Has existing barangay endorsement from BLGU of Buena Suerte according to Hon. Captain Ricky Ballena; and, 5. Allegedly, there is also an on-going backfilling/reclamation activity along the beach area with documented heavy equipment's during monitoring activities. Bebeladan does not have a PAMB endorsement.</p> <p>CENRO Valle also added that establishments built before the proclamation of PA are exempted. The penalty was Php50, 000 for those violators.</p> <p>Mr. David suggested to revisit the instances why some of SAPA applicants have troubles on complying.</p> <p>CENRO Valle also added to create a resolution to thoroughly review the suggestions of Mr. David.</p> <p>Mr. David asked regarding ancestral domains.</p> <p>Hon. 

Casel informed that the PAMO installed signages in islands informing the public that the island is within timberland area and Protected Area that requires tennorial instrument or Special Use Agreement in Protected Area (SAPA) from DENR to legally occupy/utilize the area for any development purposes.</p> <p>Mr. David suggested to propose substitute islands for those privatized islands has been included on tour packages like Cadlao Lagoon and Pinagbuyutan Island.</p> <p>APASu added that in Cadlao Lagoon, it was managed by the PO's that provides kayak rental. The claimant allowed them to continue their livelihood.</p> <p>Hon. Abrina answered that the Cadlao Lagoon has been issued Certificates of Ancestral Domain Title (CADT). 
