

The Bataraza MFPC issued Resolution No. 2022-002 entitled "*A Resolution adopting and endorsing the plan activities/forward actions of the Municipal Local Government Unit of Bataraza to neutralize illegal logging and illegal charcoal making activities in the municipality to further support the request for its delisting from the list of identified illegal logging hotspot areas in DENR MIMAROPA Region.*"

Further, on May 4, 2022 the Resolution No. 2022-001 was adopted and approved by the Bataraza MFPC entitled "*A Resolution requesting for the Sangguniang Bayan to issue a Resolution for the delisting of the municipality of Bataraza from the list of identified illegal logging hotspot areas in DENR MIMAROPA Region*" in which CENRO Brooke's Point duly presented and discussed the accomplished activities based on the submitted action plan.



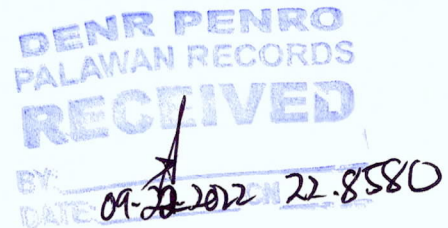

This is in reference to her memorandum instruction dated May 30, 2022 acknowledging receipt of the report of this Office relative to the aforementioned subject and concurring with the proposal to delist the Municipality of Bataraza as an illegal logging hotspot provided that the LGU shall issue a Resolution to this effect with further recommendation that it will contain detailed activities to sustain the drive against illegal logging within the AOJ of Bataraza. This is considering that the issue/concern identified is the limited involvement/support of the LGU in forest protection activities.

In compliance therein, this Office coordinated with the Municipal LGU particularly with the Office of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources (MENRO) to schedule for the created Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (MFPC) in the Municipality to convene for a meeting so as to discuss the issuance of the required LGU Resolution to support the request for the delisting of Bataraza as an illegal logging hotspot. During the meeting held on August 31, 2022, the Municipal LGU presented its plan activities/forward actions to continuously minimize/neutralize illegal logging and illegal charcoal making activities within the AOJ of the Municipality of Bataraza. Said Municipal LGU plan is then adopted and endorsed by the Bataraza MFPC through the issuance of Resolution No. 2022-002 entitled "*A Resolution adopting and endorsing the plan activities/forward actions of the Municipal Local Government Unit of Bataraza to neutralize illegal logging and illegal charcoal making activities in the municipality to*

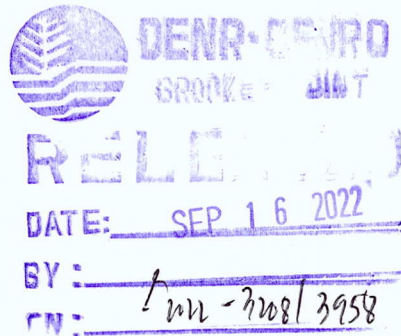
further support the request for its' delisting from the list of identified illegal logging hotspot areas in DENR MIMAROPA Region".

Moreover, it is likewise informed that a prior Resolution No. 2022-001 entitled "*A Resolution requesting for the Sangguniang Bayan to issue a Resolution for the Delisting of the Municipality of Bataraza from the list of identified illegal logging hotspot areas in DENR MIMAROPA Region*" has been adopted and approved by the Bataraza MFPC during the previous meeting held on May 4, 2022 wherein this Office presented and discussed the accomplished activities per the submitted action plan.

In line thereof, it is further informed that per commitment of the Municipal LGU during the MFPC Meeting on August 31, 2022, the securing/issuance of Sangguniang Bayan Resolution/LGU Certification to support request for the delisting of the municipality is tentatively scheduled on the 3rd week of September 2022. Copy of said Sangguniang Bayan Resolution/LGU Certification will be furnished/forwarded soonest.

RESOLUTION No. 2022 – 001

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FOR THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ISSUE A
RESOLUTION FOR THE DELISTING OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BATARAZA
FROM THE LIST OF IDENTIFIED ILLEGAL LOGGING HOTSPOT AREAS IN DENR
MIMAROPA Region**

WHEREAS, per the list released by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the Municipality of Bataraza has been identified as one of the two (2) municipalities in the Province of Palawan declared as an illegal logging hotspot due to high incidence of apprehensions of undocumented forest products;

WHEREAS, in CY 2020, CENRO Brooke's Point submitted an Action Plan aiming to minimize and neutralize the illegal logging, charcoal making and other forestry related illegal activities through capacitation, strengthening of linkages and coordination with the different agencies and stakeholders in the municipality of Bataraza, Palawan covering the period of September 2020 to February 2021 which was then further extended considering the challenges brought about by the health crisis and global pandemic (Covid 19) wherein limited movement of personnel and individuals had impeded the implementation of the proposed and identified programs and activities;

WHEREAS, coordination with the DILG/ MLGOO personnel and MENRO of LGU Bataraza re: MFPC creation/ reactivation was conducted on September 02-04, 2020 to discuss the proposed action plan and activities to address the issues on illegal logging, charcoal making and other illegal forest related activities in the municipality;

WHEREAS, On October, 2020, the Local Chief Executive of Bataraza, Mayor Abraham M. Ibba issued an Executive Order No. 17 "An Order Creating the Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (MFPC) in municipality of Bataraza. It has 15 regular members composed of representatives from this Office, PCSO, DENR, SB, PNP, Maritime, PCG, MENRO, MMPL PASu, and RTNMC (private sector).

WHEREAS, the created MFPC then adopted the proposed plan activities to address the aforementioned issues on illegal logging, charcoal making and other illegal forest related activities in the municipality;

WHEREAS, the impact and results of collaboration, coordination and implementation of activities for the action plan can be verified on records and reports and directly relate on the accomplishments related to conduct of apprehensions specifically operated incidence in the municipality;

WHEREAS, current data trend on apprehension in the municipality show decreasing incidences but varying volume of apprehended undocumented forest products, nonetheless, the volume of reported undocumented forest products in each operations only ranges from above fifty (50) board feet but less than 1,000 board feet which reports also includes the joint and single operation activities of other apprehending agencies;

WHEREAS, as reflected on records of CENRO Brooke's Point, since the incidence of apprehension in CY 2015 in which a total of 32,000 board feet of assorted lumber and flitches was apprehended in Barangays of Tabud and Tagnato (in boundary area of Municipality of Rizal at So. Wangle) and 135.42 cubic meters of different lesser used species apprehended in Barangay Igang-Igang, no other apprehensions exceeding 2,000 board feet (which is the indicator to set an area into hotspot) was recorded and reported. Moreover, the number of incidences and volume of apprehended lumber had since then decreased significantly;

WHEREAS, although, in most cases, the apprehended forest products were naturally grown species of forest trees mostly Bubog, Bangkal and Panasan species, these were only intended for construction of houses and furniture and not necessarily for commercial purposes;

WHEREAS, the activities and accomplishments indicated in the action plan is 100% implemented but not yet enough to be considered that illegal logging, charcoal making and other forestry related illegal activities in the municipality is completely eradicated rather it is 100% successfully neutralized and minimized;

WHEREAS, with the objective of delisting the municipality of Bataraza in identified hot spot areas of MIMAROPA, the reported incidence and volume of apprehended timber and non-timber forest products can be considered as justifications;

WHEREAS, further, the commitments of the Municipal LGU and other partner agencies to support the activities to continue and keep neutralizing and minimizing the incidence can also be measured and deliberated;


WHEREAS, upon motion of PASu Renato S. Gonzaga of MMPL, the Committee unanimously agreed and signifies to the passage of a MFPC resolution requesting for the Sangguniang Bayan to issue a resolution for the Delisting of the municipality of Bataraza from the list of identified illegal logging hotspot areas in DENR MIMAROPA Region;

WHEREFORE, be it resolve as it is hereby resolved that the Bataraza Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (BMFPC) hereby passes a resolution requesting the Sangguniang Bayan to issue a resolution for the Delisting of the municipality of Bataraza from the list of identified


RESOLVED FURTHER, that copy of this Resolution be forwarded immediately to the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) for assessment, evaluation and consideration.






