRPA.
2. Mr. Omegan informed that they have parcel of land planted with coconut trees within the PA. He requested further if it’s possible to remove their actual area in the PA because they had already occupied the area for over 40 years now.	PMF Casel responded that this Office will verify the lists of tenured migrants within the PA to recognize their occupation within the PA.



3. Alipio T. Santos from Farmer's Association proposed the exclusion of A&D areas in Bgy Cataban.	PMF Casel responded that Bgy. Cataban has 2.19 hectares of A&D areas within ENTMRPA. He suggested to include this in their resolution to support the boundary modification of these areas within PA.
4. Mrs. Hermilina Bonagua raised that income paid by the taxpayers accrue only to Barangay Bayan, El Nido, Palawan. She hoped that since Cataban is within PA, taxes should accrue to Barangay Cataban.	PMF Casel responded that this problem is a unresolve boundary conflict between the municipalities of El Nido and Taytay.

After the open forum, the PASA form 2 was administered to the key informants of barangay Cataban, Taytay, Palawan. Follow-up questions were also asked by the interviewers to elucidate responses from the key informants.

Please be informed that on August 10, 2022, the undersigned together with the PASA team PAMO staff of ENTMRPA and on-the-job trainees from Western Philippines University (WPU) conducted the public consultation at Barangay Liminangcong, Taytay, Palawan. The said activity was attended by a total of sixteen (16) participants composed of 6 male and 10 female from local government officials, People’s Organization (POs), BFARMC, Sangguniang Kabataan (SK), Indigenous People (IP), and Senior Citizen.

During the preliminary, Hon. Lanie G. Abogado gave the welcome message and APASu Jenuel P. Casel gave the opening message highlighting the purpose of the re-PASA activity and the request of PAMB ENTMRPA to assess the suitability and non-suitability of the PA. Forest Ranger Herson Y. Caliao presented the ENTMRPA profile highlighting the historical background, the importance of PA, and its institutional management. For. Clarissa P. Pador also gave a brief background about PASA while Forest Technician I Lanie Jane A. Rey discussed the map of Barangay Liminangcong that falls within the PA including the built-up areas, mangrove forest, inland waters, land classification (*unclassified public forest, timberland, and alienable and disposable land*), and the PA management zones. Afterward, the team facilitated an open forum to accommodate the issues and concerns of the key participants. Hereunder are the highlights of the discussion during the activity.

Issues and concerns raised during the open forum	Response
1. Mr. Renato Ignacio, president of PLSL, requested to exclude the areas that fall within the ENTMRPA boundary and include these areas in Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS). He raised as well the unfamiliarity of PAMB members of El Nido to Bgy. Liminangcong and the difficulty of requesting a permit.	FT I Lanie Jane Rey responded that the Office has no reference to the marine boundary between Liminangcong and Bebeladan. Thus, the PASA team recommended to the key participants of Liminangcong to identify the boundary of marine areas between their Barangay and Bebeladan through a resolution. She further explains that the said document shall be submitted to the Barangay Sanggunian to support their request for the exclusion of the said boundary that falls within ENTMRPA to support the inclusion of these areas to MSPLS.



<p>2. Mr. Ignacio requested to exclude the built-up areas of Liminangcong within ENTMRPA into alienable and disposable (A&D) area so that investors will not hesitate to buy and invest.</p>	<p>For. Clarissa P. Pador explained that the total area of terrestrial in Barangay Liminangcong within ENMTRPA is 929.14 hectares and 15.27 hectares of which is A&D. She further explained that the NAMRIA has a set of standards in the categorization of A&D areas. <i>Unclassified Public Forest (UPF)</i>, topography, and 500 hectares of contagious flat land are some of the considerations for re-classification of A&D areas. In the case of Liminangcong, there is no contagious area that qualifies the criteria and a large portion of their area is timberland. For. Pador further explained that purchasing or selling of lands or other portions of the PA which are covered by any tenurial instrument is prohibited within the PA.</p>
<p>3. Punong Barangay Lanie G. Abogado asked if a donation of land is allowed within the PA since the Liminangcong Forest Management (LIFMA) would like to donate a portion of land to the local government of Liminangcong, Taytay, Palawan. Pador responded that Community Based Forest Management Agreement is a production sharing agreement between the Department of Environment Natural Resources and the participating People's Organization (POs). The said agreement provides tenurial security and incentives to develop, utilize and manage specific portions of forest lands. In view of the circumstances, the team advised Punong Barangay Abogado and the CBFMA of LIFMA to endorse their concern through a resolution and submit the same to DENR for further review and evaluation.</p>
<p>4. Mrs. Nonita Bibat, Chairman of Liminangcong Forest Management Association (LIFMA) asked if the LIFMA falls within ENTMRPA or MSPLS.</p>	<p>FT I Lanie Jane A. Rey confirmed that upon initial verification, the portion of the boundary of CBFMA falls within ENTMRPA and MSPLS. She further informed that the proposed area for donation is within ENTMRPA.</p>
<p>5. BFARMC Chair Nonito Sistoso suggested coming up with a legal basis for the marine boundary between Bebeladan and Liminangcong.</p>	<p>FT I Rey responded that the local government of Liminangcong may submit a resolution enumerating their reason for the exclusion of Liminangcong from ENTMRPA to support its modification of PA boundary.</p>

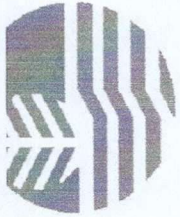

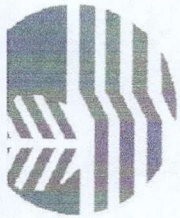

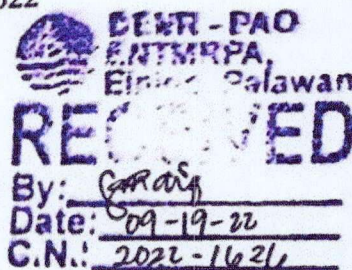
